Bobby and Bess used to pull heavy sledges before they retired. They now live a quieter life at Pine Lodge.

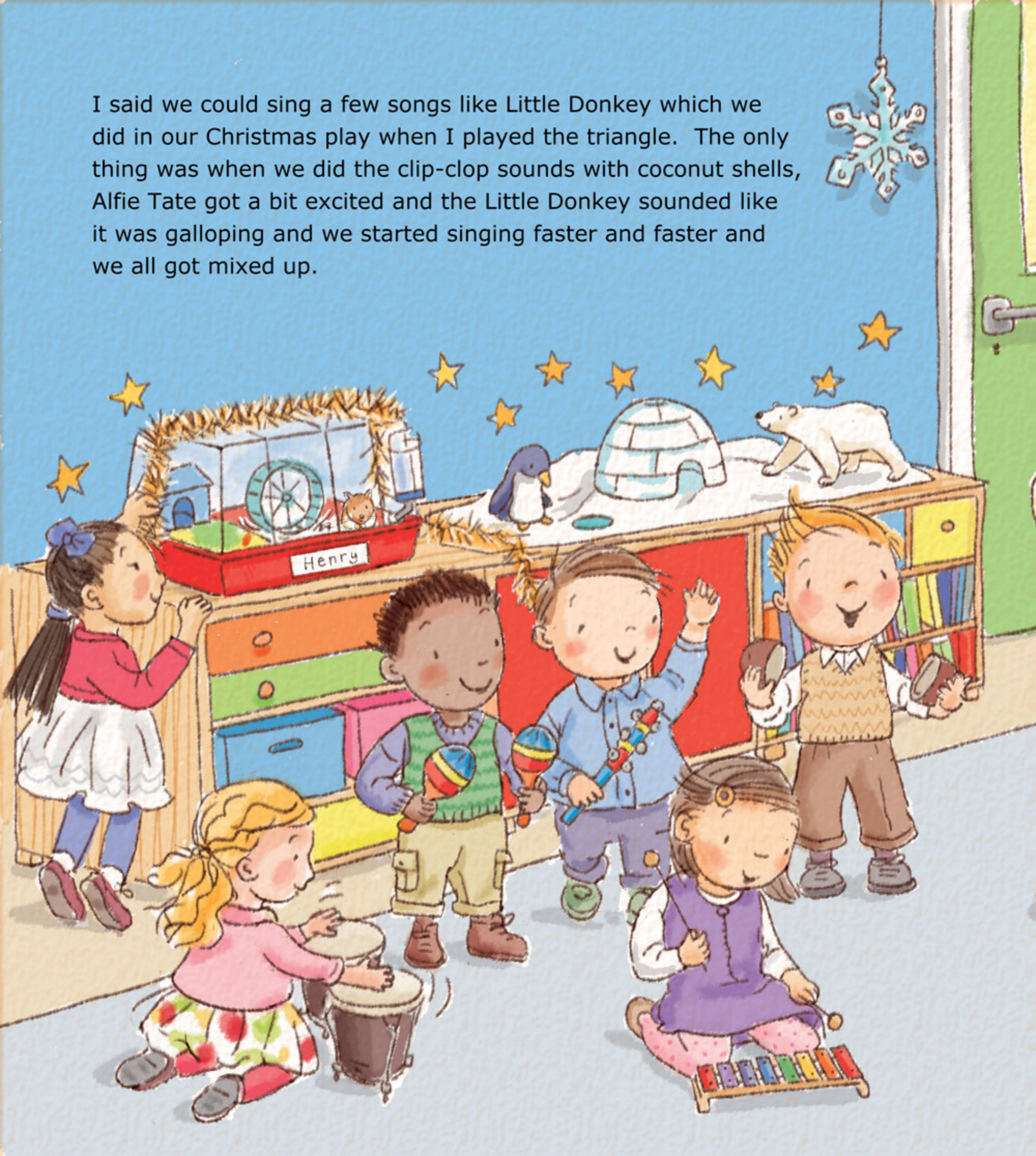
Bonnie
