INK BLOTTING DRAWING (MONOPRINTING)

THIS TECHNIQUE IS A KIND OF PRINTMAKING AND BECAUSE YOU DO MAKE "MULTIPLES" OF THE SAME DRAWING.

WHAT YOU NEED

- REVERSE-SIDE PAPER (OR THIN PHOTOGRAPHY PAPER)
- NON-RESISTANT PAPER (TRACING PAPER, PAPERGLASS)
- COLORFUL INKS OR WATER-COLOR
- NO. 2 PENCIL OR PENCIL SHARPENER
- NO. 2 PENCIL OR PENCIL SHARPENER

TRACING
PAPER

1. DRAW OR TRACE IN PENCIL WHAT IMAGE YOU WOULD LIKE TO "INK" ON THE TRACING PAPER.

2. TIE (WITH ONE) THE TWO PAGES OF PAPER TOGETHER SO THAT THEY CAN OPEN LIKE A BOOK.



3. USE THE INK PEN TO DRAW A SMALL PART OF YOUR TRACED LINE.



RUB
OR
PRESS
DOWN

4. BEFORE THE INK DRIES, PRESS DOWN ON THE ABSTRACT PAPER (Like closing your book).



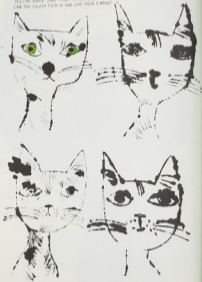
5. REPEAT STEPS 3-4 UNTIL DRAWING COMPLETE.



6. ONCE DRY, COLOR WITH COLORFUL INKS OR PAST.



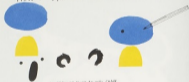
NEAR THE MORE CAT FACIL MADE BY THE SCOTTISH.

HOW TO DRAW A KOALA BEAR



1. DRAW AN OVAL AS THE HEAD.
2. DRAW A SEMI-CIRCLE FOR THE BODY.
3. ADD EYES, NOSE AND EARS.
4. ADD THE FLUFFY EARS.
