Bird houses come in all shapes and sizes. They are usually wooden and provide a safe shelter for birds who are without a nest or need extra protection in the wild.

Birds may also struggle to find food or water when the temperature drops or if trees are cut down. Let's have a look at the different ways we can help birds survive...





DUCK HOUSES are floating structures, found on lakes and ponds, or fixed shelters built on dry land.



Male ducks are called **DRAKES**.
