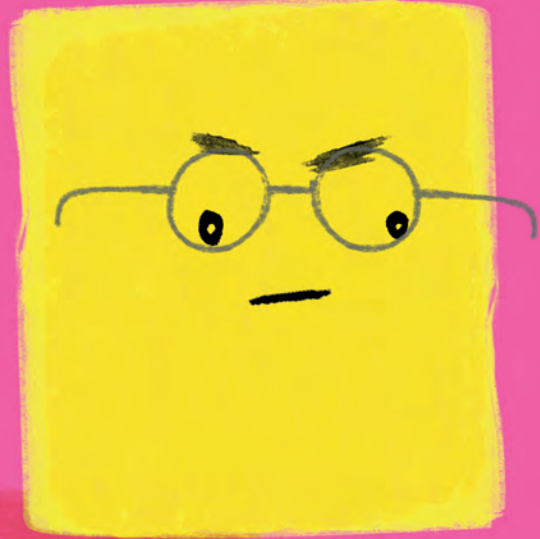

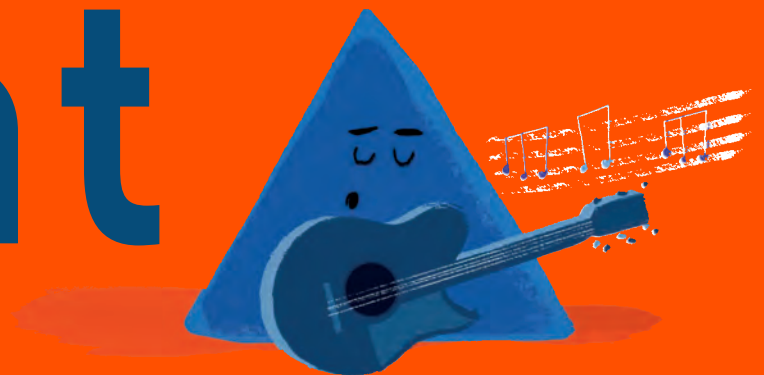

The Reds loved being red.



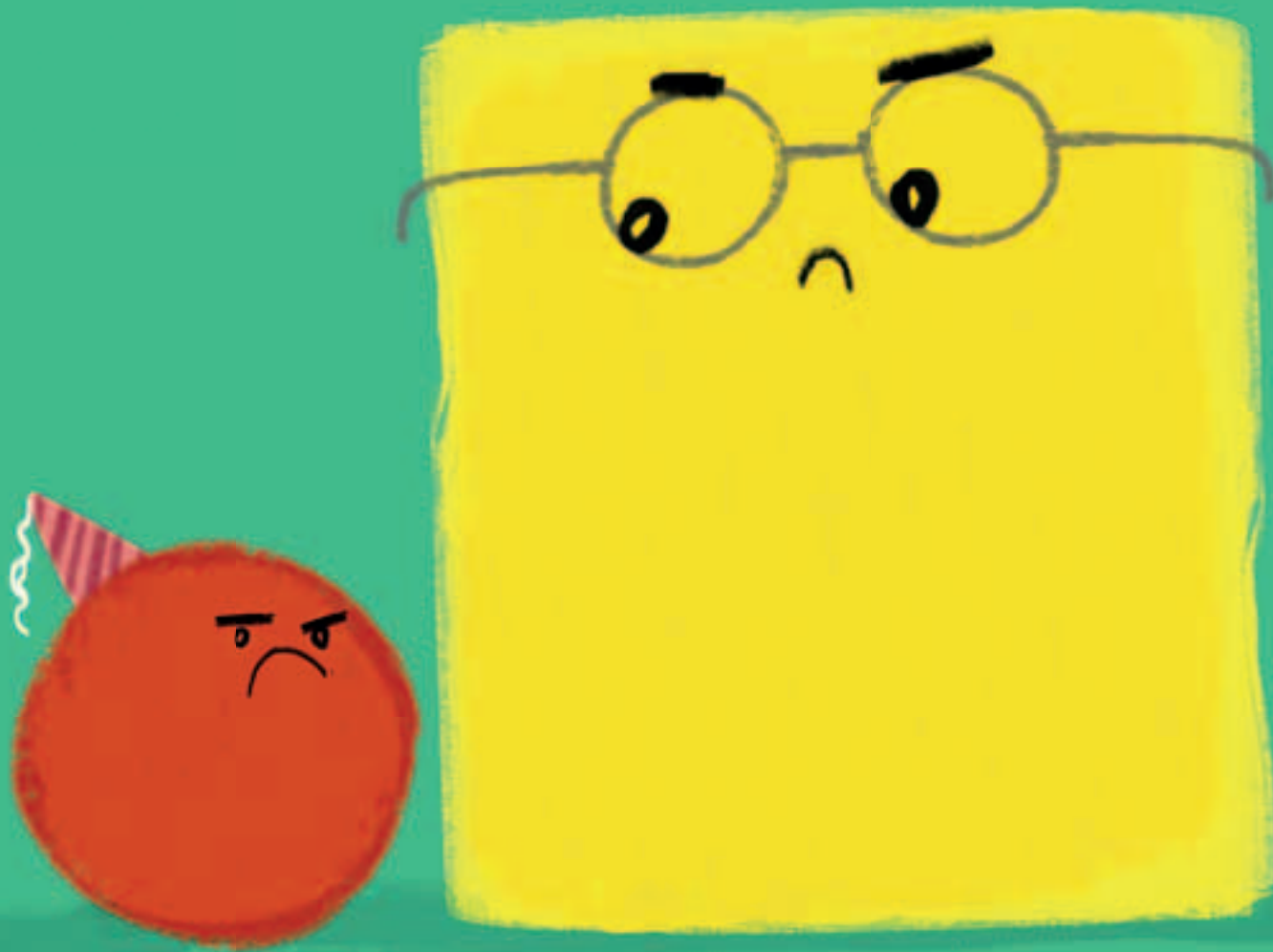
They wore **red hats**, sang **red songs**

along came a different.

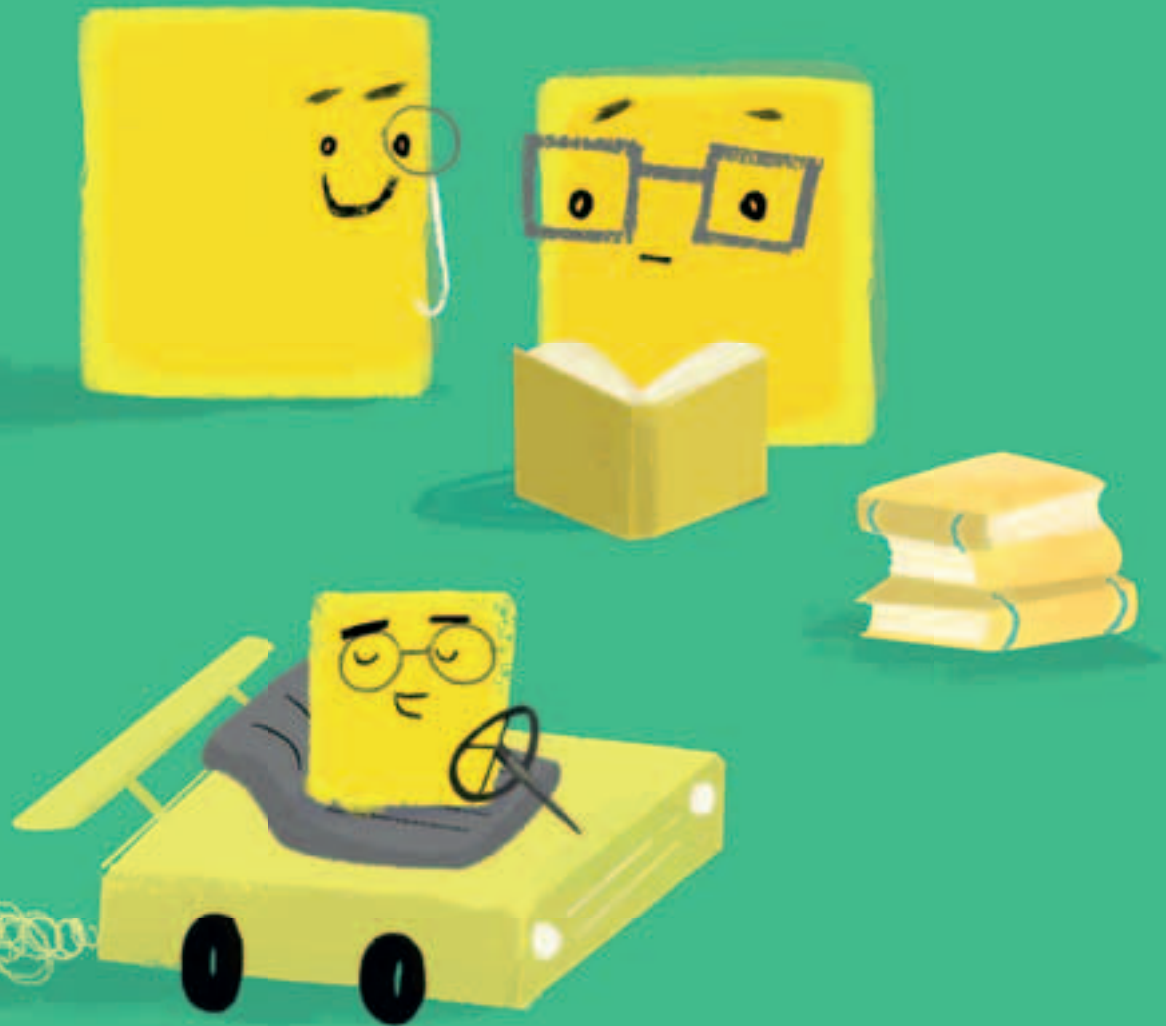


**The Yellows** loved being **yellow**.
