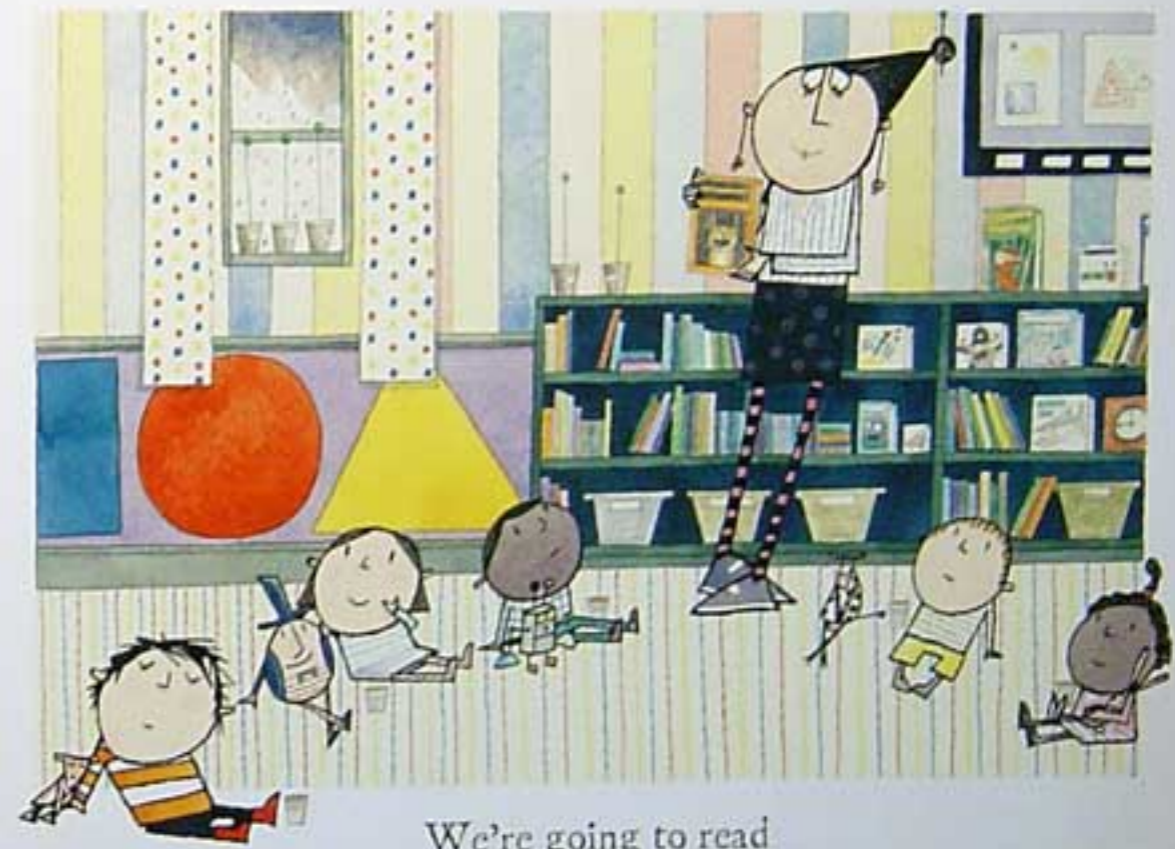


Looks like it's time for a story -
