He didn't know what to say.

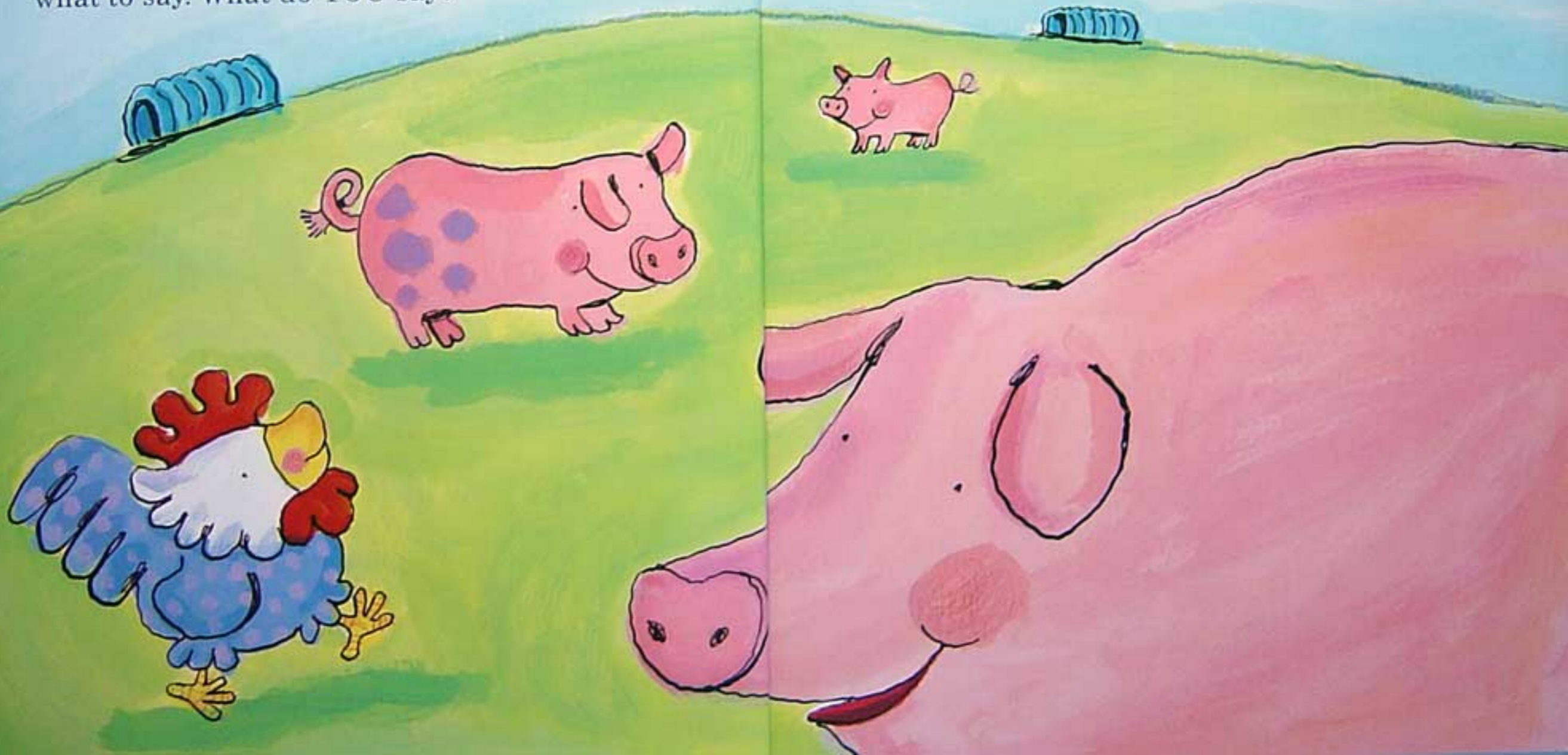
So, he went to see the pigs.
