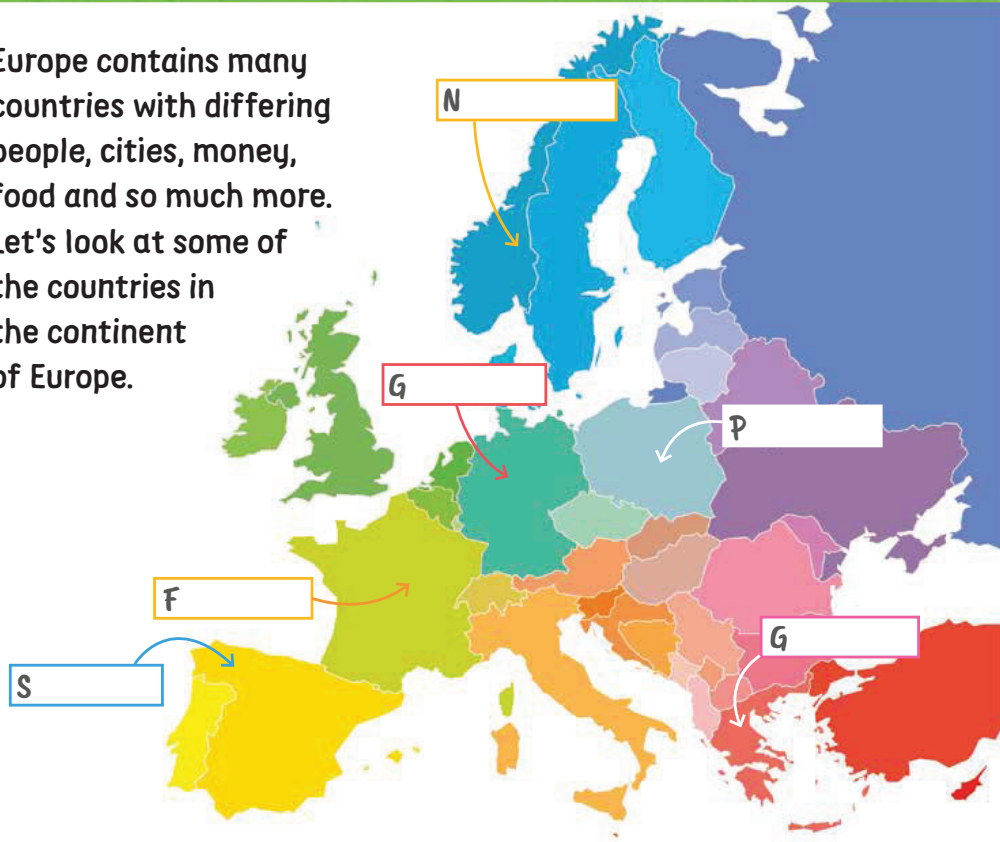


Europe contains many countries with differing people, cities, money, food and so much more. Let's look at some of the countries in the continent of Europe.

Alphabet Action

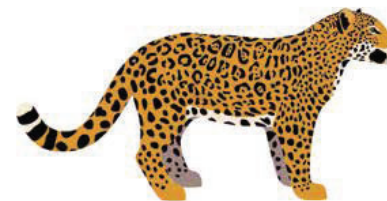


Games are important to help develop and broaden our vocabularies. Categorising words can help build links, so why not do it with a game?
