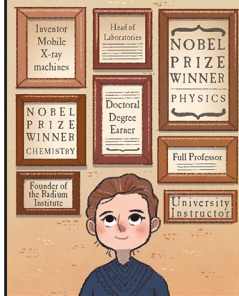
NOBEL PRIZE FOR CHEMISTRY—1911
