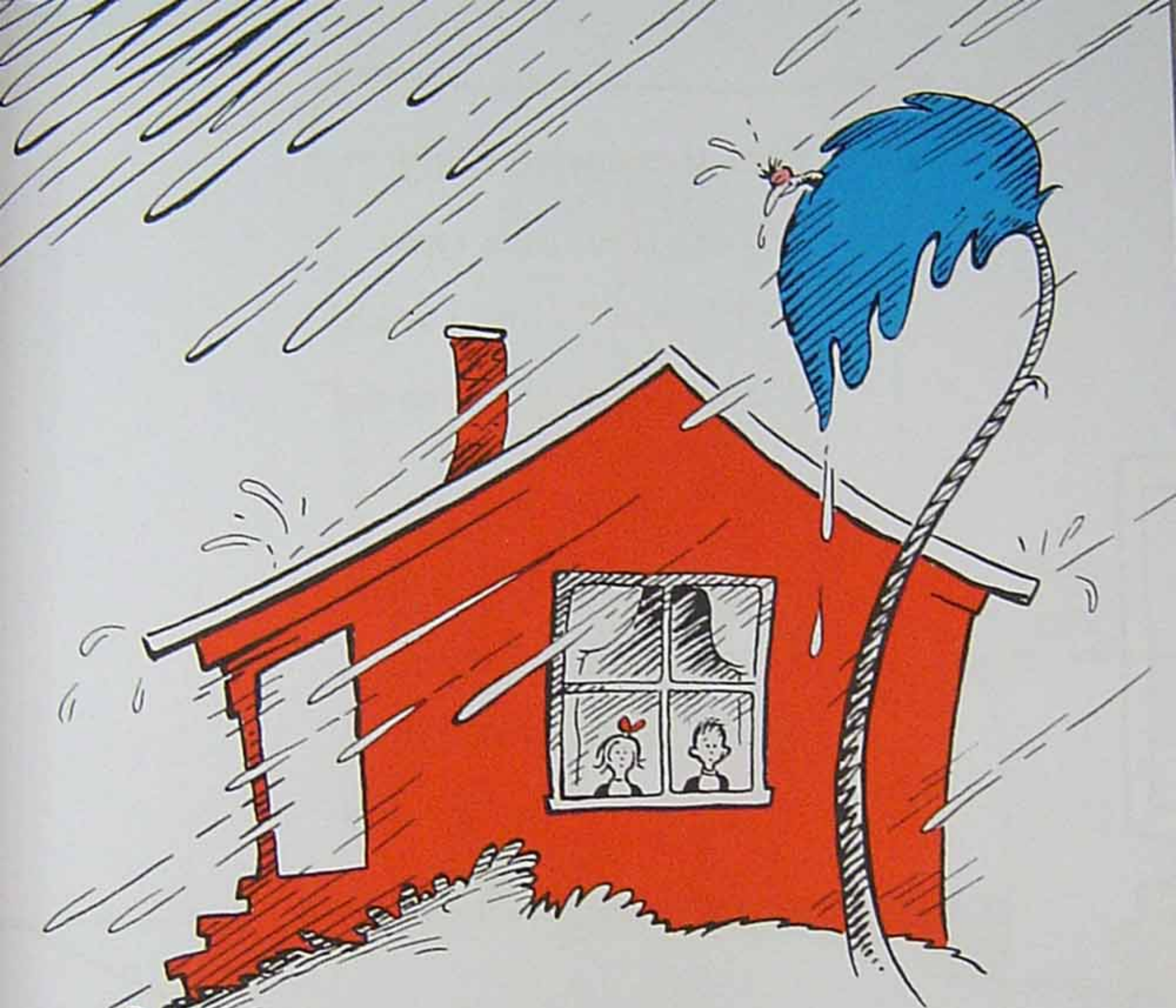

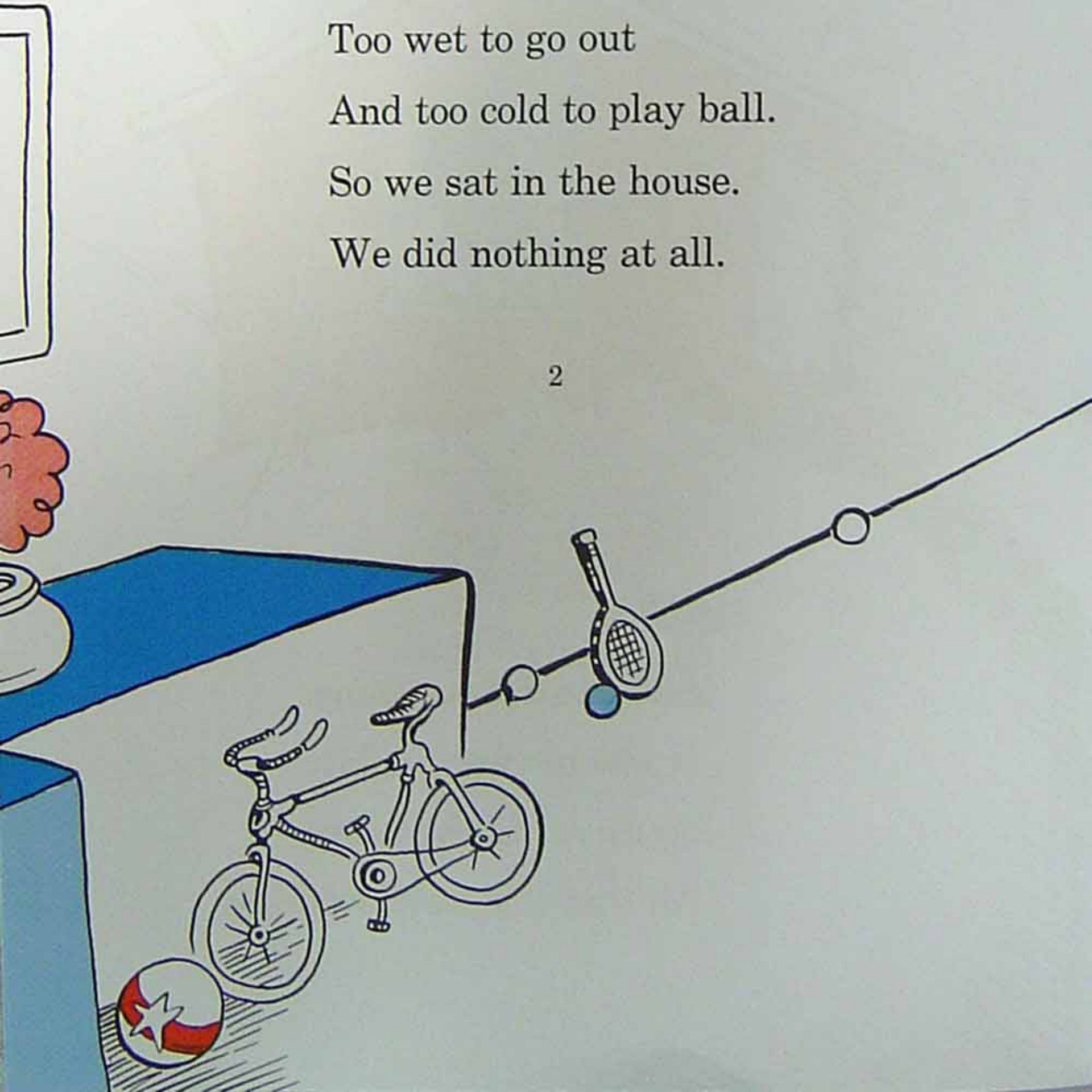


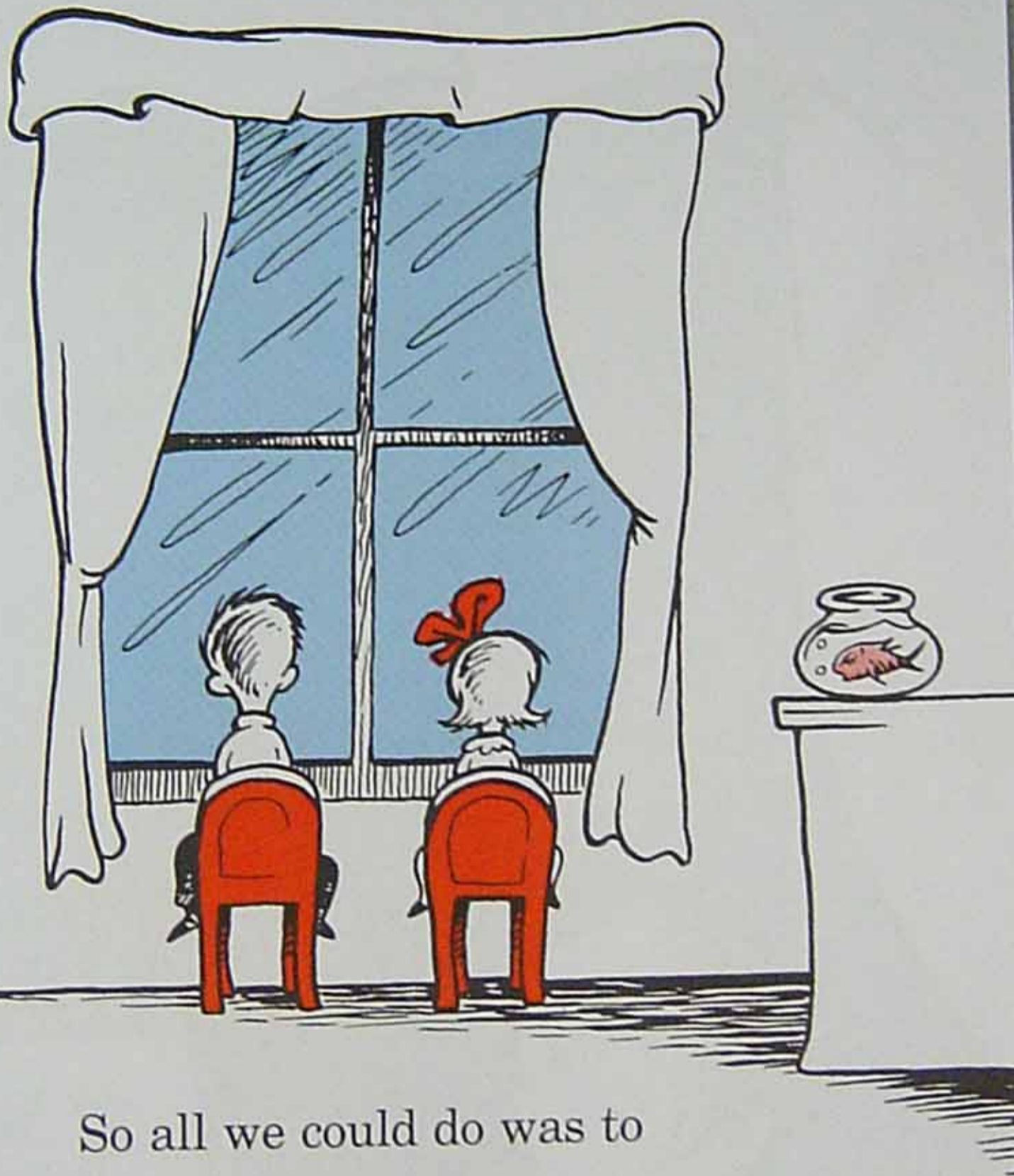
The sun did not shine.
