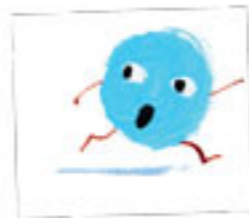

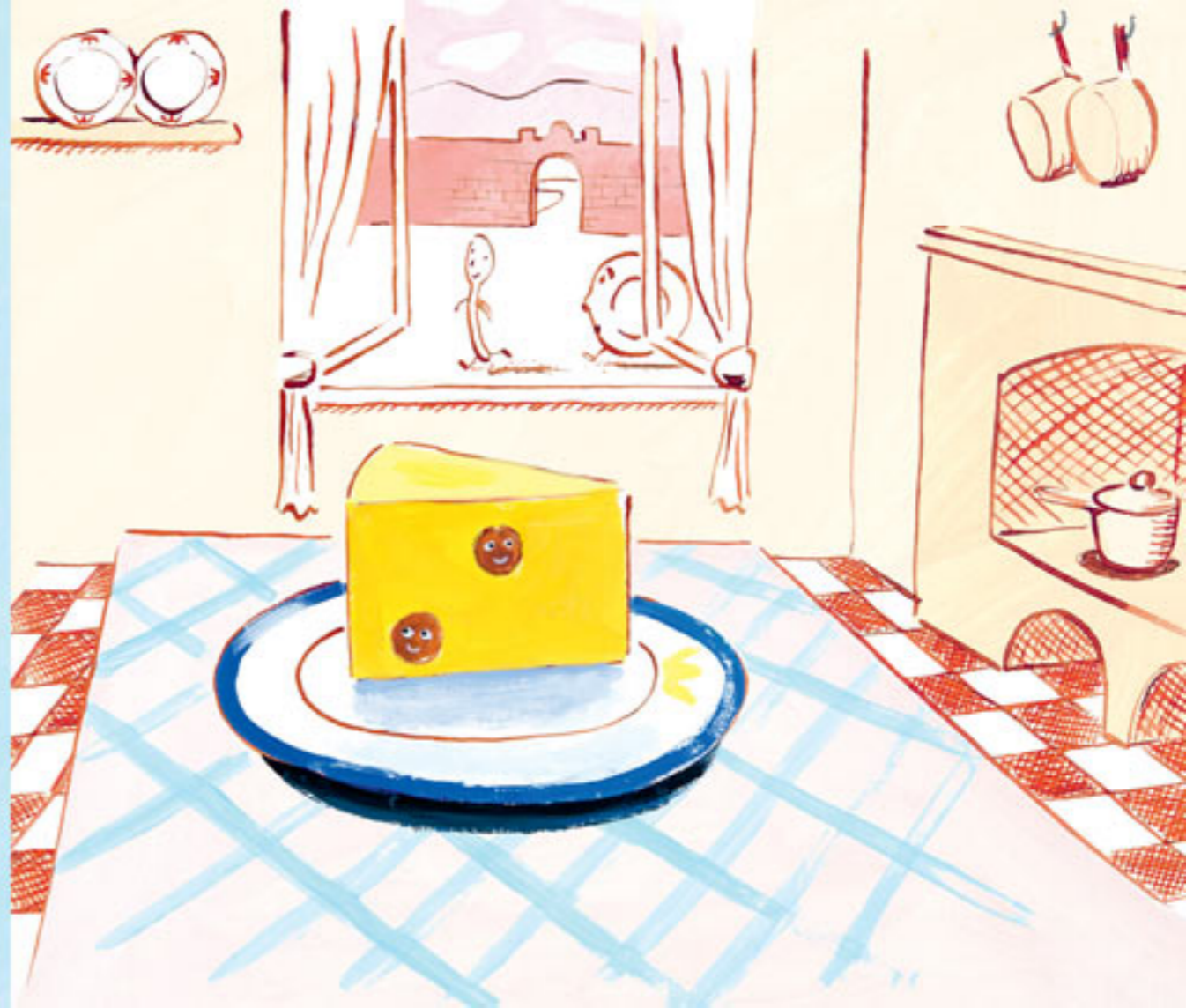

He called for the royal seamstress to darn his sock...

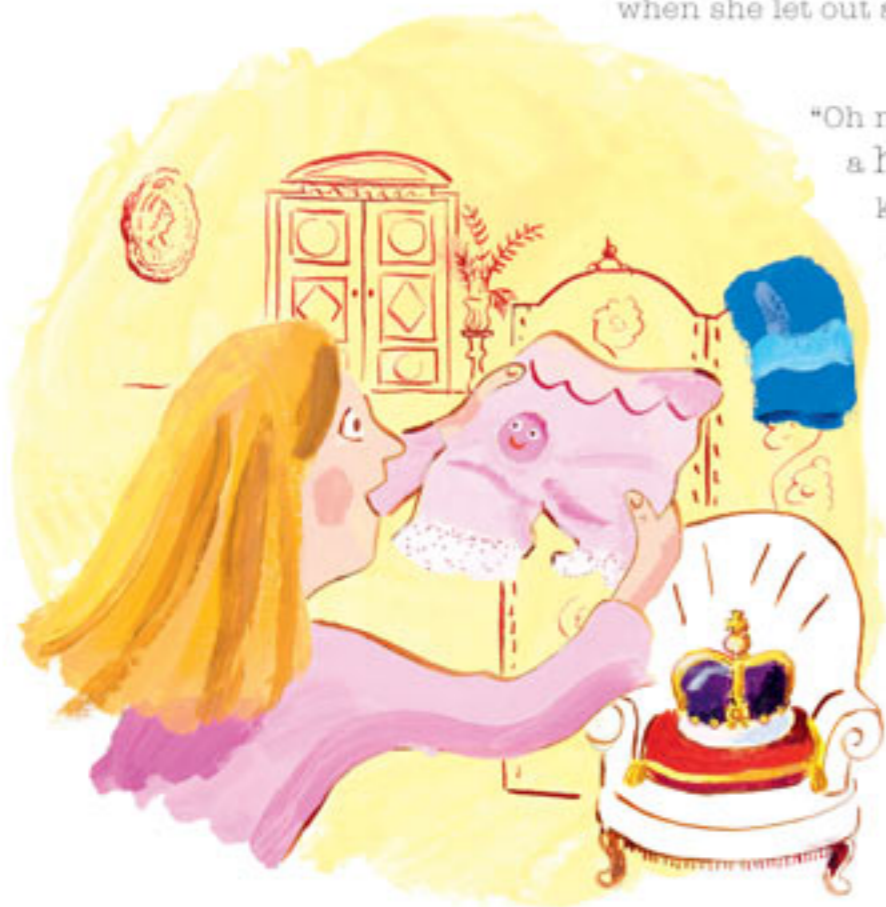


but by the time she arrived, Hamish Hole had gone.
