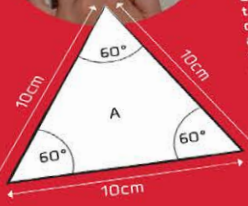

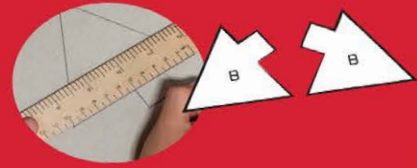

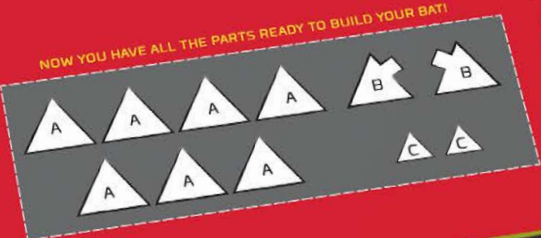
**1** Cut out 7 equilateral triangles with a side length of 10cm. It's easiest to use a protractor to measure your 60° angles. Once you have one triangle use it as a template for the others.

THERE'S A TRIANGLE TEMPLATE ON PAGE 40 OF THIS BOOK!

**2** Then make 2 more triangles the same size but with 2 tabs. These tabs will join the head onto the body. Make them quite chunky!

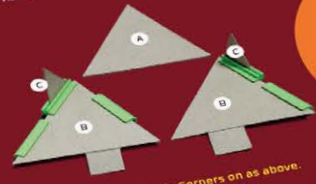


**3** Cut out 2 little triangles for the ears, you can do long ones or short whatever you fancy!

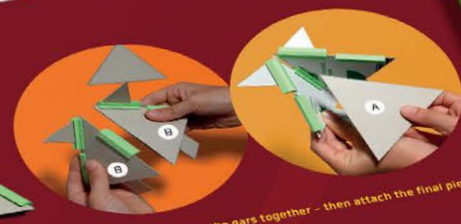


NOW YOU HAVE ALL THE PARTS READY TO BUILD YOUR BAT!

**4** Assembling the head



Put the Magic Corners on as above.



Slot the 2 pieces with the ears together - then attach the final piece

**5** Now let's make the slots to help hold the head on the TOP of the body. Using an 'A' triangle, mark where the tabs go - just like we're doing here. Then cut 2 slots. ASK A GROWN UP TO HELP WITH THESE. We used pointy nail scissors.



**6** Now we can assemble the body and wings. Fix on the Magic Corners



JOIN BLUE EDGE TO BLUE EDGE & YELLOW TO YELLOW

Then slot the body together



**7** Slot the head onto the body and your bat is all done!

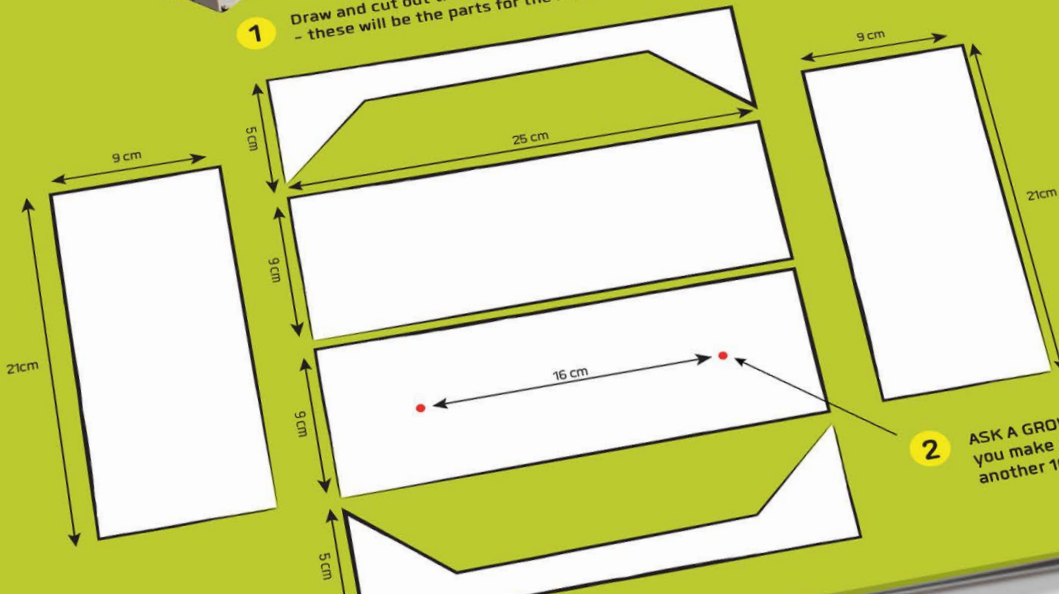

# Swing seat



**1** Draw and cut out the card like we have below - these will be the parts for the main frame



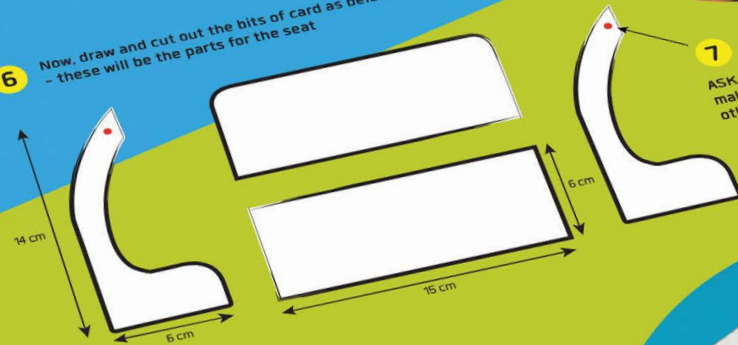
NOTE: YOU NEED 2 PIECES OF STRING TO MAKE THIS!



**2** ASK A GROWN UP to help you make a hole here and another 16cm to the left



**6** Now, draw and cut out the bits of card as below - these will be the parts for the seat



**5** Slot the inner frames into the outer frame



**7** ASK A GROWN UP to make a hole in the other one



**8** Slot on the Magic Corners on like this and put the seat together

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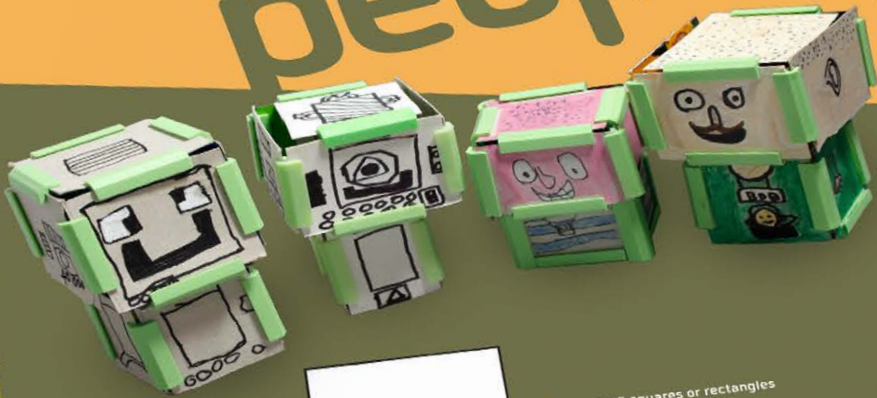

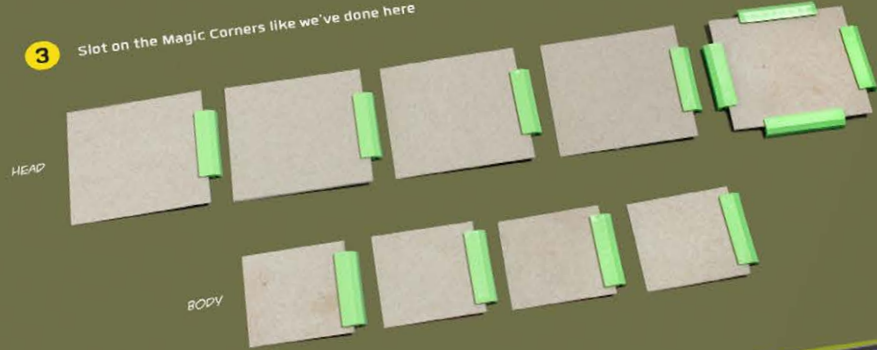
1 Make 6 squares or rectangles for the head.



2 Make 4 rectangles for the body which are at least 2cm narrower than the head

MAKE SURE THE BODY RECTANGLE IS NARROWER THAN THE HEAD

3 Slot on the Magic Corners like we've done here



4 Put the head together



5 Then put the body together



6 Now we need to make 2 little card link pieces like these. These pieces are to join the head onto the body. You may need to try a couple of different sizes to see what works. We like to start off too big then trim them smaller if needed.



7 Now you can slot the head onto the body and say hello to your new little friend!

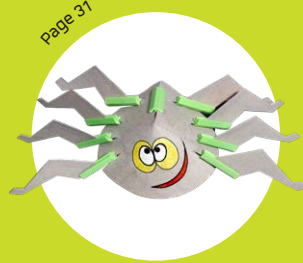
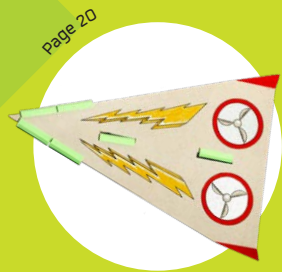
