6 Draw in his eyes, nose and mouth.

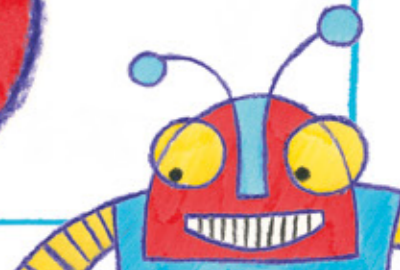
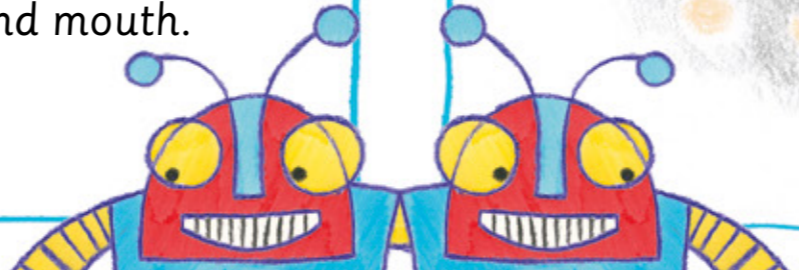
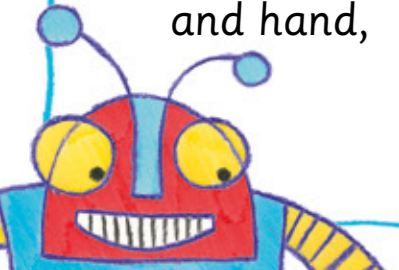
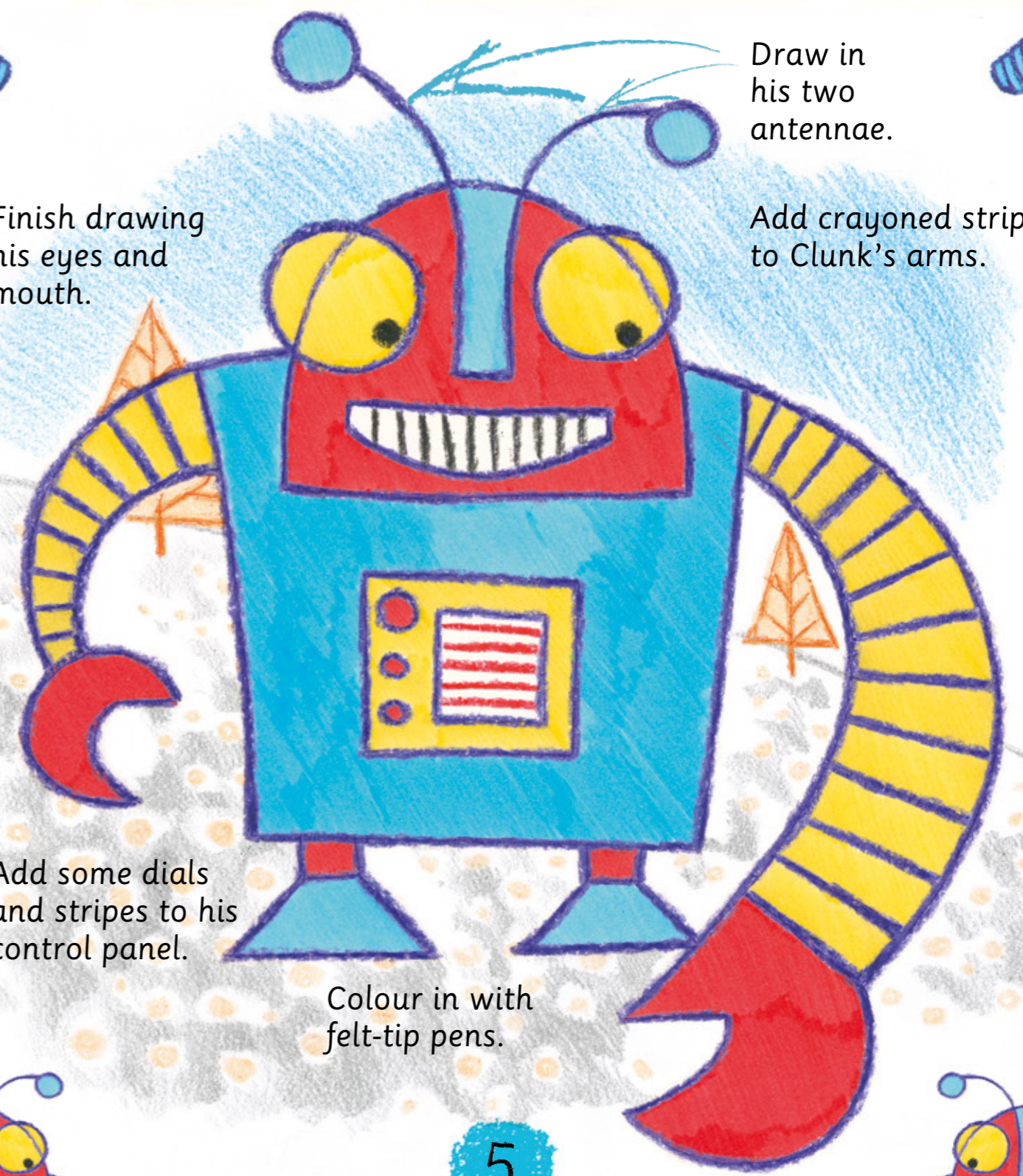

Add crayoned stripes to Clunk's arms.

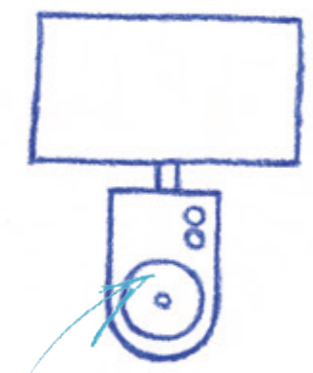

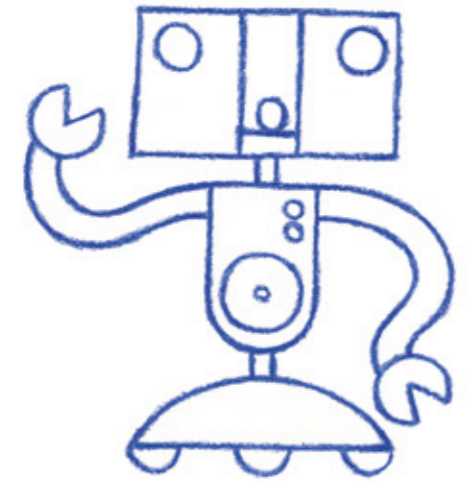
1 Hiss needs a head, a neck,

2 ...and a body with a dial and two buttons.

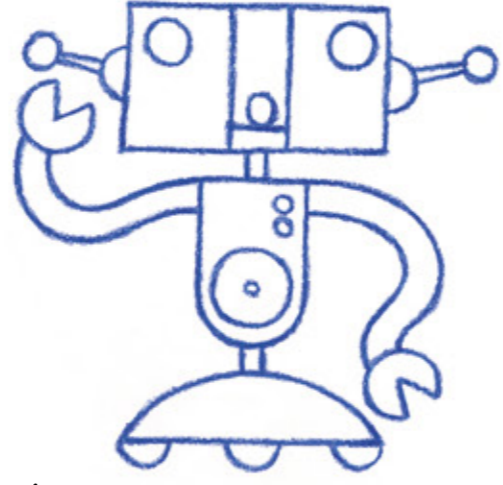
3 Now add a base with three wheels,



4 ...and two bendy arms and hands.



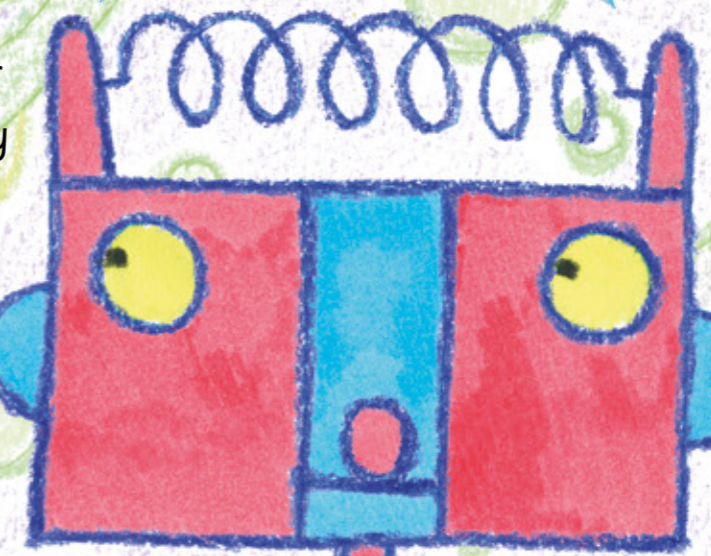
5 Draw Hiss's eyes, nose and mouth,

Add two brackets on top of her head joined by a curly wire!



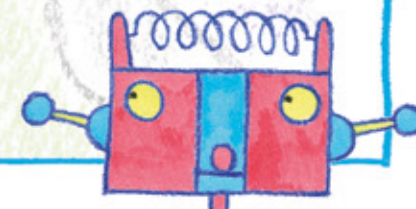
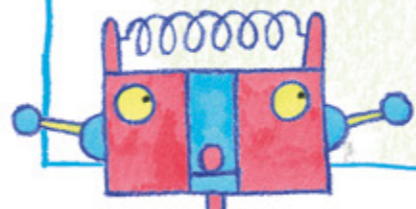
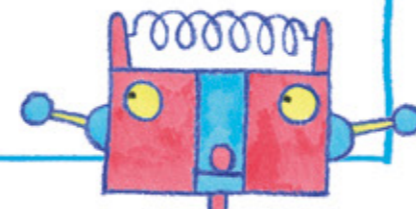
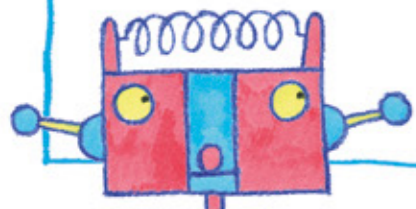
Brackets

Use a crayon to draw in stripes on her arms.

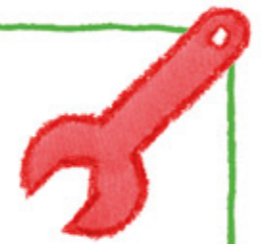
Add hands to the round dial.

Colour in with felt-tip pens.

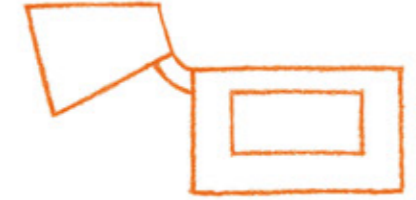




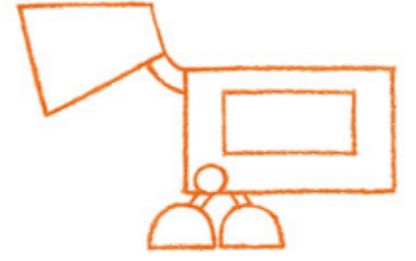
Snap!



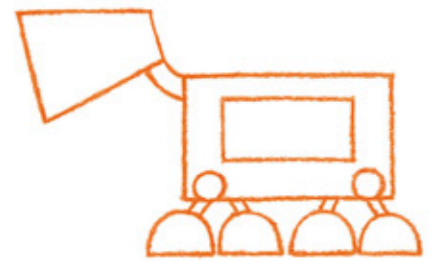
1 Snap needs a head and a neck,



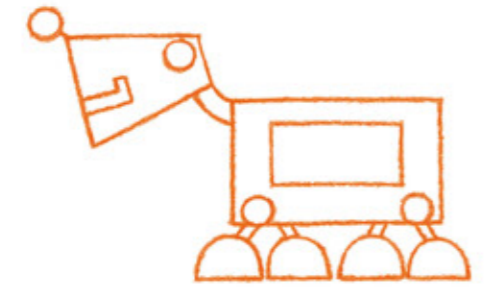
2 ...a body and a control panel,



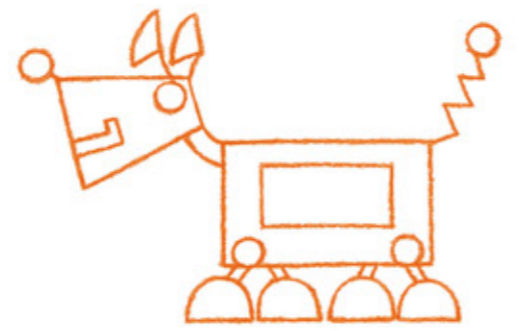
3 ...two front legs with **big** paws,
