Biscuit sat down on the rug.

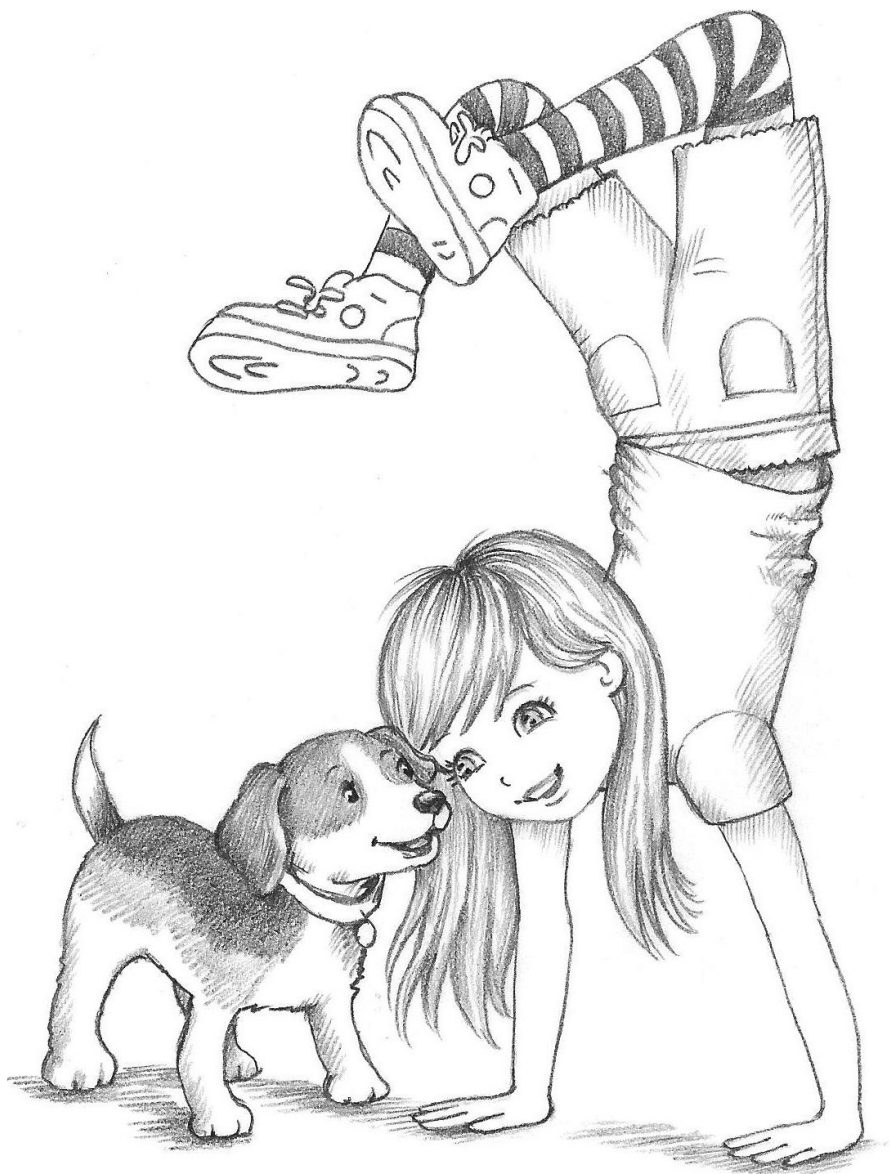
‘I’ll show you,’ said Lottie.
