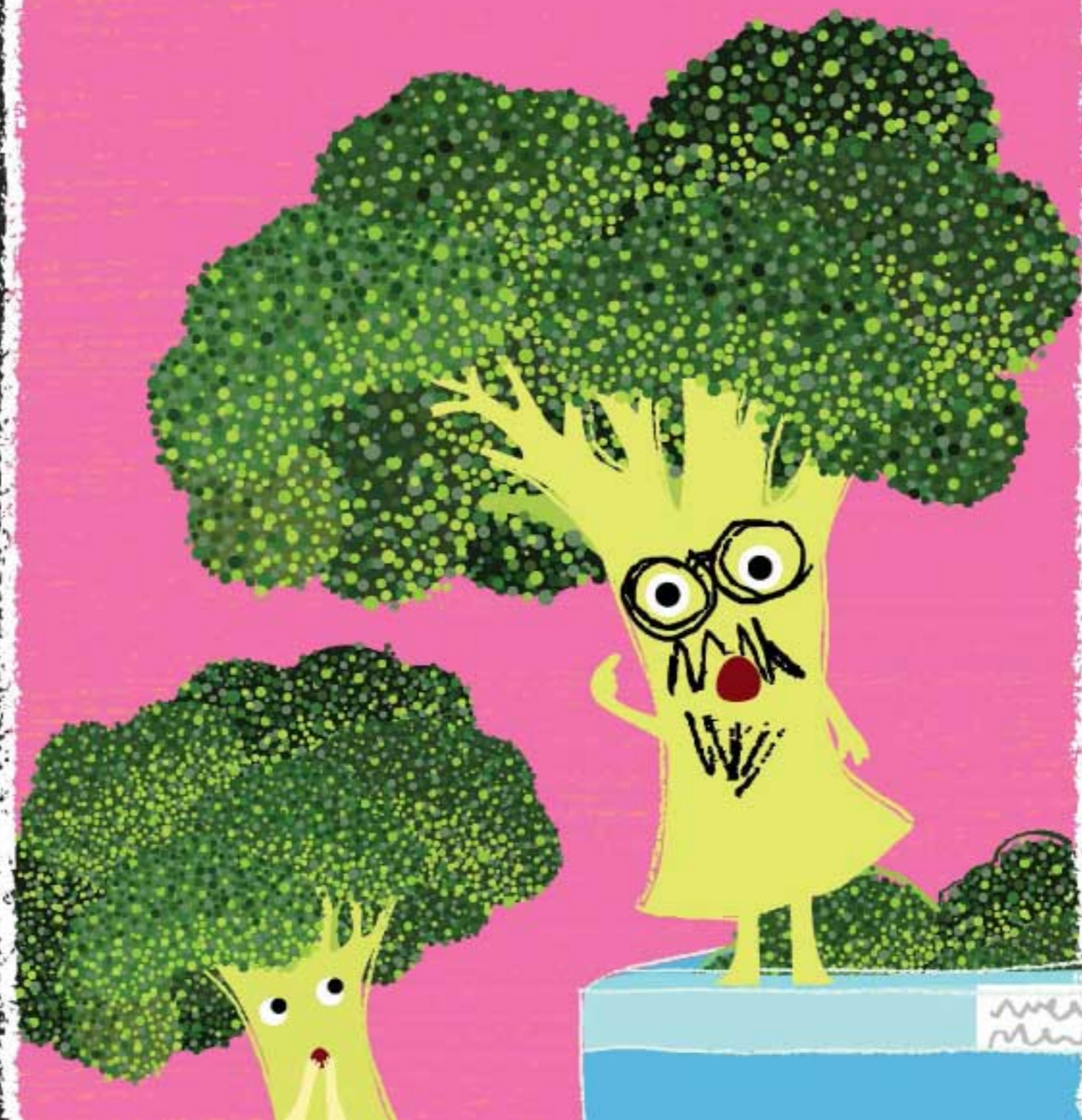

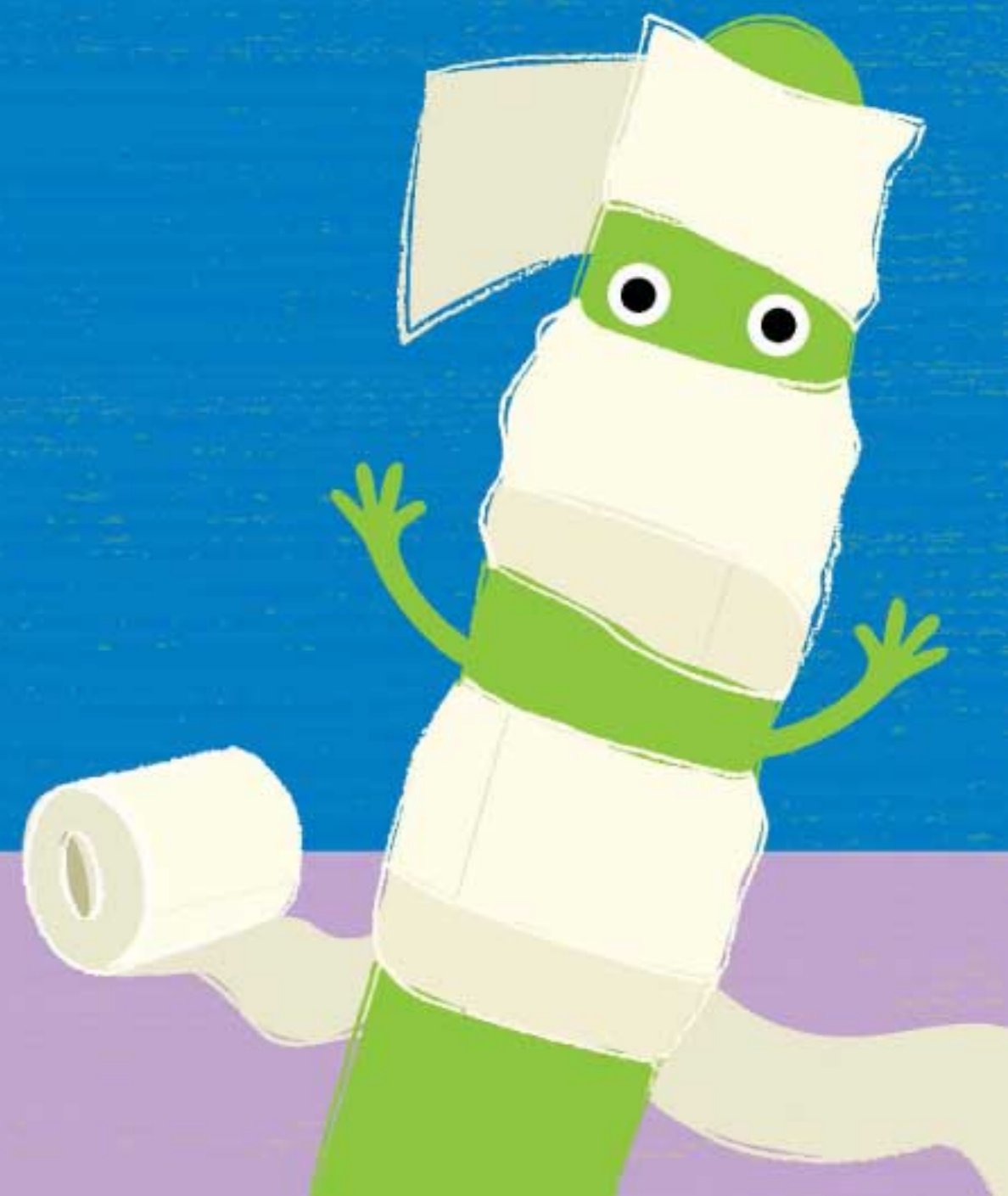
"Help! Help!" cried Carrot.

super strength . . .



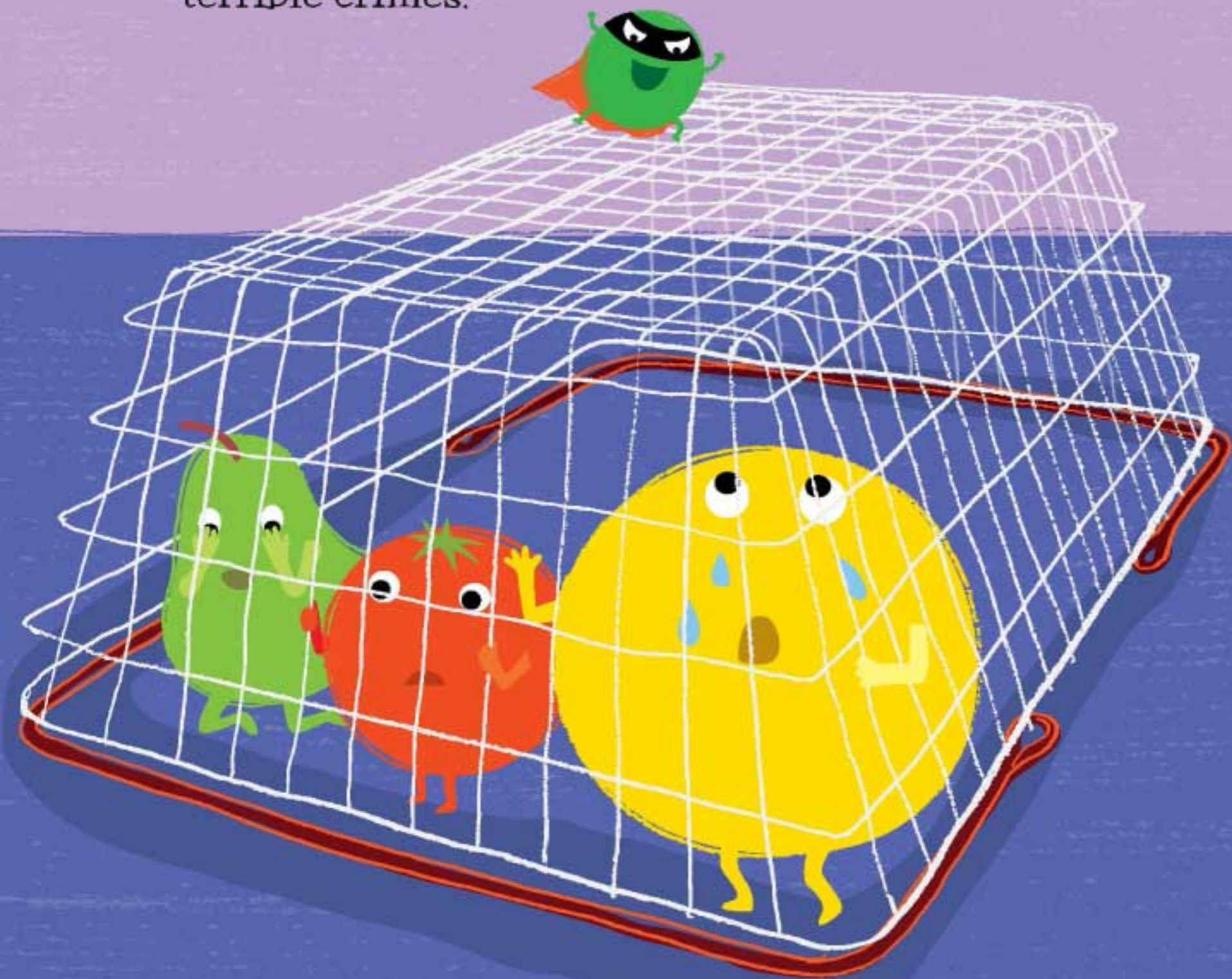
He used a flannel
