Wagging their tails behind them.

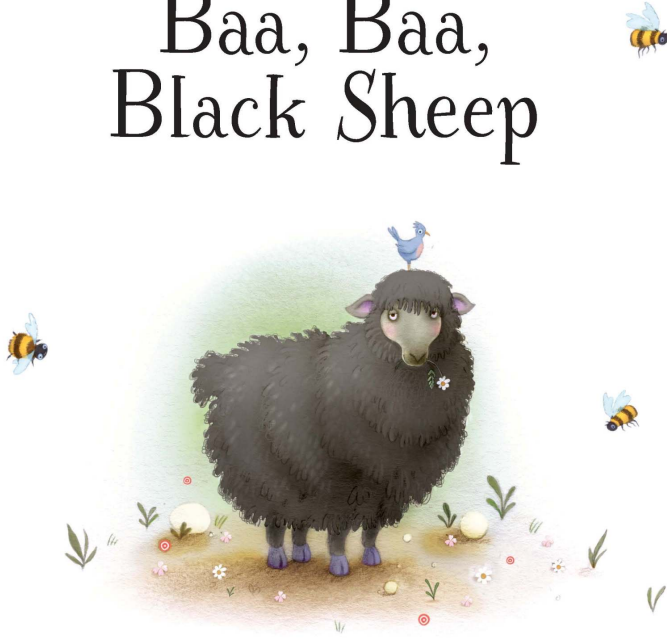


Hickory, Dickory, Dock
