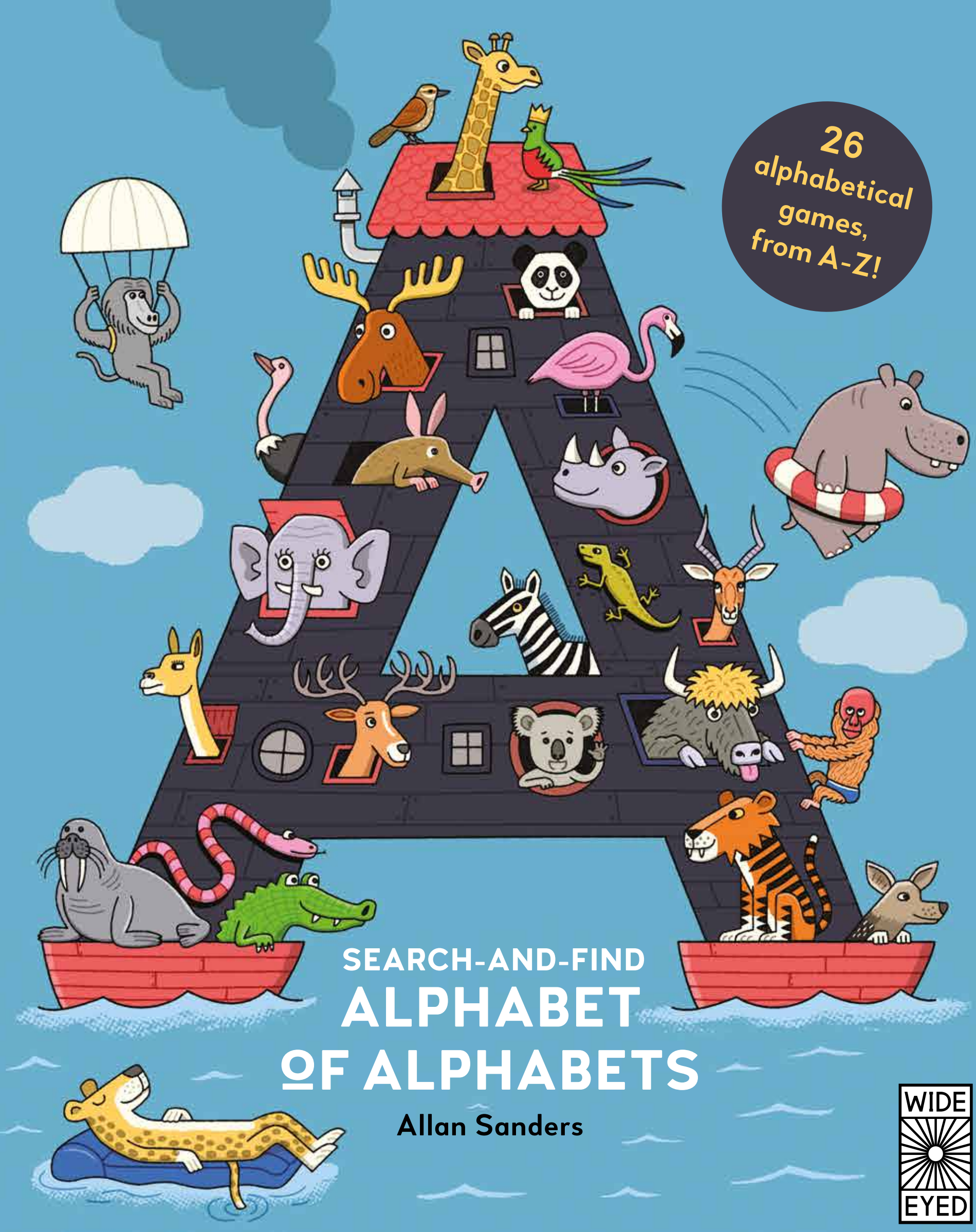

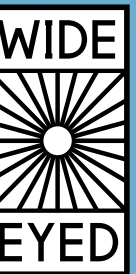

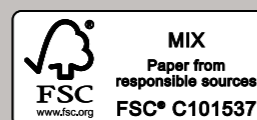

Over the following pages you'll find 26 different alphabets. One for each letter all the way from A to Z. There's an alphabet of birds for **B, a museum alphabet for **M**, an ocean alphabet for **O**... Are you getting the hang of it?**

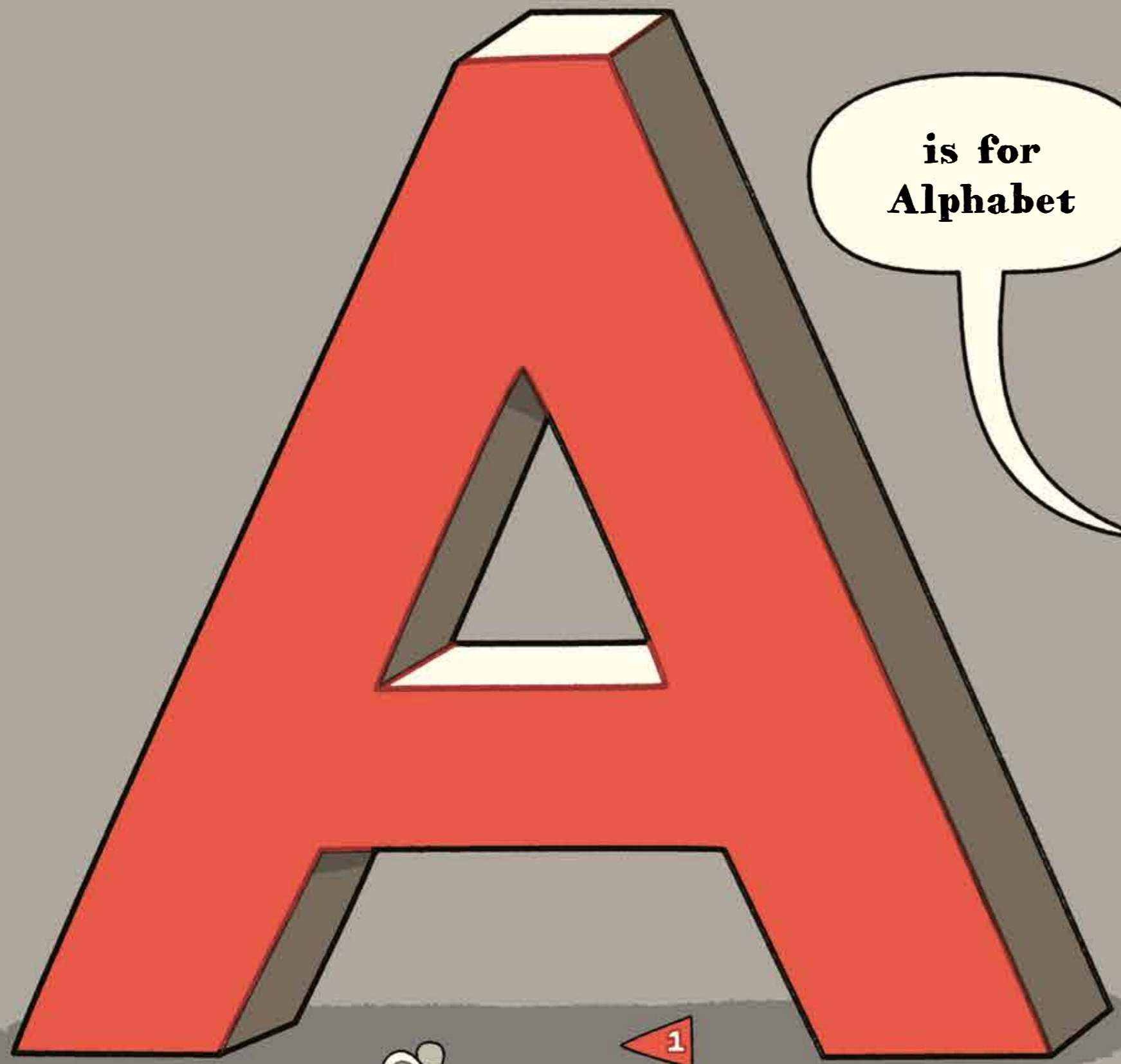
And in each one there's a complete **A to **Z** of things to find.**

Sometimes we give you a hand, by showing you what to look for, or giving you a list, sometimes you're on your own, and sometimes there's even two separate alphabets for you to discover in one picture. That means over 676 things to spot, so you're going to be busy.

But first, we have a confession to make. You may know that some letters - 'S**' for instance - have literally squillions of things beginning with them. Others, like **X**, or **Y**, or **Q** are a bit more tricky, so we've had to do a little bit of cheating. You'll find that the **X** words don't always start with **X** but have an **X** somewhere in them; **Q** is often for Queen and even if there's another **Q** word in the picture, Queenie (or her crown) are always there for you to find. Same goes for **U** - there's always a pair of underpants lurking around somewhere...**

Sometimes the letters are for things that people are saying (like "Yikes" or "Hurrah"). Sometimes the letters are for words written into the picture (like signs or labels). Sometimes the letters are for words you'll know and sometimes they're for weird stuff which you can find out about at the back of the book.

But whatever you come across, keep your eyes peeled and you'll be an expert Alphabetarian before you know it!
