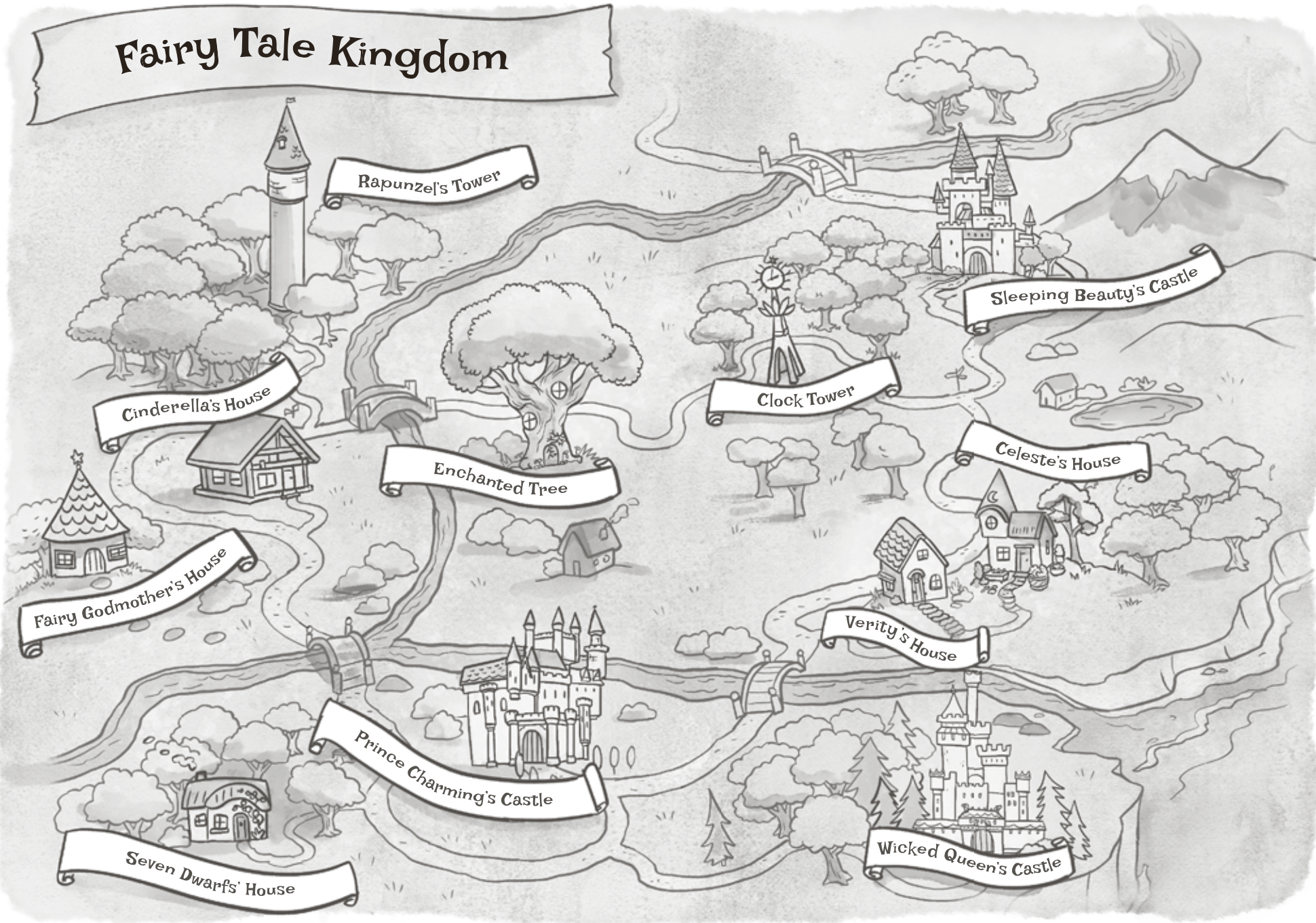

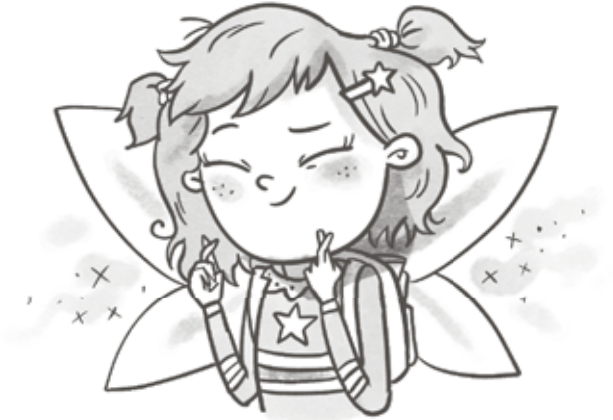

“And the winner is... Fay!” Tatiana announced happily.

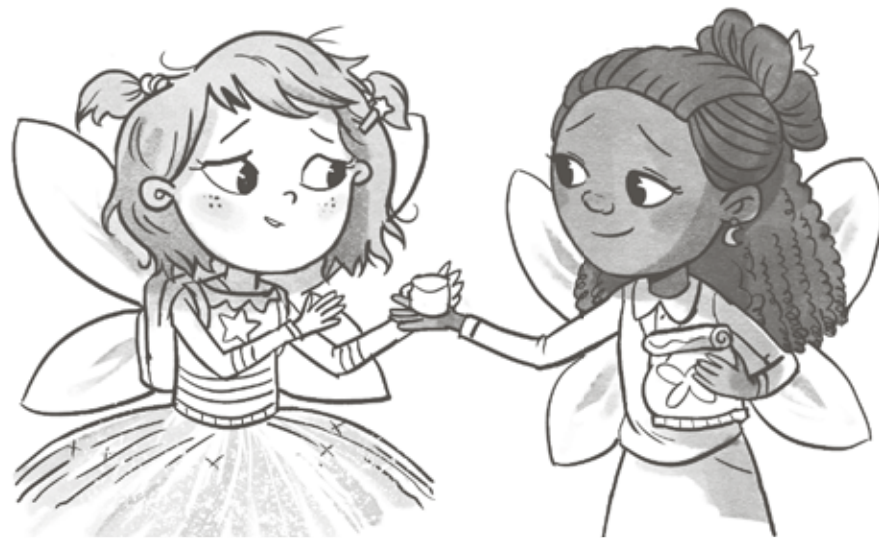
