This is Circle.





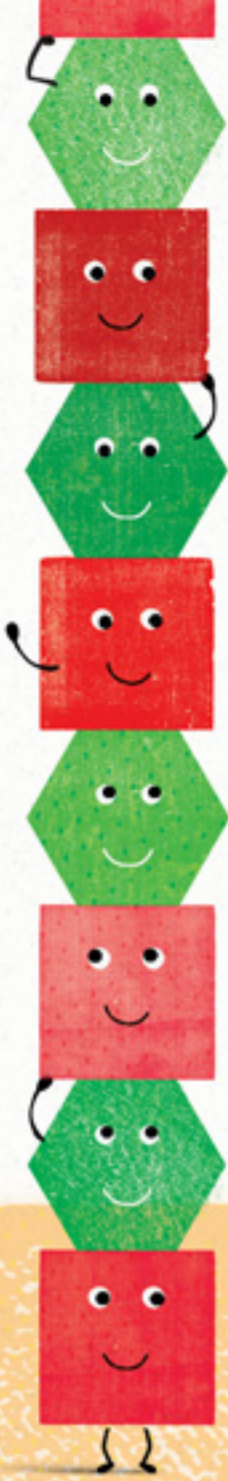

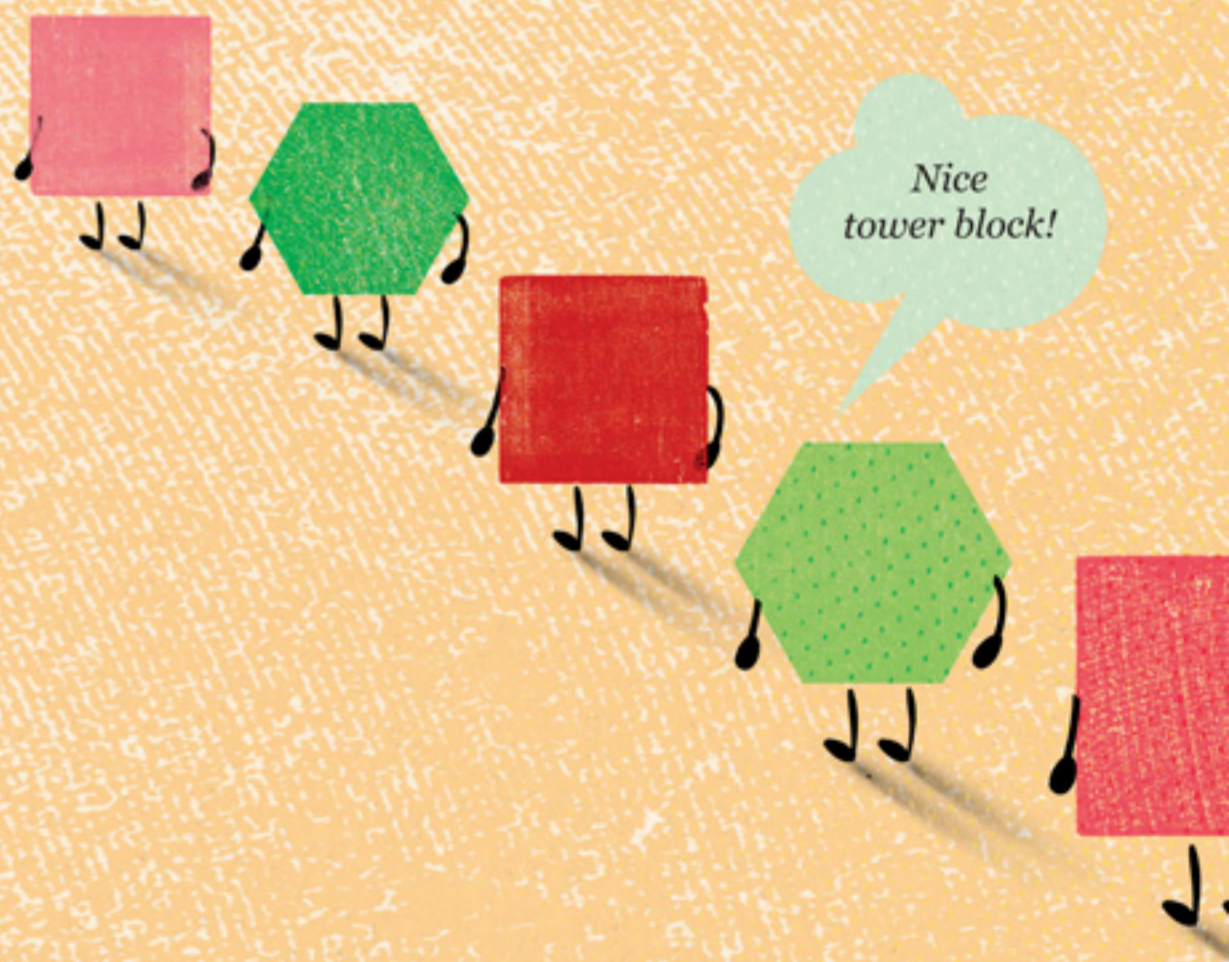


