in the entire house.

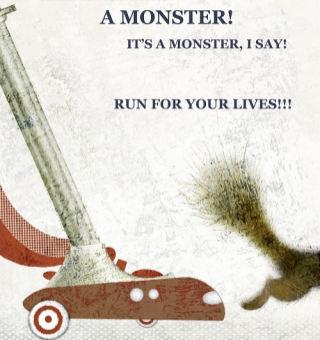


Aaahhh! A monster!

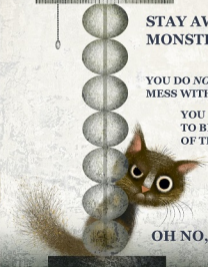
