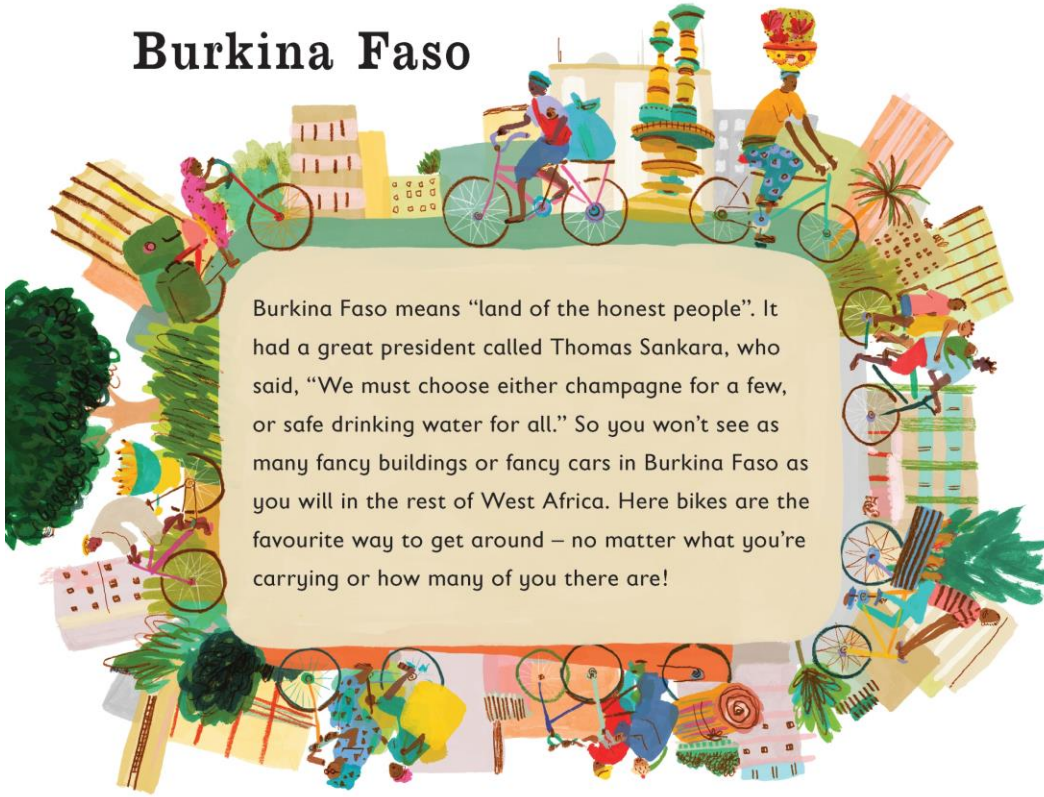
Africa is donkeys and diamonds, camels and Coca-Cola, Lamborghinis and lions, oil-rigs and armies, football and voodoo, and more...
