friends

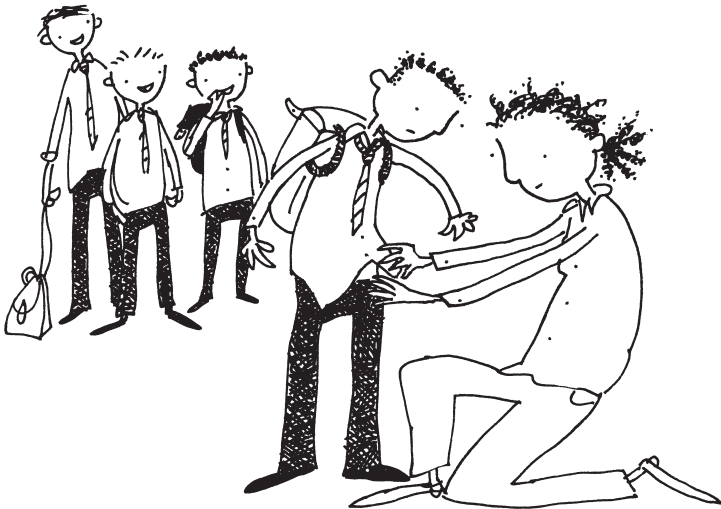
Tuck my shirt right down my pants – in front
