"I know, why don't we try **dancey-dancing** like this?" said Ruby.

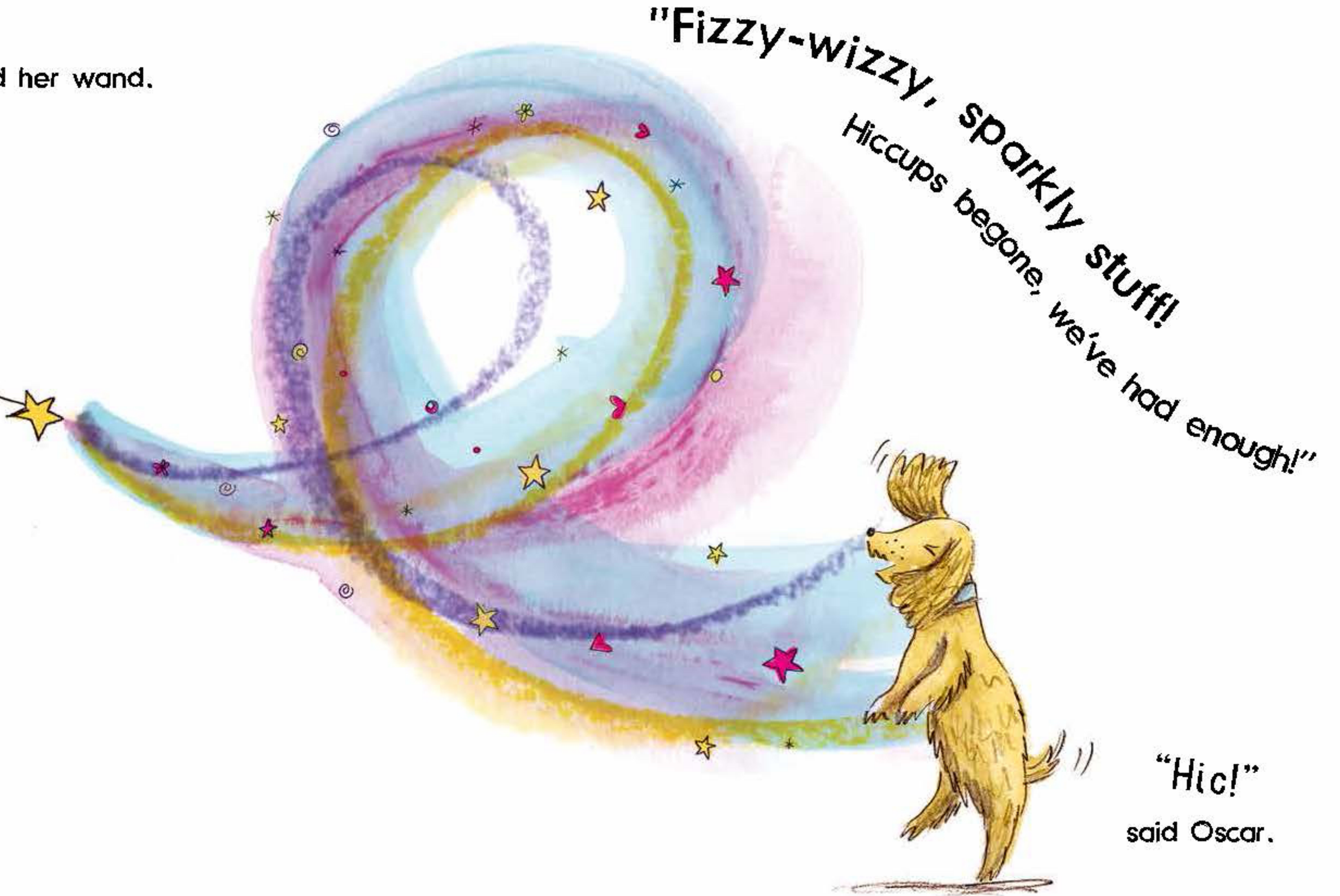


Oscar danced just like Ruby, but the hiccups did not stop.
