Try this fabulous family craft activity for even more festive fun. These delightful and delicious decorations can be made using all locally sourced materials.

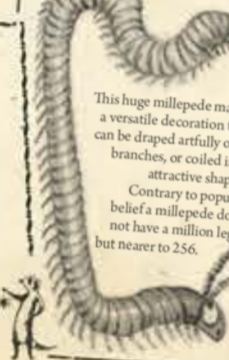


HOW TO

1. Gather as many bags as you want (be aware: if you try this activity with the kits, expect them to eat more than they serve!).
2. Find an attractive nearby tree or cactus to decorate.
3. Place each bag on the tree (you may need to give each a little food to tempt them to stay put).
4. Feed to the kits as fun-sized snacks when boredom strikes (usually once grown-ups get talking).

Millipedes (Class: ones!)

This huge millipede makes a versatile decoration that can be draped artfully over branches, or curled into attractive shapes. Contrary to popular belief a millipede does not have a million legs, but nearer to 256.



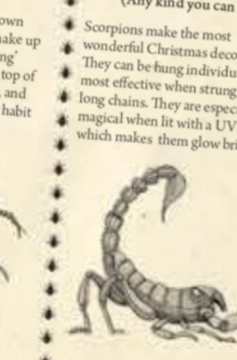
Toktokkies (Peg-boring Beetle)

What these black or dark brown beetles lack in colour they make up for with their pleasant 'bucking' noise. They can be found on top of sand dunes in foggy weather, and are easily recognised by their habit of standing on their heads.



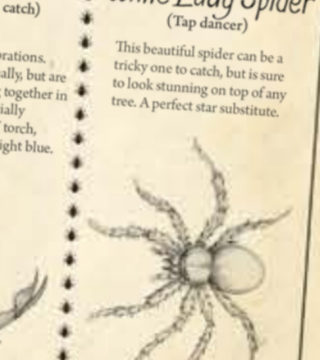
Scorpion (Any kind you can catch)

Scorpions make the most wonderful Christmas decorations. They can be hung individually, but are most effective when strung together in long chains. They are especially magical when lit with a UV torch, which makes them glow bright blue.



White Lady Spider (Tap dancer)

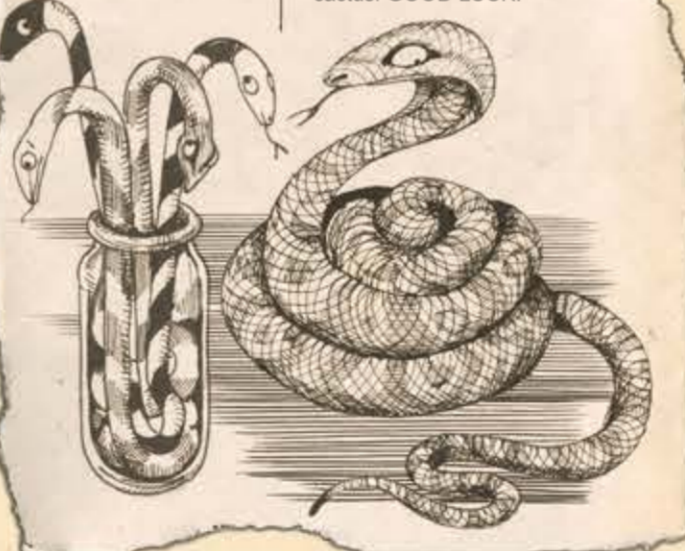
This beautiful spider can be a tricky one to catch, but is sure to look stunning on top of any tree. A perfect star substitute.



KALAHARI CANDY CANES

Home-made Xmas treats - healthier, yet cheaper!

- Serves 25**
25 assorted snakes (whatever variety you can catch)
- 1 tin (edible) red paint
 - 1 tin (edible) white paint
 - 2 paint brushes



Begin by catching all 25 snakes and securing them in a basket with a tight-fitting lid. Holding each snake tightly paint first with white paint. You may need two coats to fully cover. Once dry, paint the white snakes with red diagonal stripes. Bend each snake into a candy cane shape and hang on tree or cactus. GOOD LUCK!



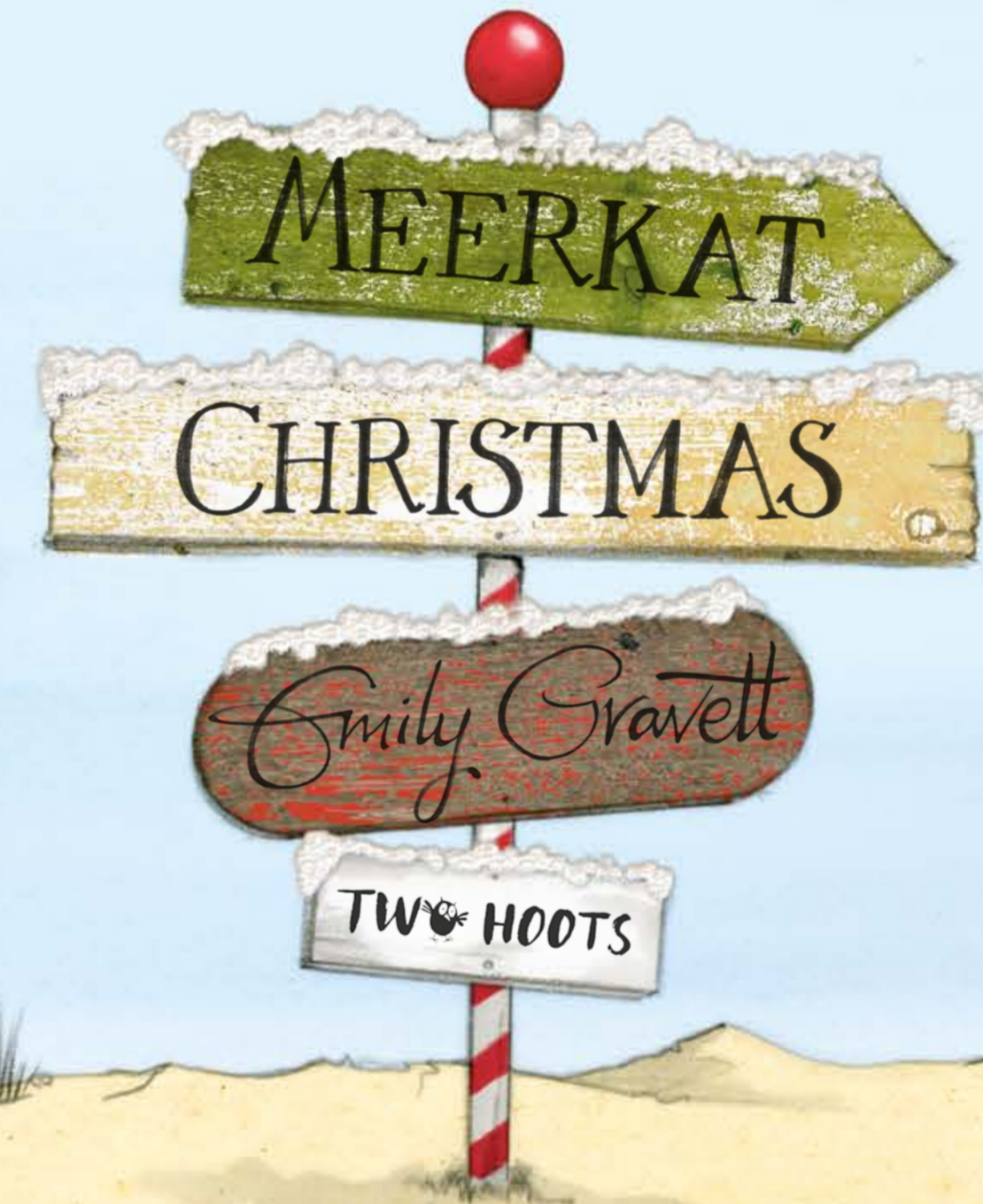
