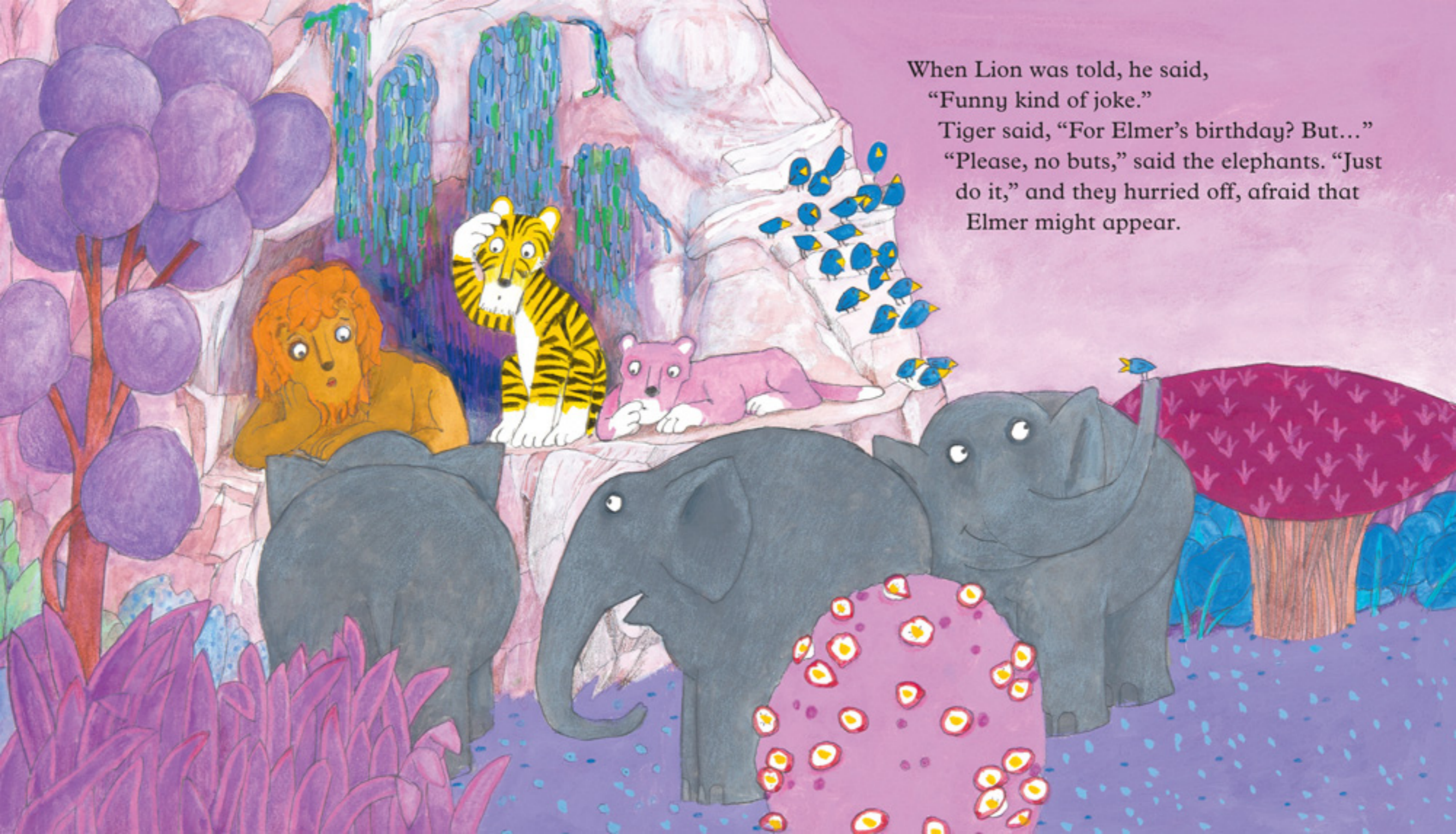
Elmer, the patchwork elephant, was walking a morning walk. He said, "Good morning," to a group of elephants and kept walking.
