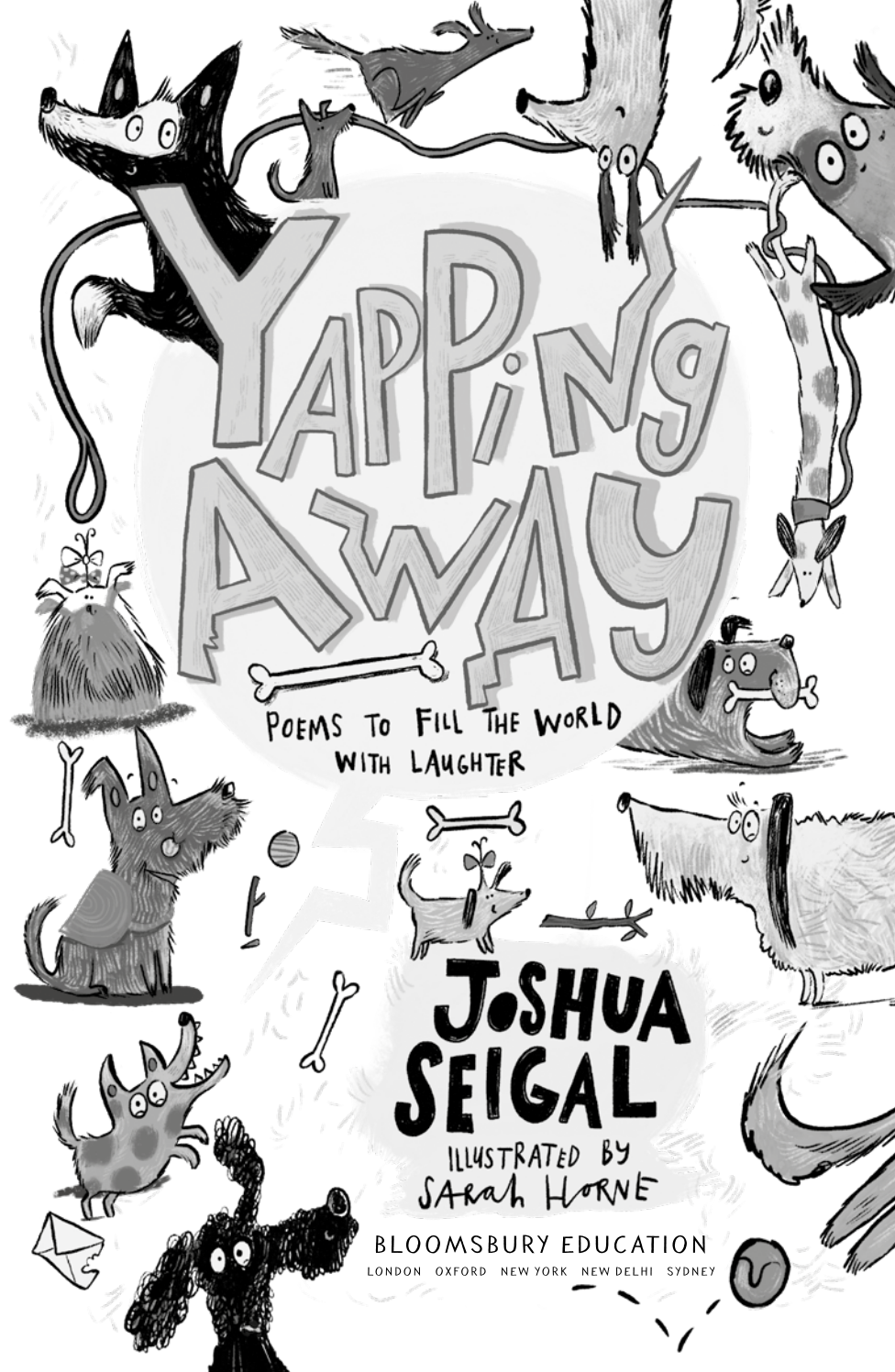

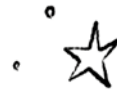

let's have fun

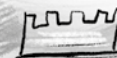
fun

that's magic.

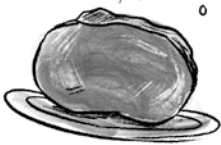


A rainbow peeking through the rain:
