# Next steps

- Did the children know what a librarian was before they read this book? Do they know any librarians? Discuss what a librarian does.
- In the story, Evan said he didn't like books. But in the end, he discovered some that he loved. What made him like books? Have the children ever thought they didn't like something, and then found out they did after all?
- Evan liked the books about space best. What books do the children like best? Do they have a favourite author, illustrator or character? What is their favourite book at the moment?
- In the story, the library had a party that Rita organized as a surprise. Ask the children if they like surprises. What's the best surprise they can think of?
- Libraries contain books on almost anything you can think of. As a game, ask the children to suggest some things they'd like to make a book about, and then make up titles for these books. Then, as a follow-up activity, help the children to make the books.
