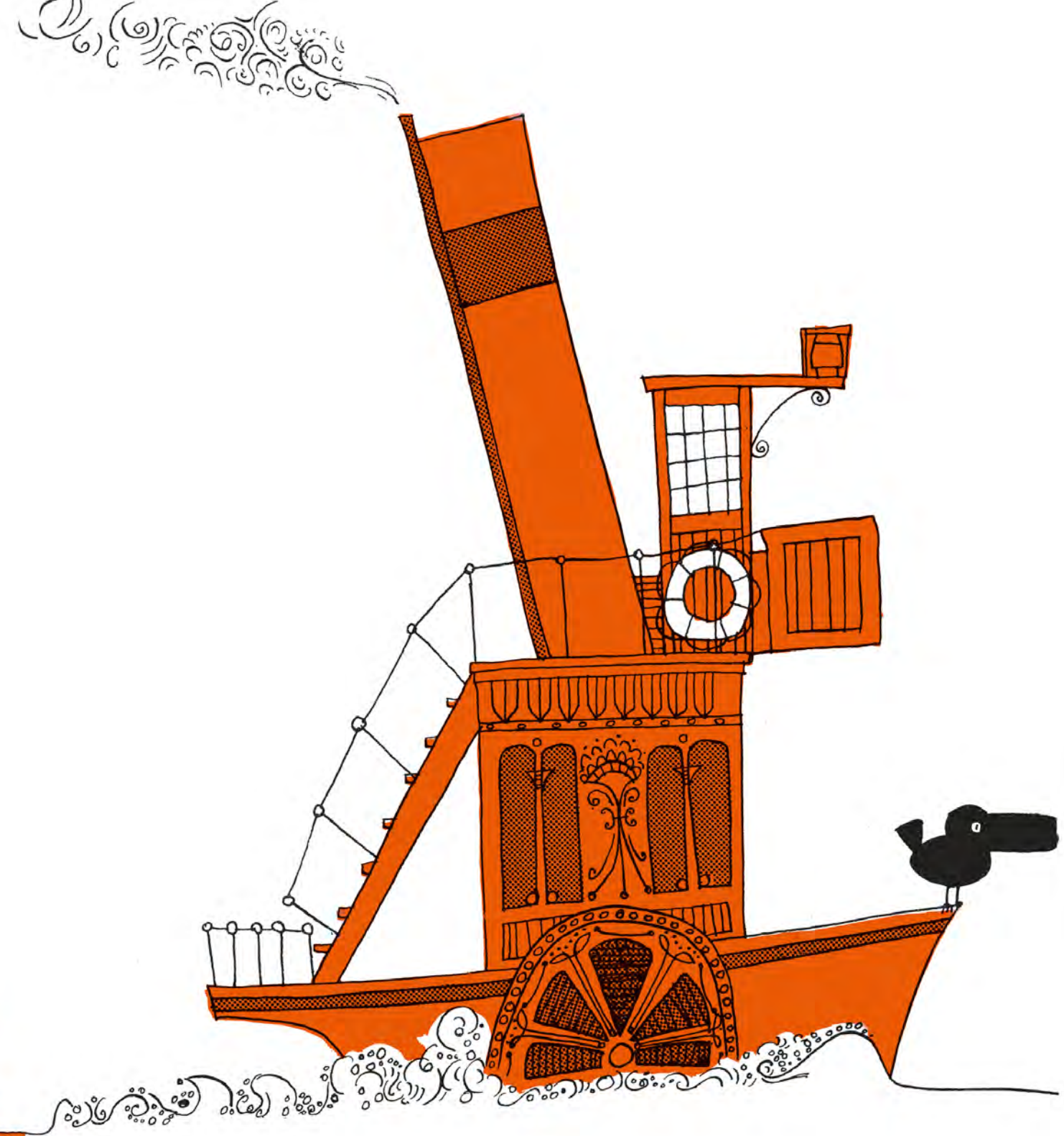
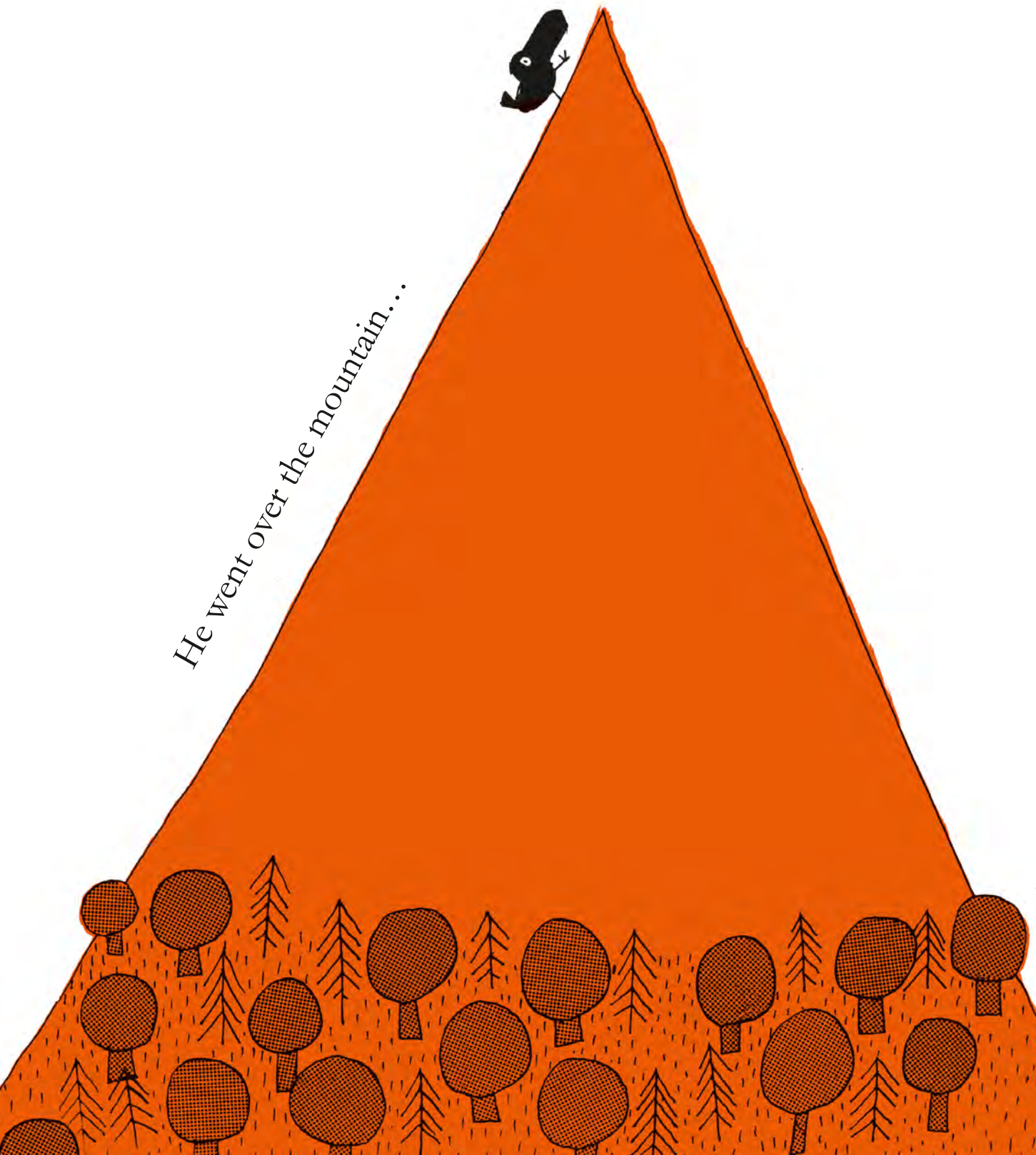
There was once a bird who didn't have a name.
