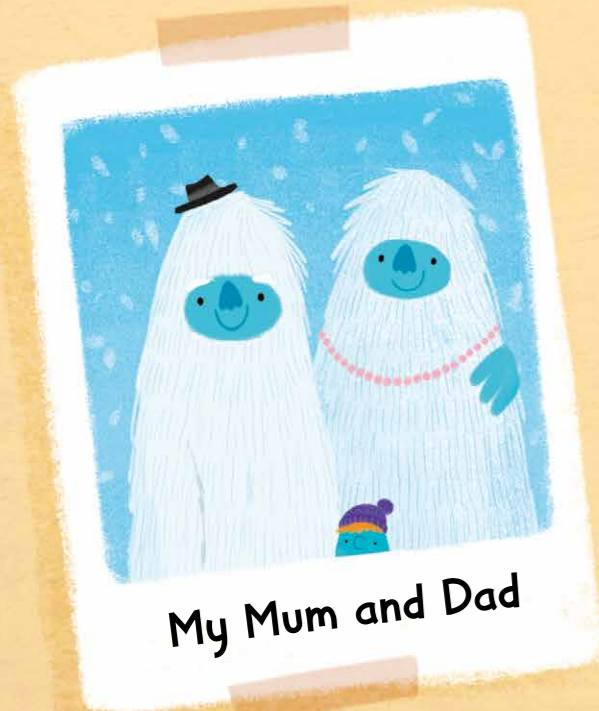

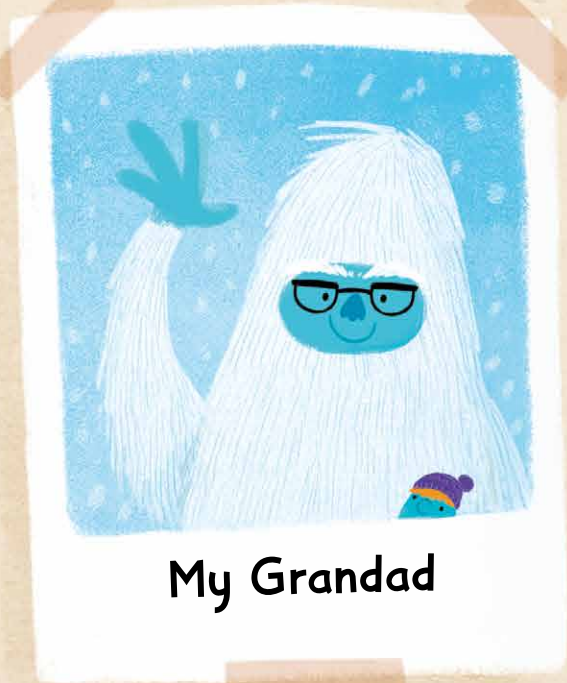
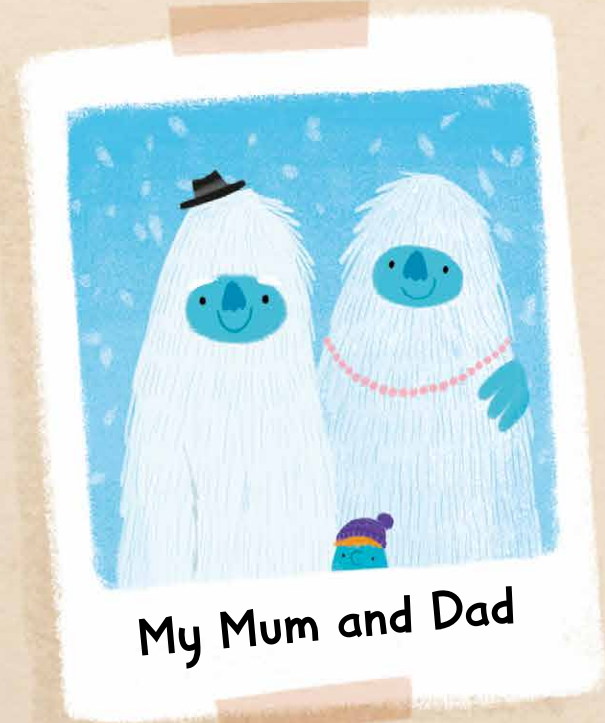

His sister was a yeti.

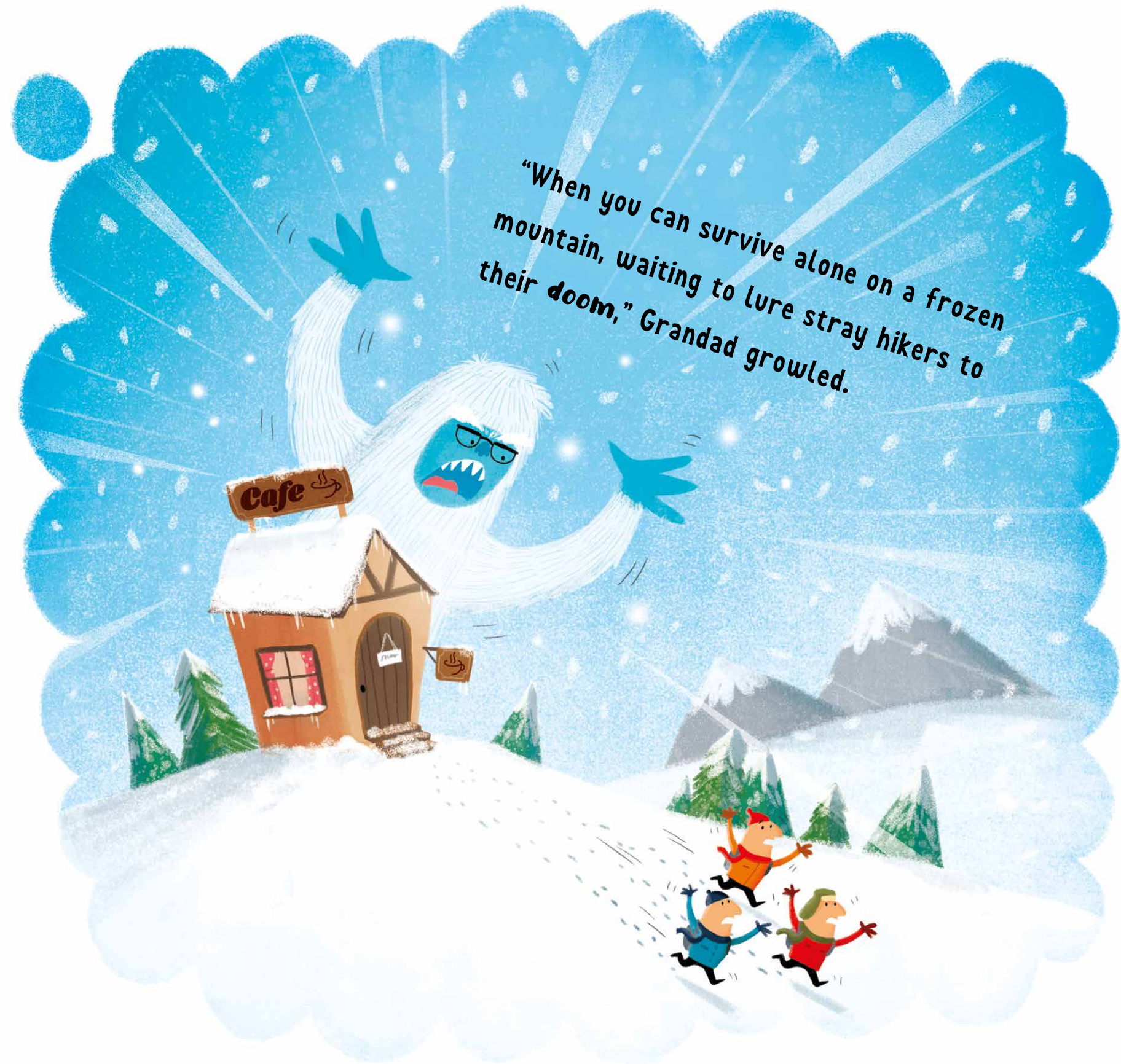


All of George's family
