Little Red Riding Hood was on her way to Grandma's house when she met a wolf...



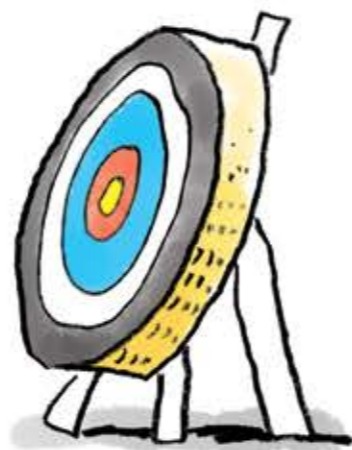
She does NOT have a **KINDNESS RAY**...
