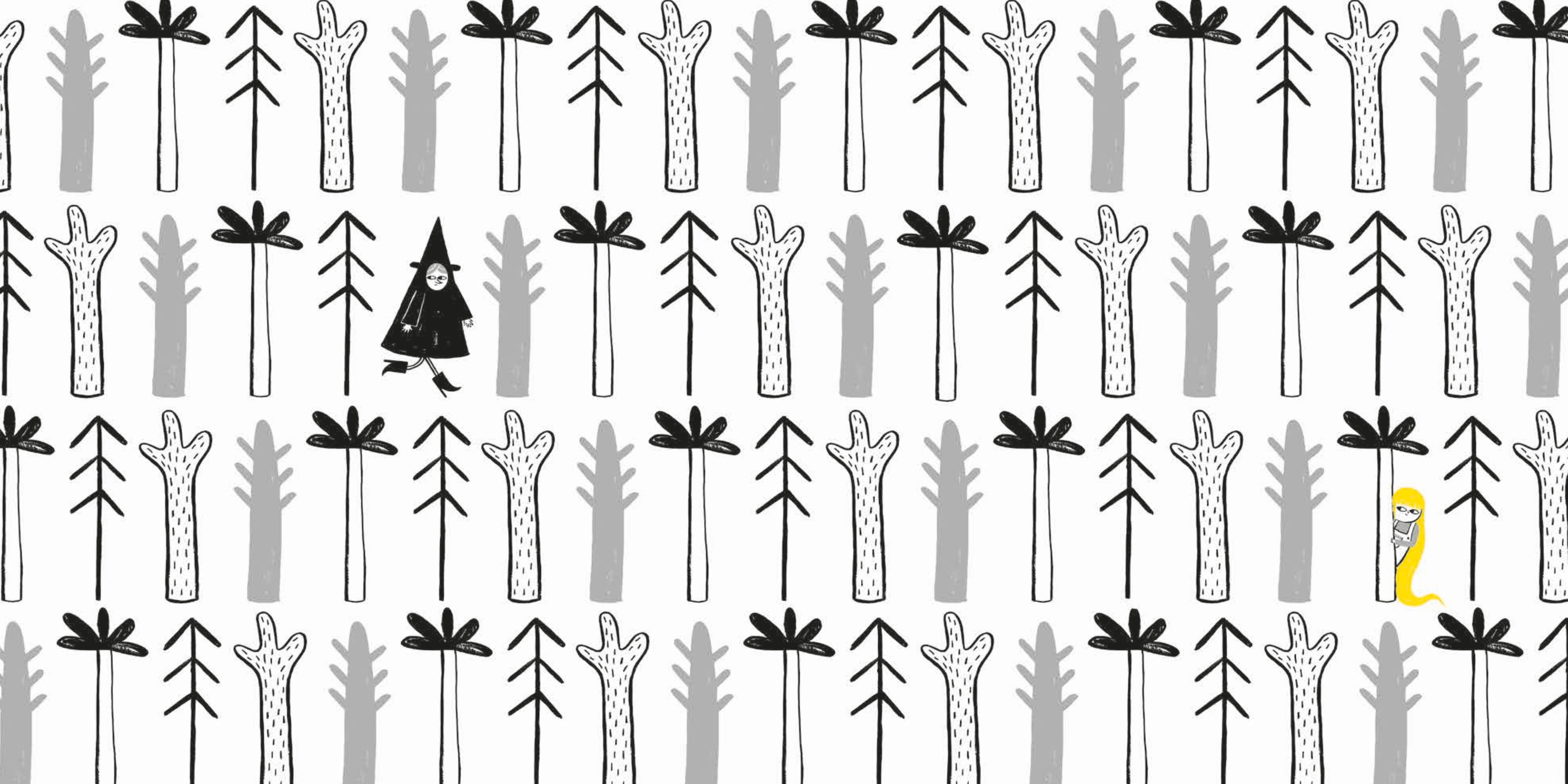

Then

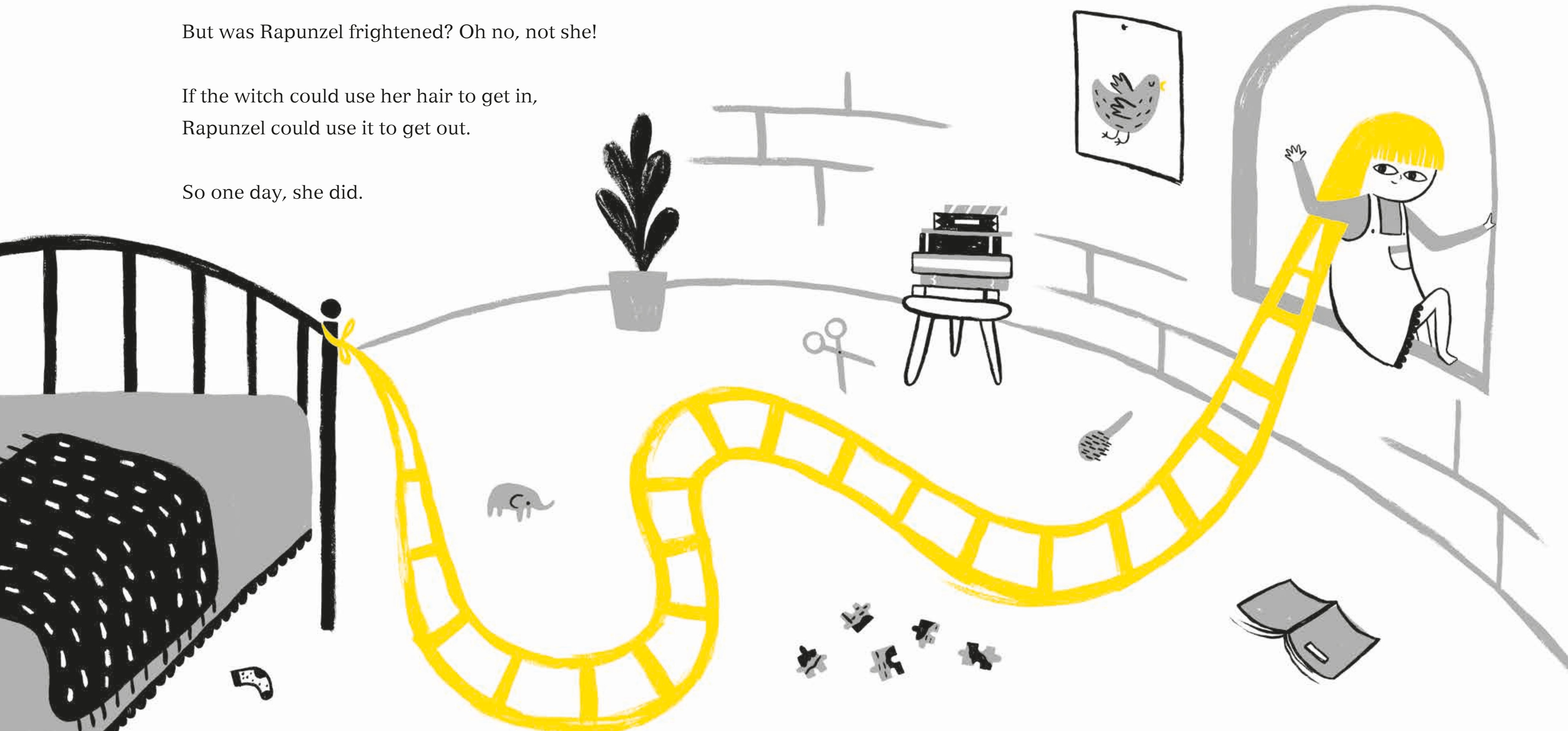
**SNIP,**
