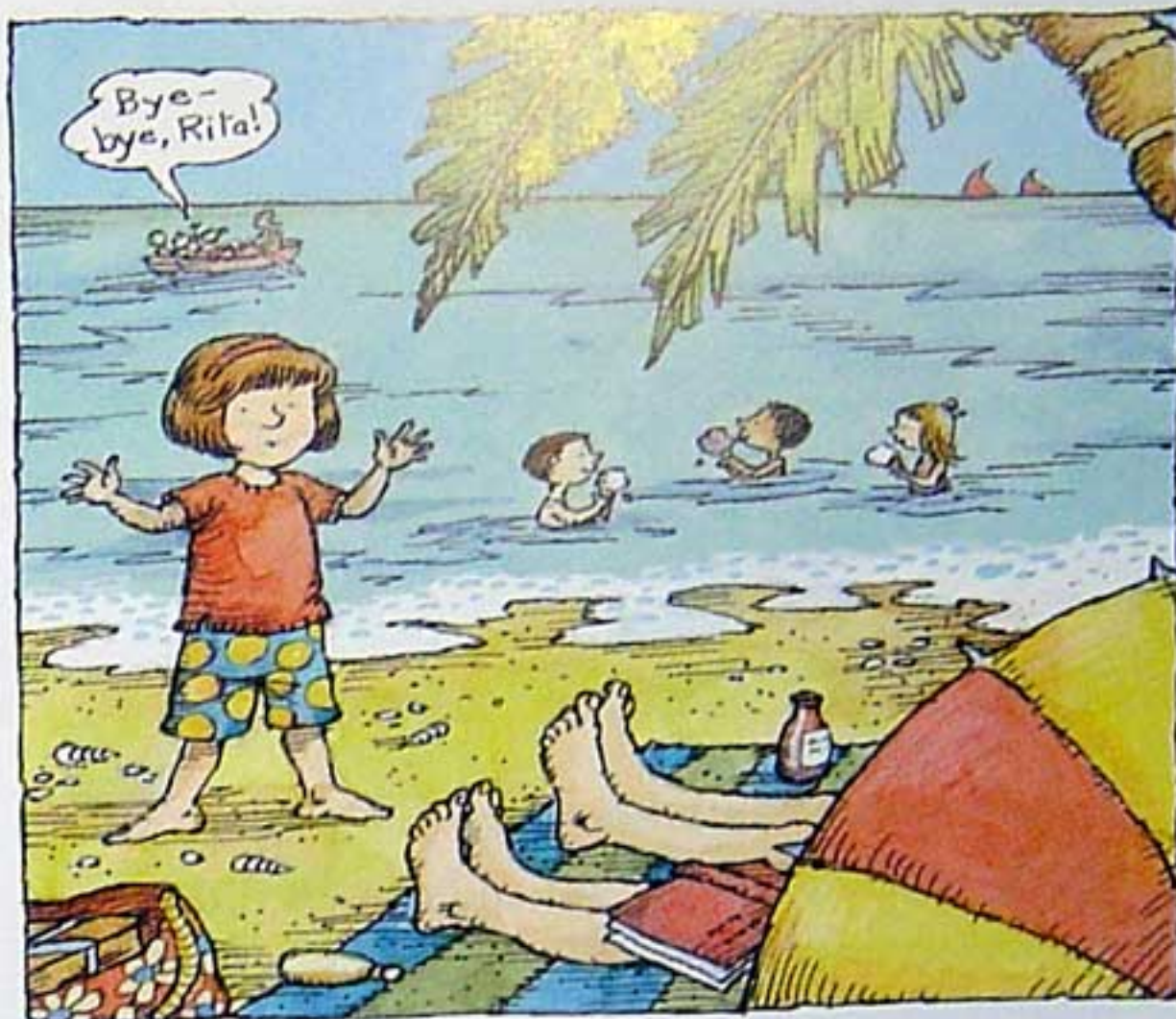

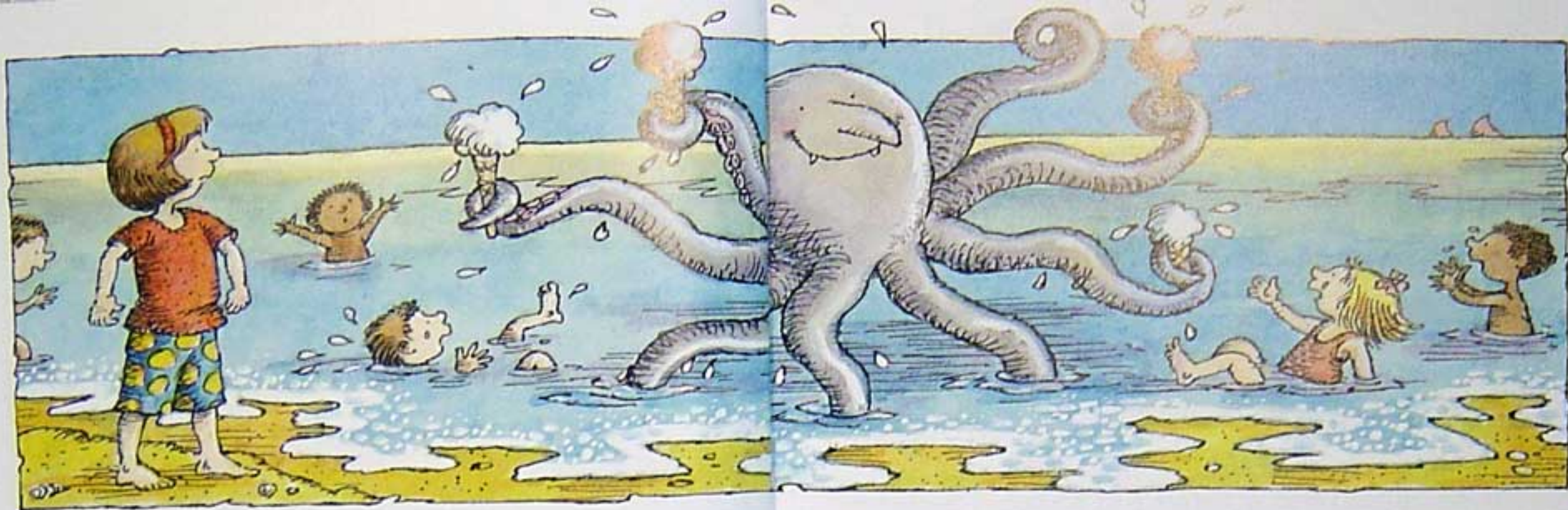
“It’s nice to be somewhere hot for a change,” said Mrs Potter.
