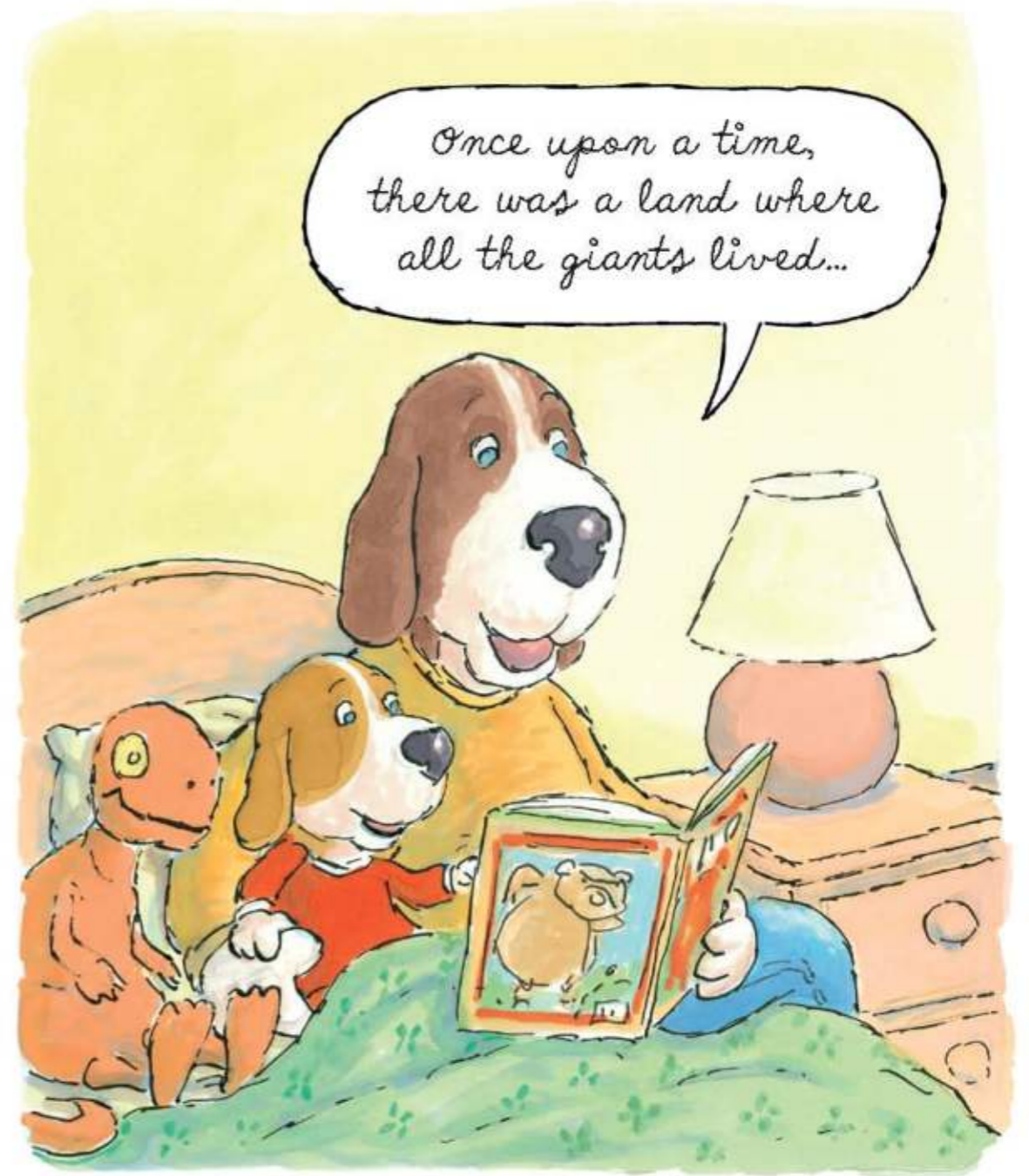

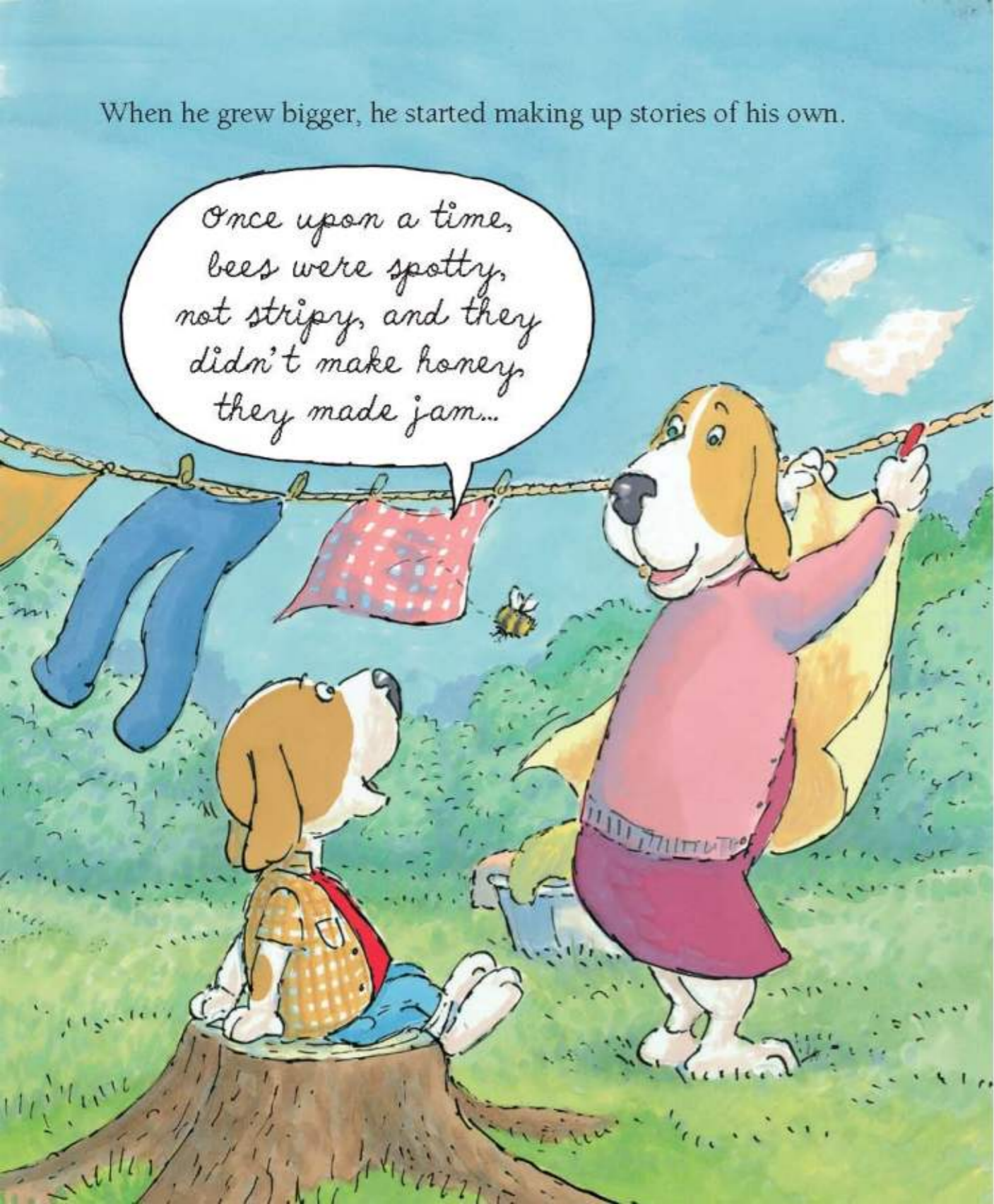

they made jam...



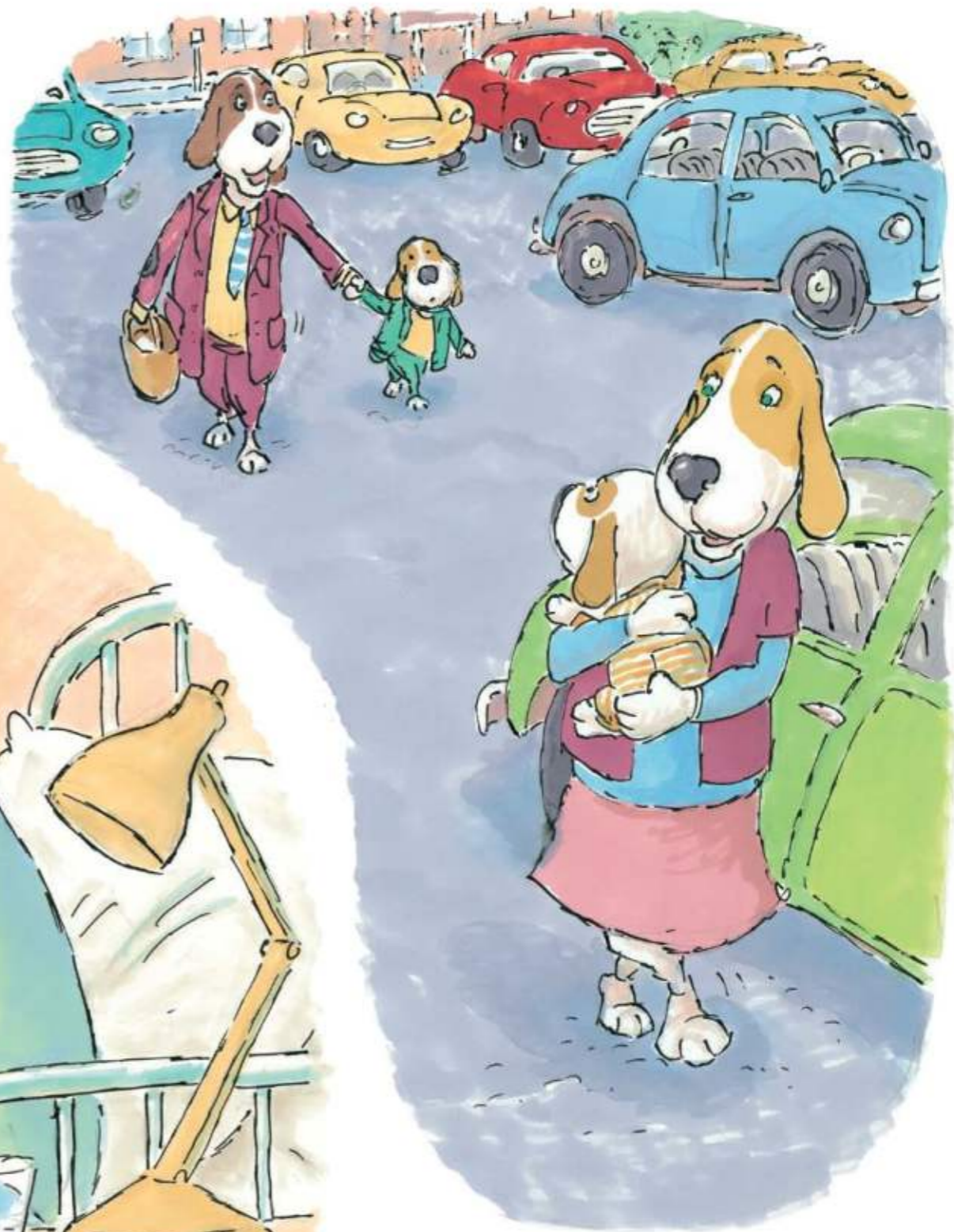
Once upon a time,

that ran on water...

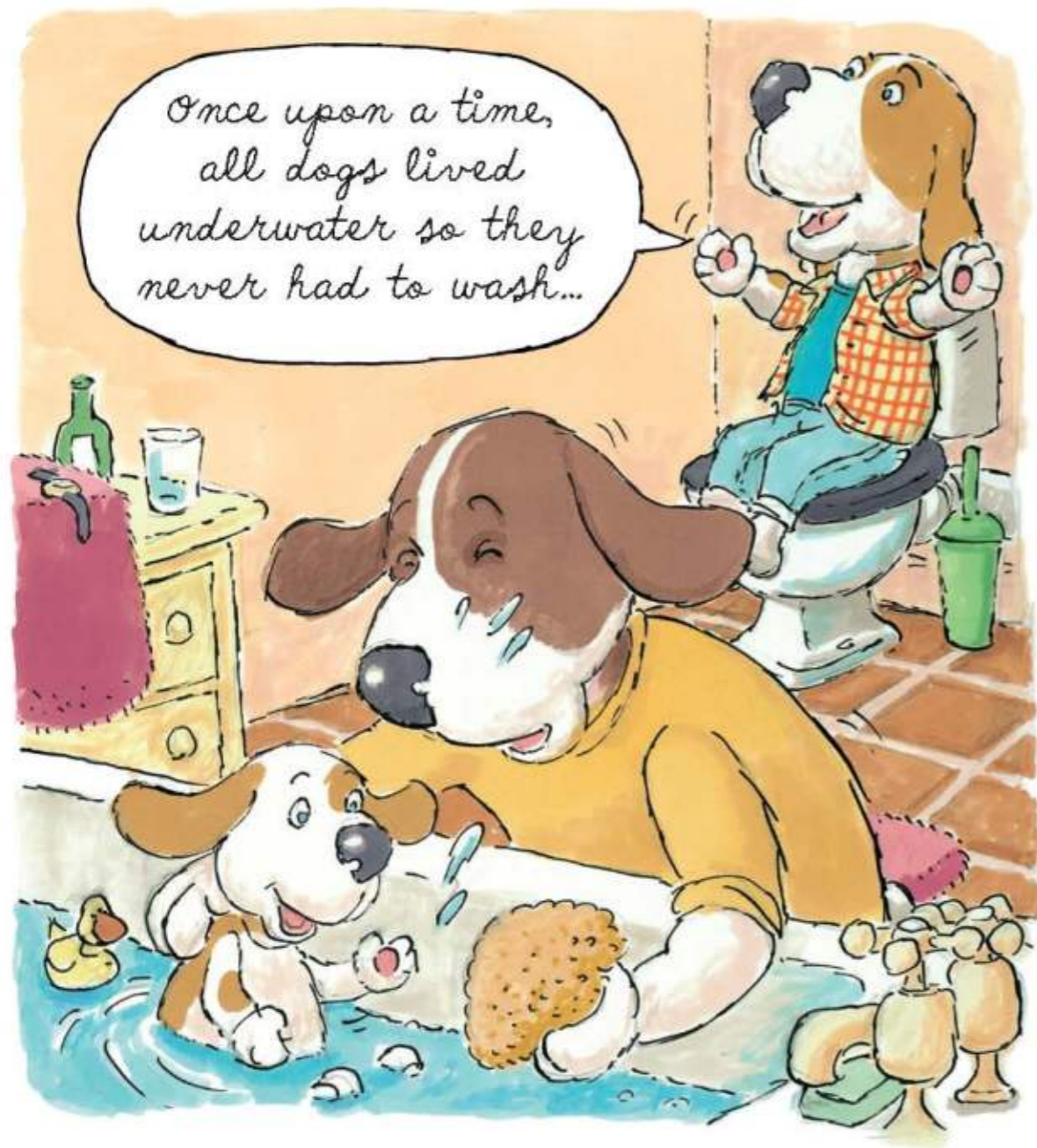


Albert's mum and dad loved to hear his stories,

That was the day that Little Henry arrived.

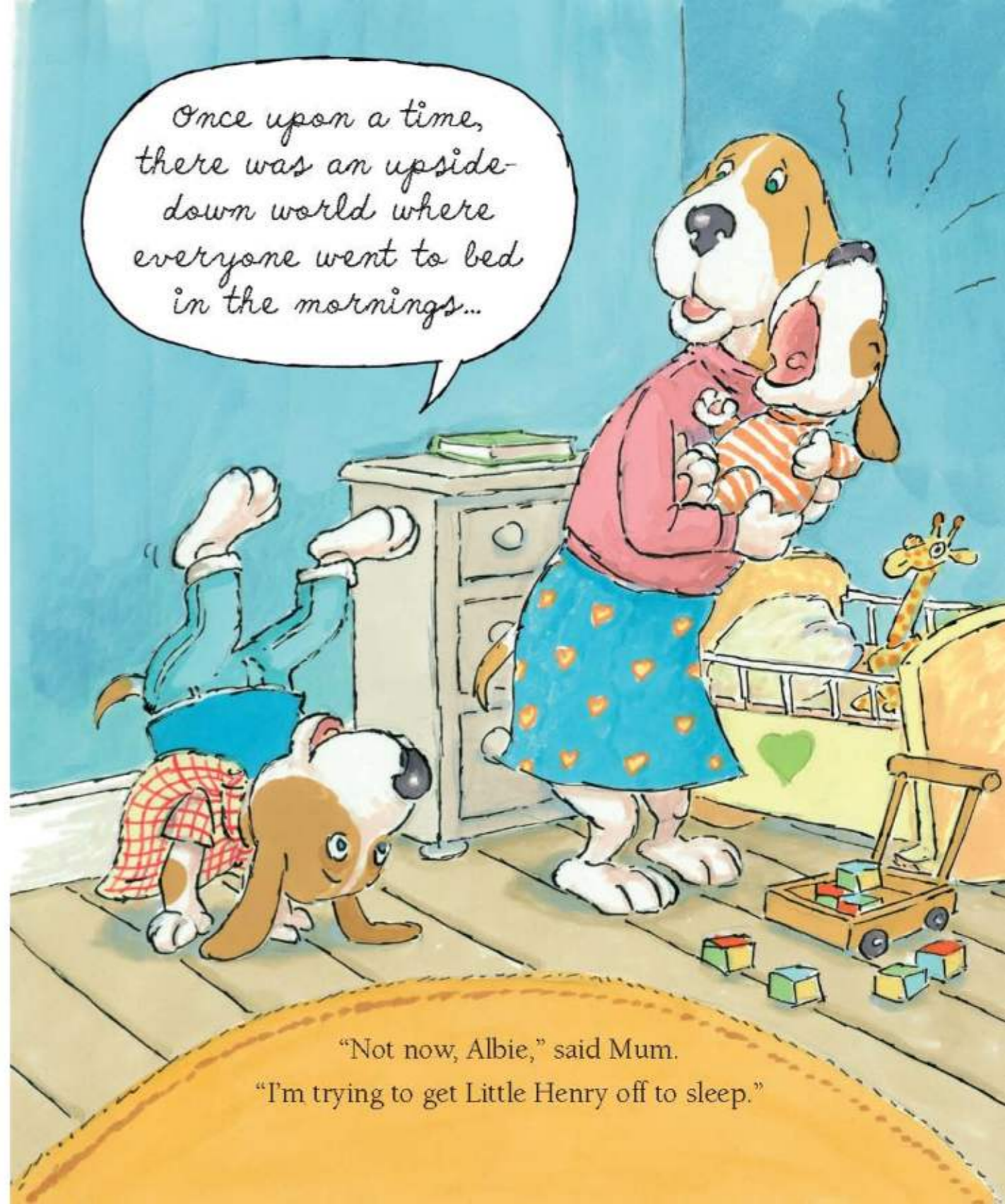
Say hello to Little Henry, Albert.





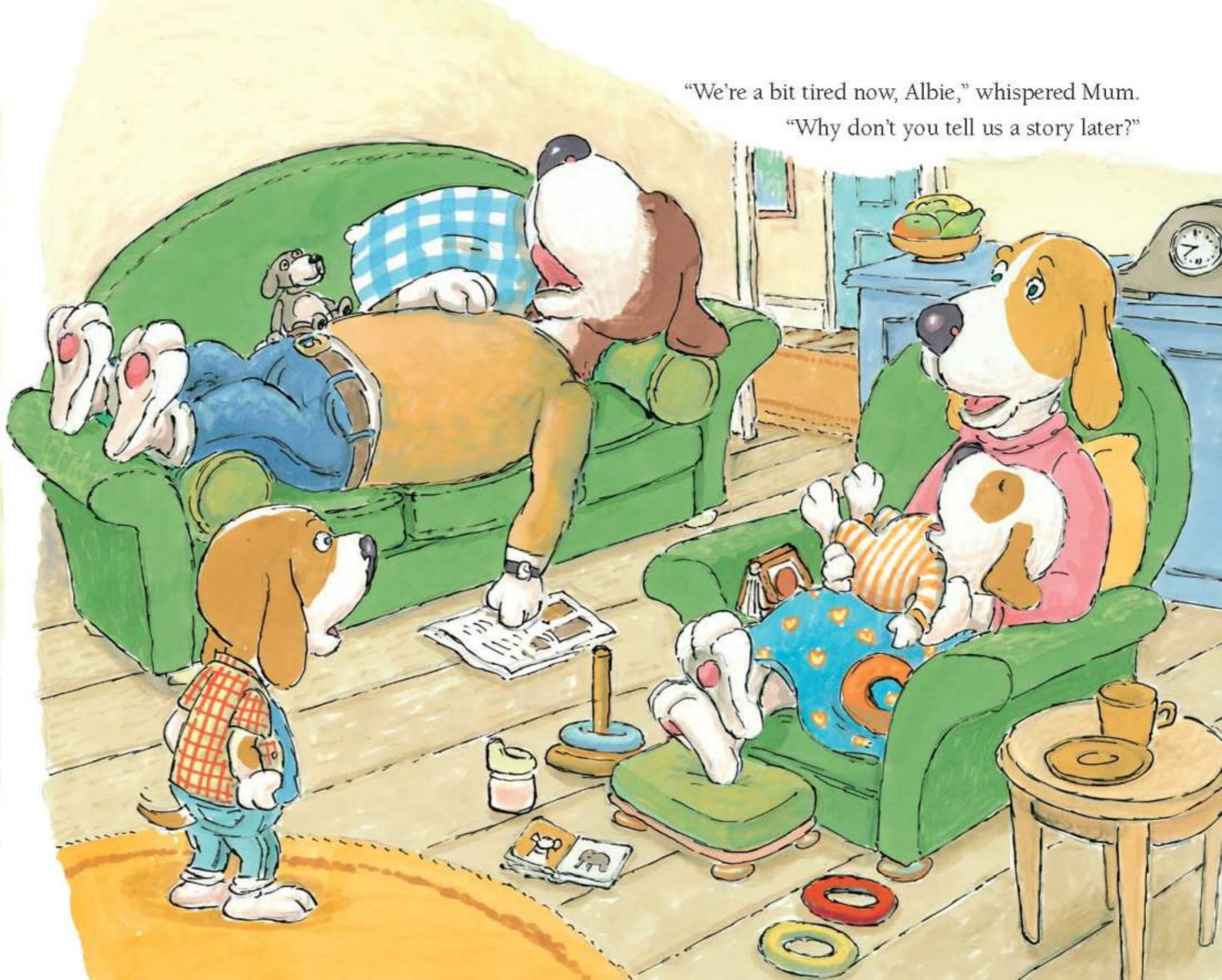
Once upon a time,
