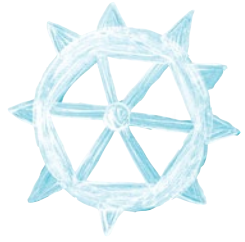

He licked it,

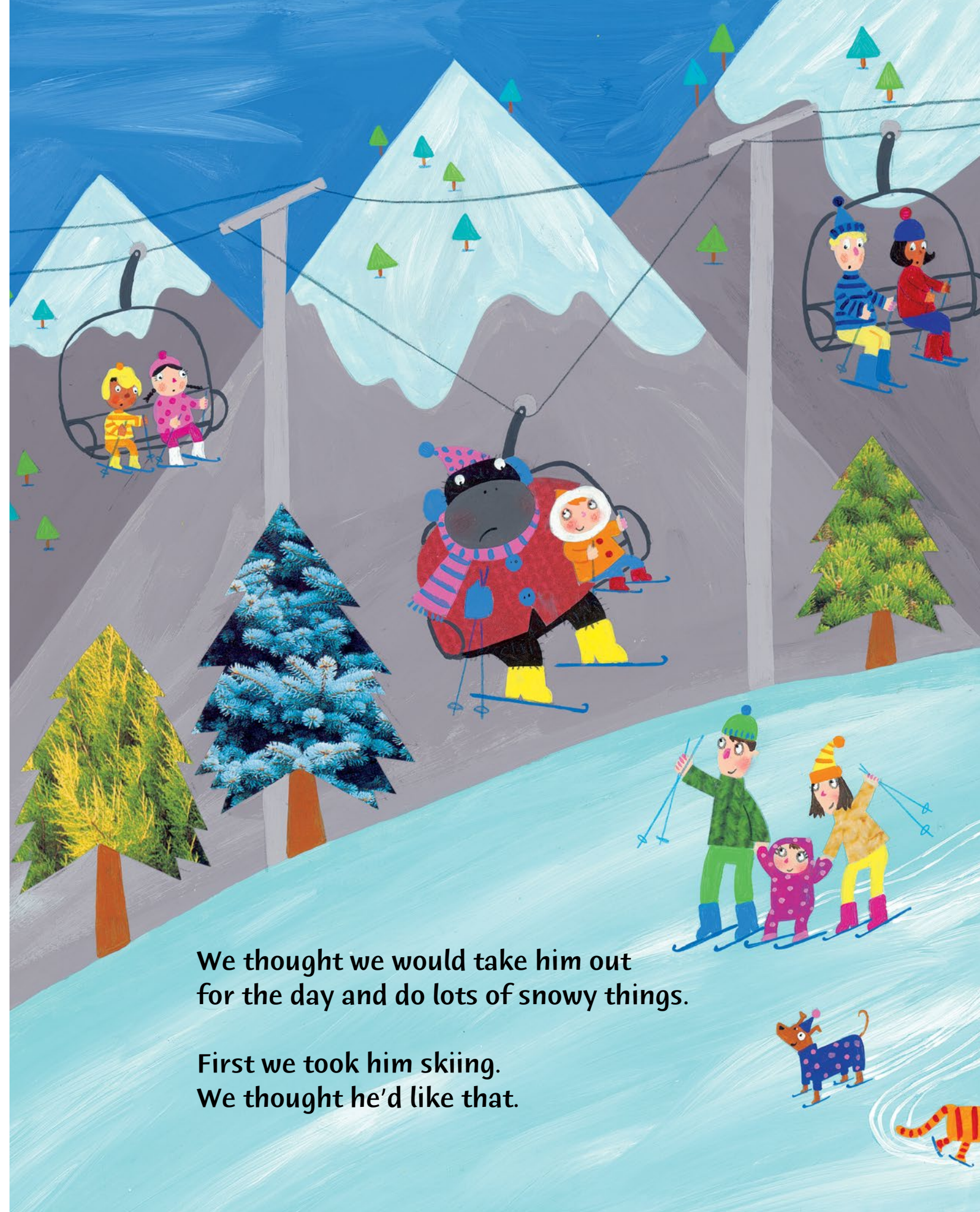
poked it,
