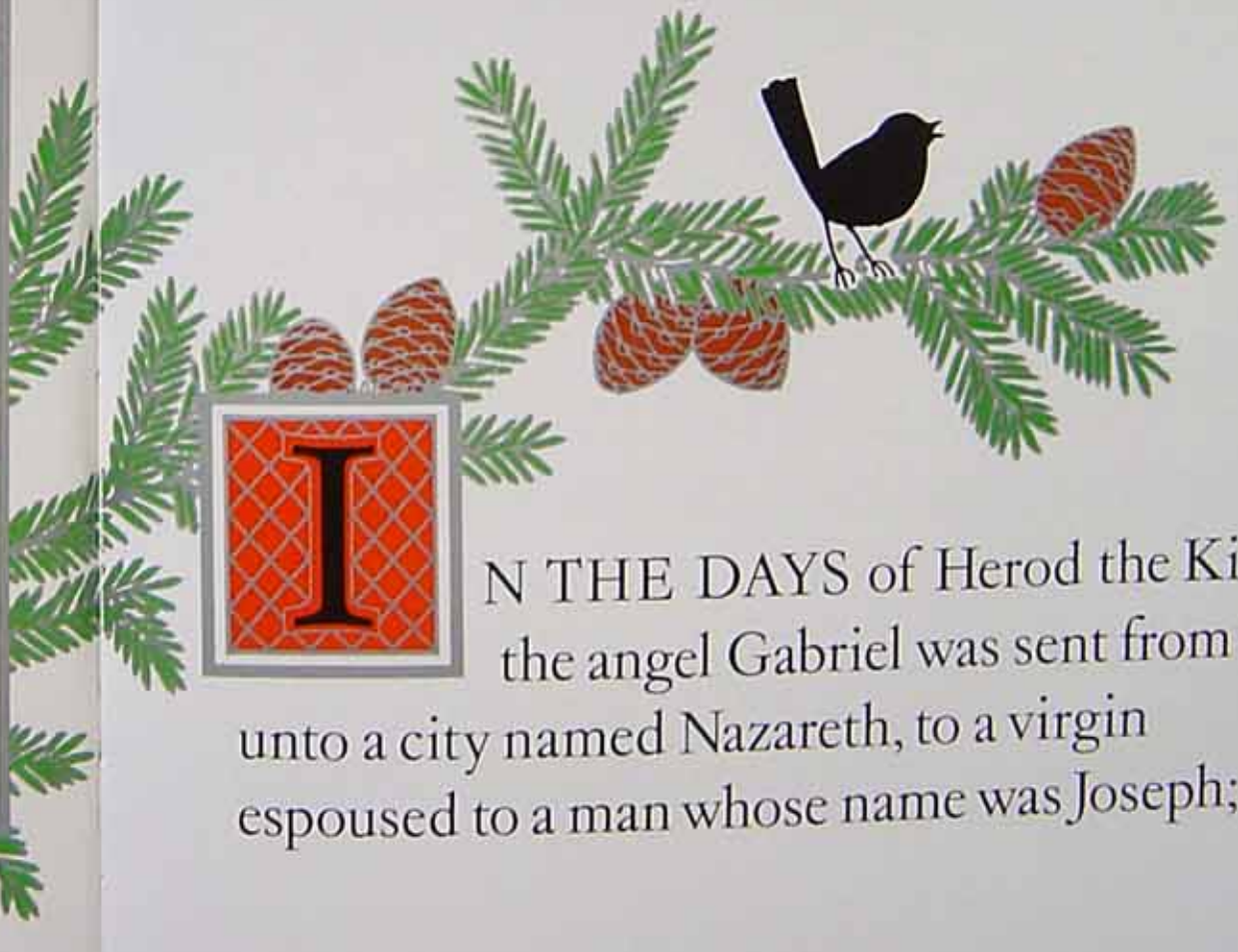

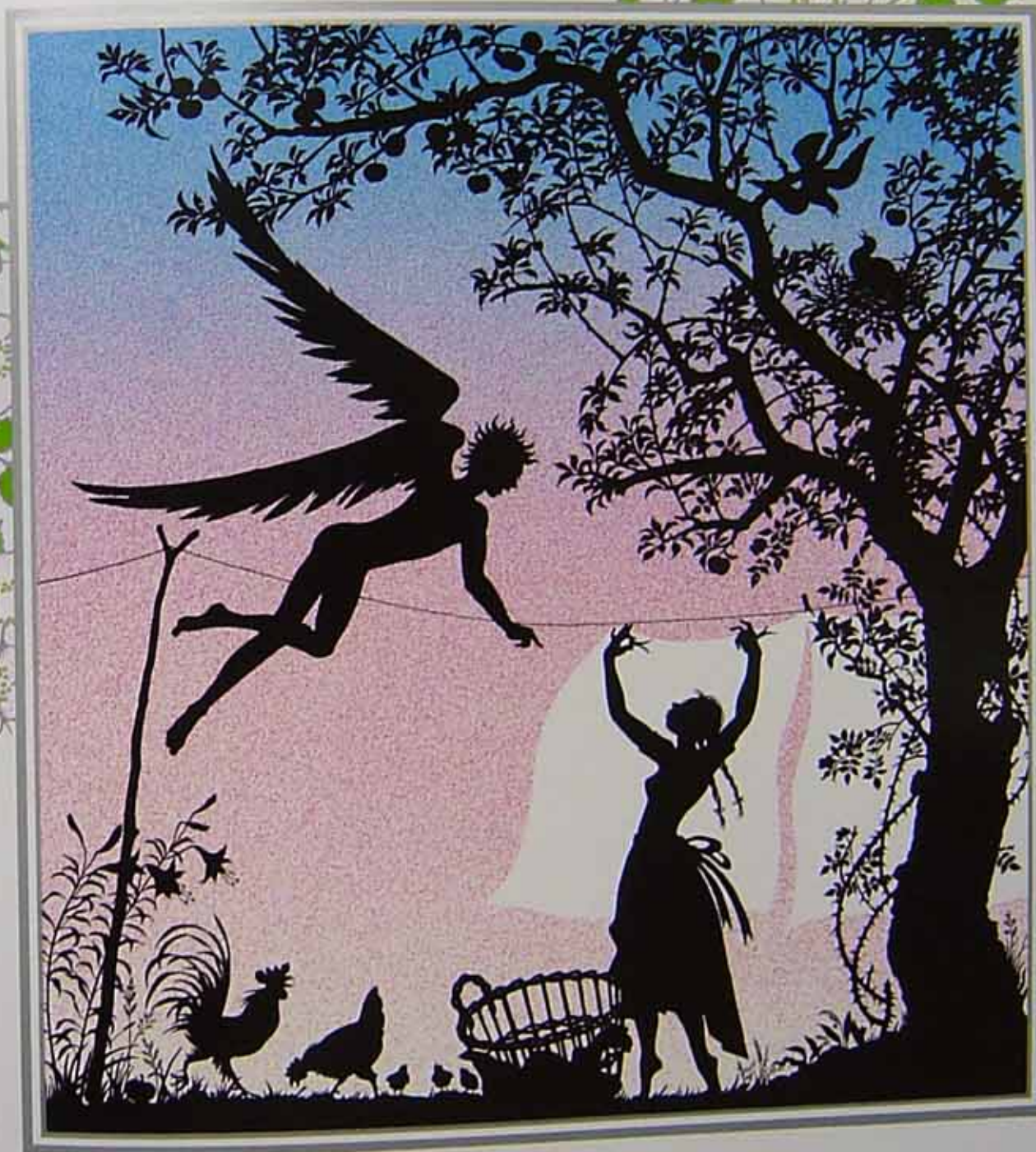
N THE DAYS of Herod the King,

espoused to a man whose name was Joseph;

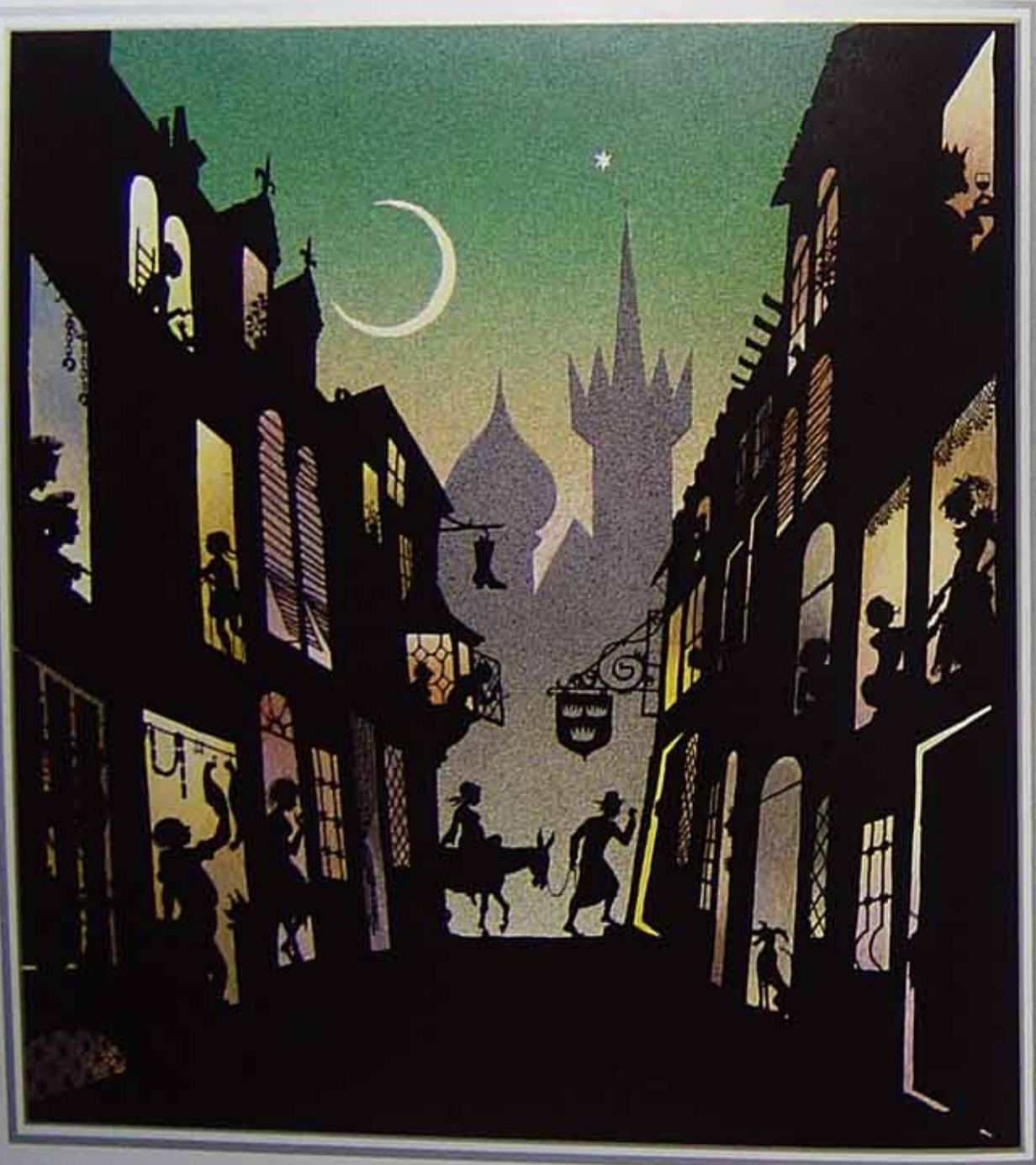
and the virgin's name was Mary.
