This is my friend Terry.

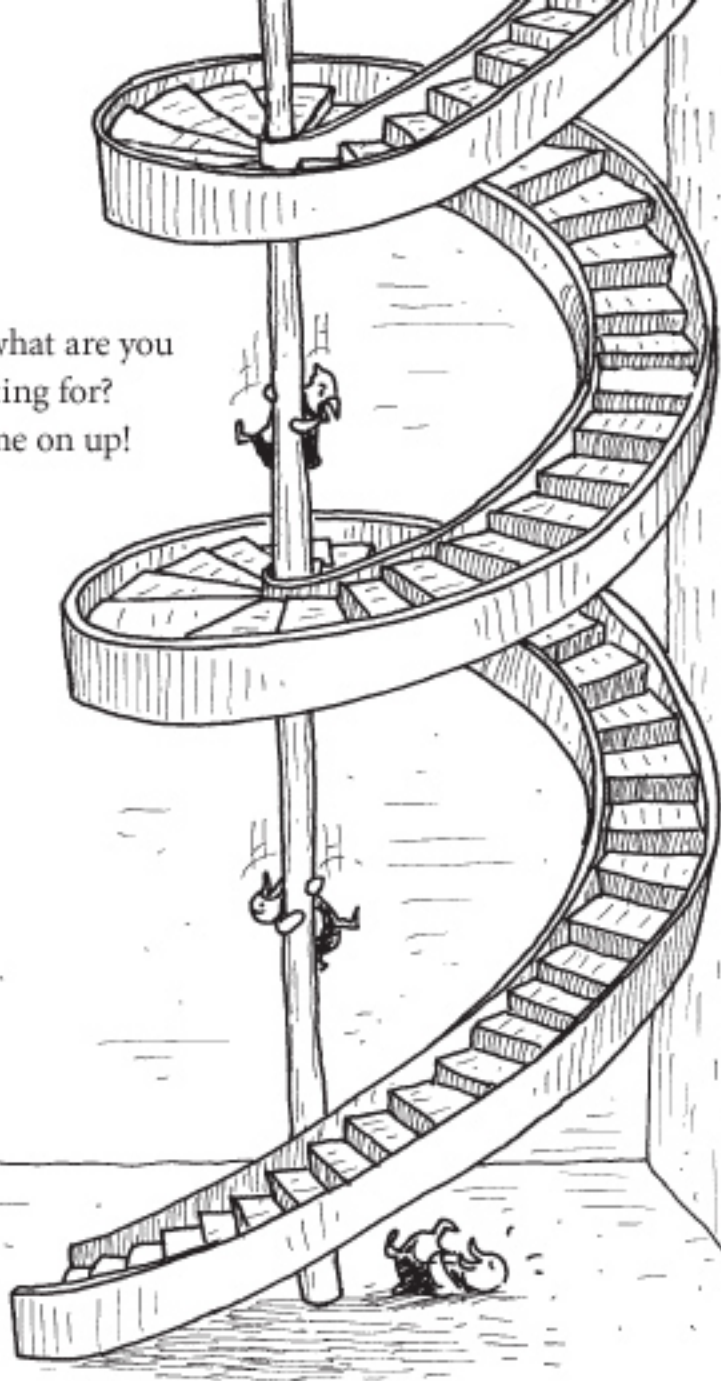


We live in a tree.
