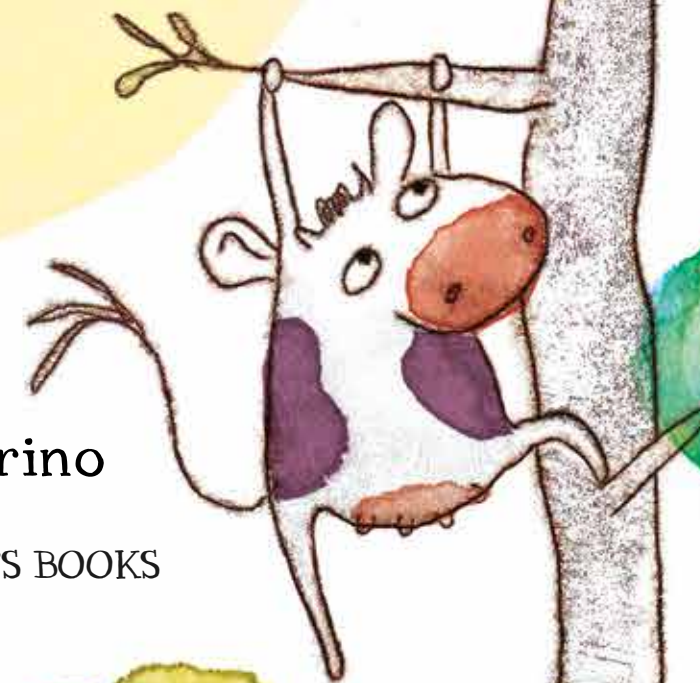

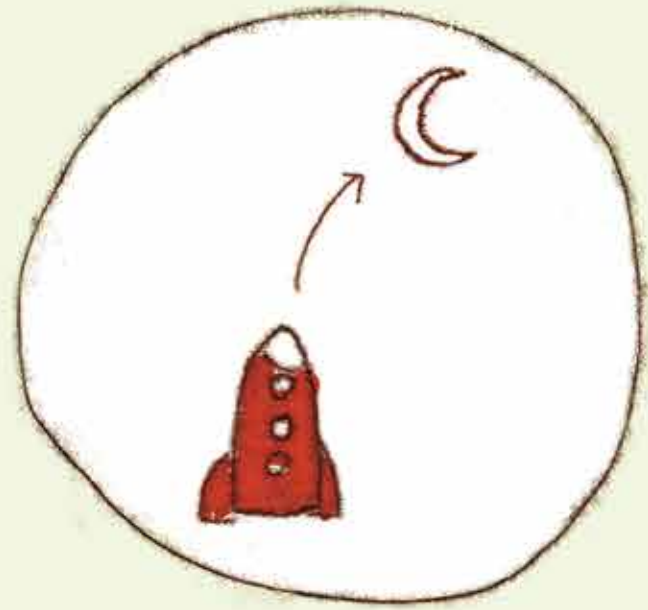

She had a thirst for discovery.



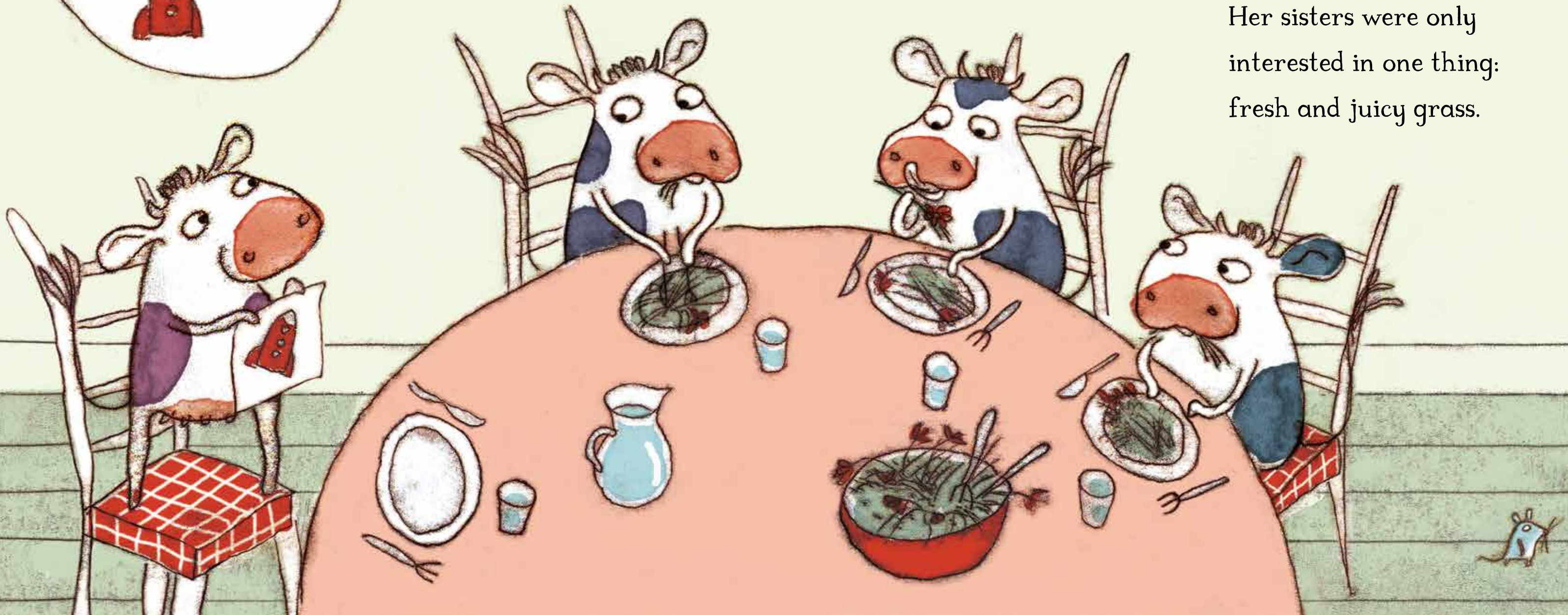
Her mind was full of wonderful things,

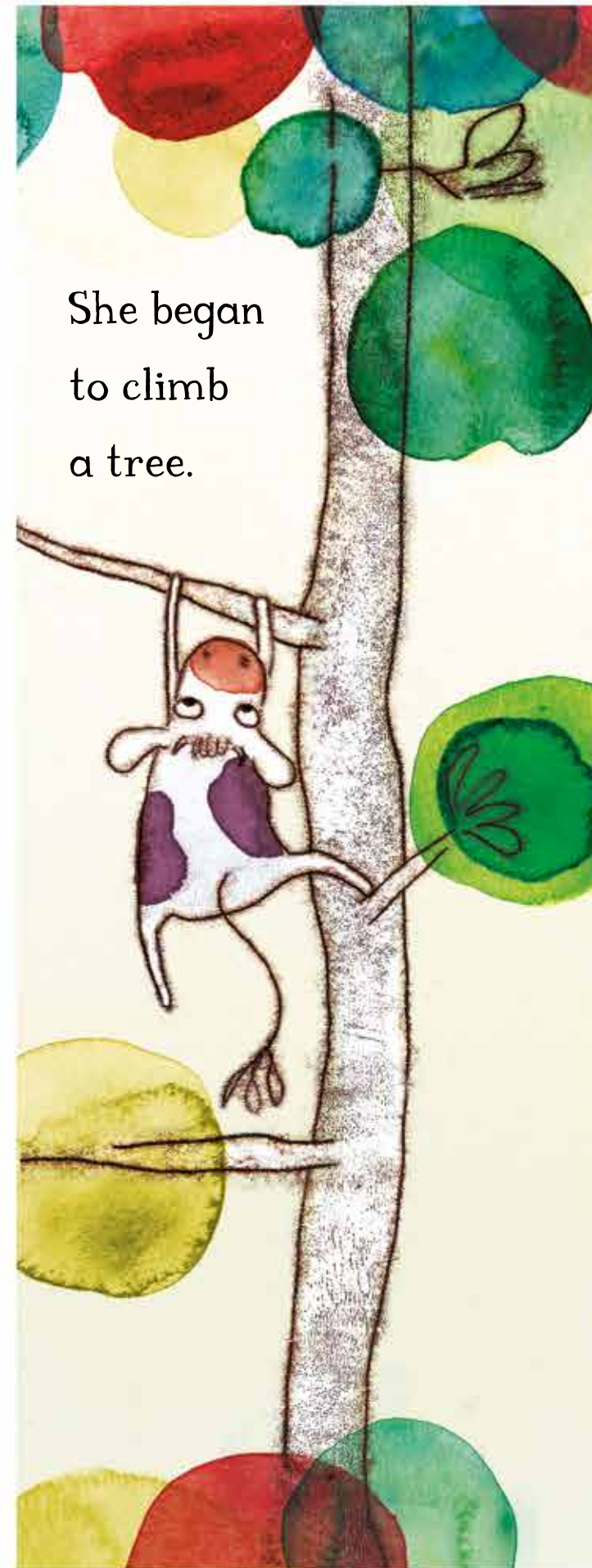

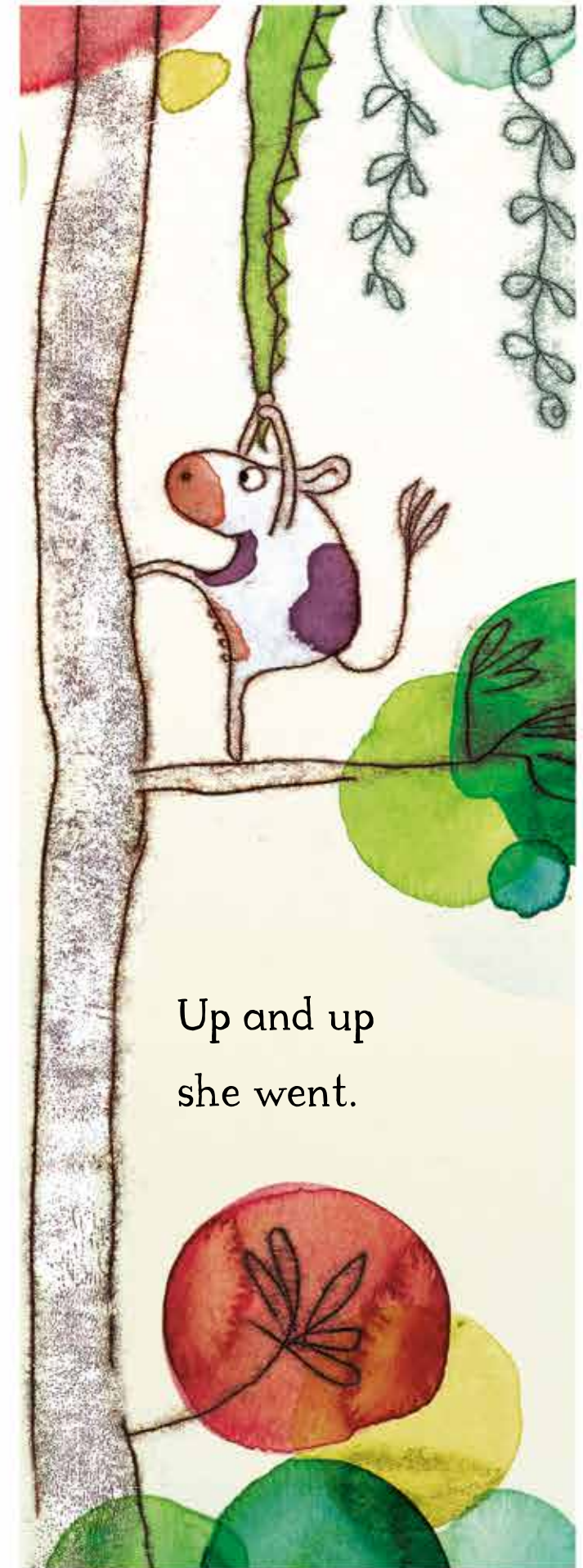

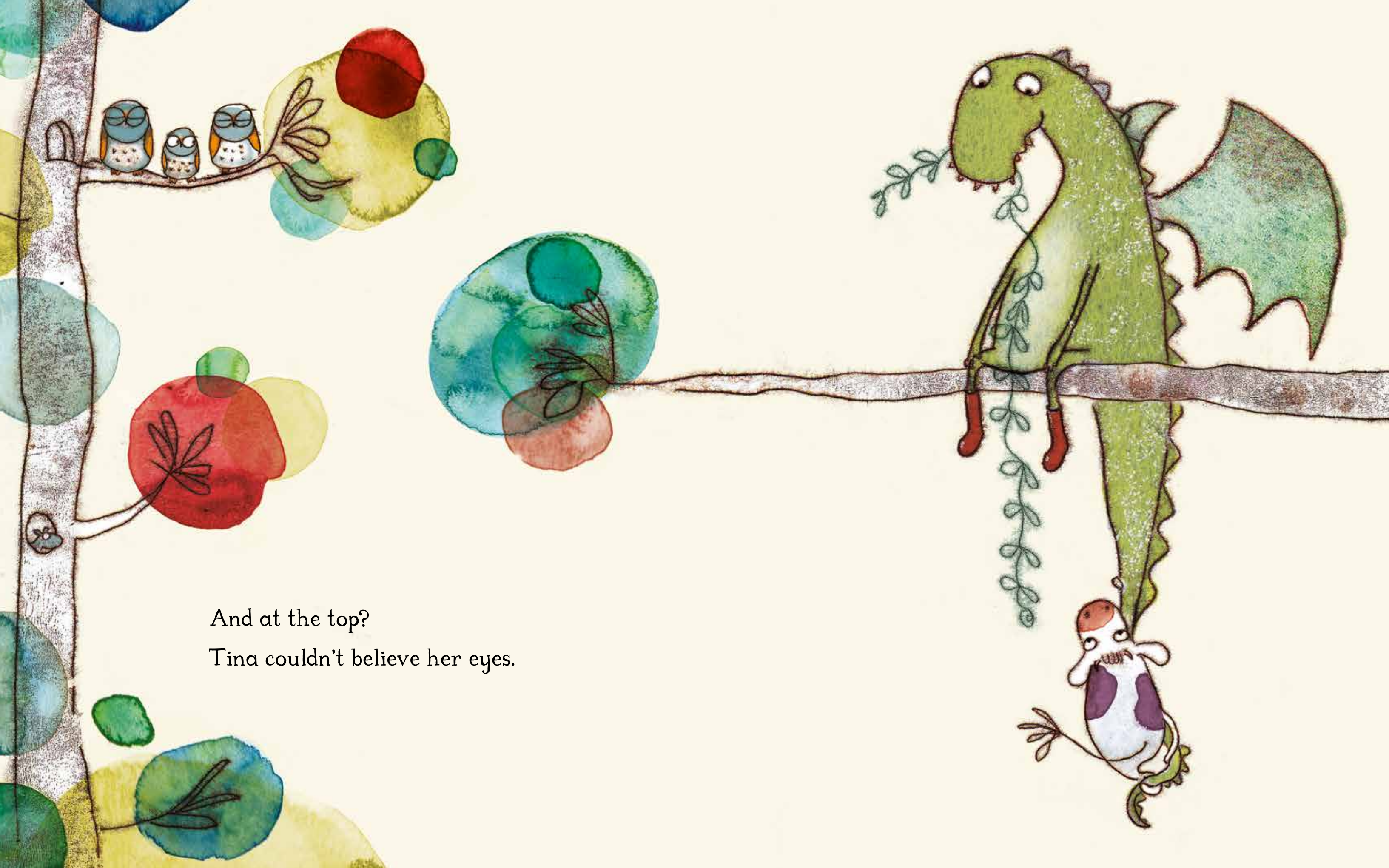
