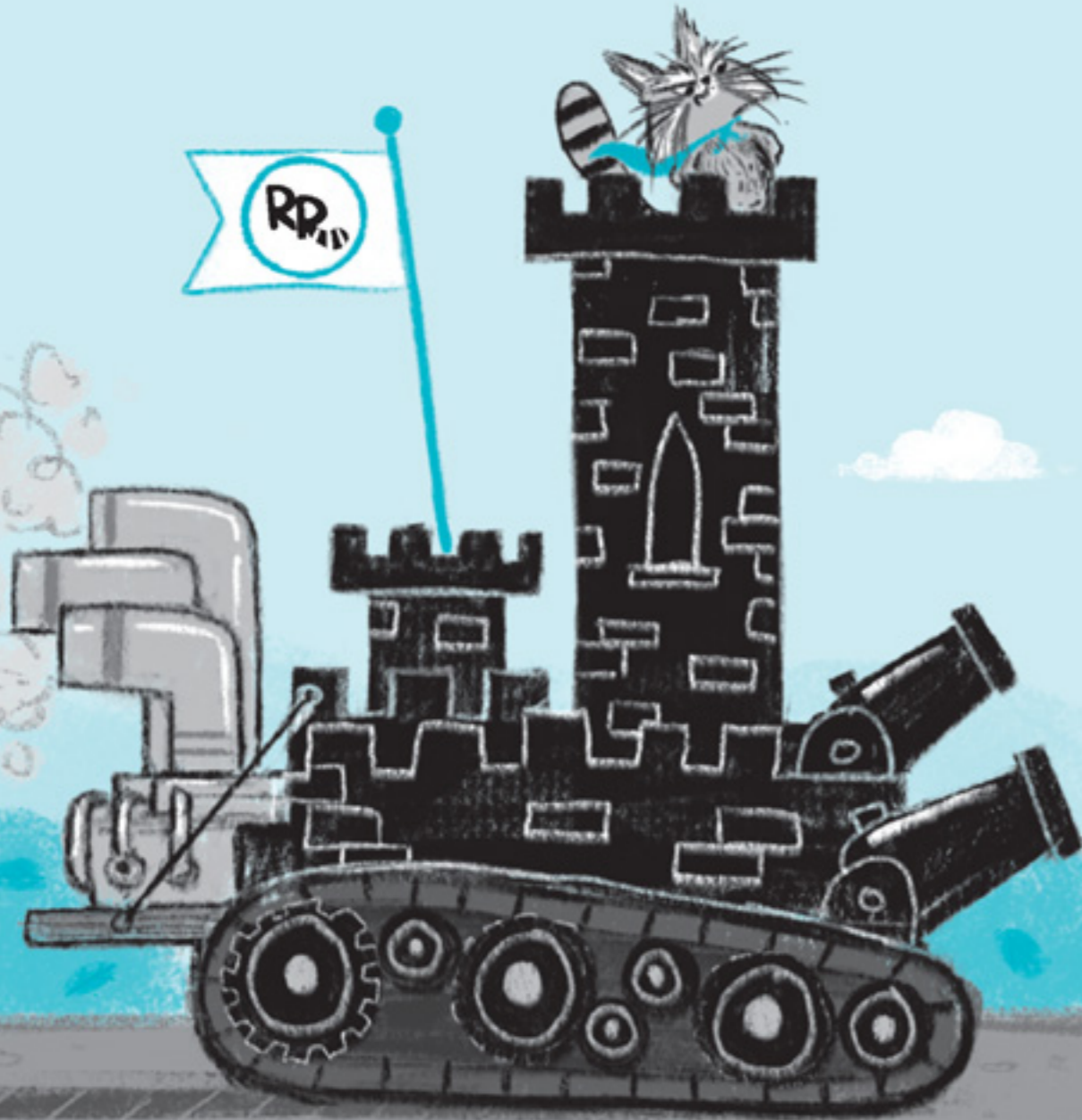
“Eeek!” gulped Sam.
