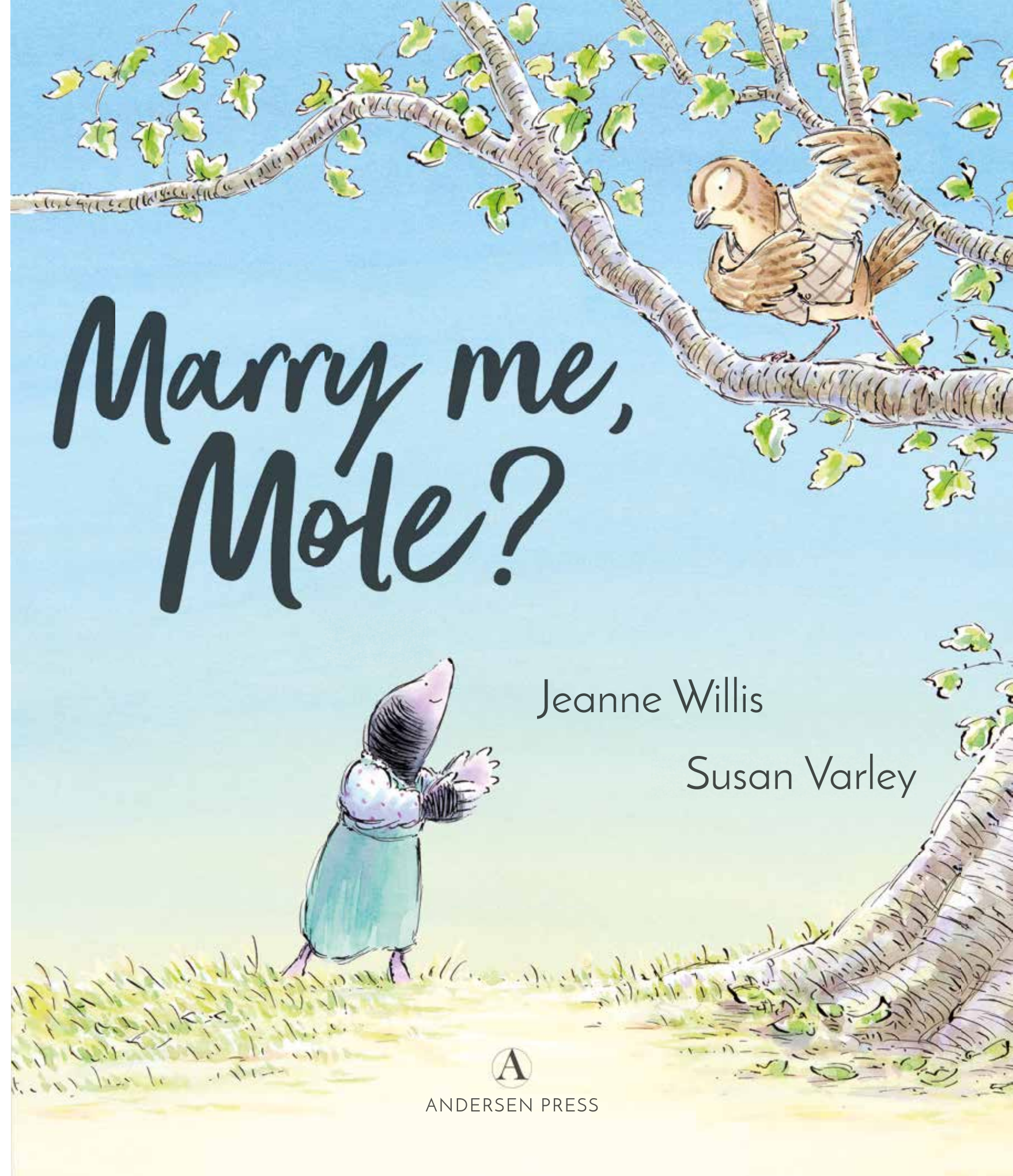

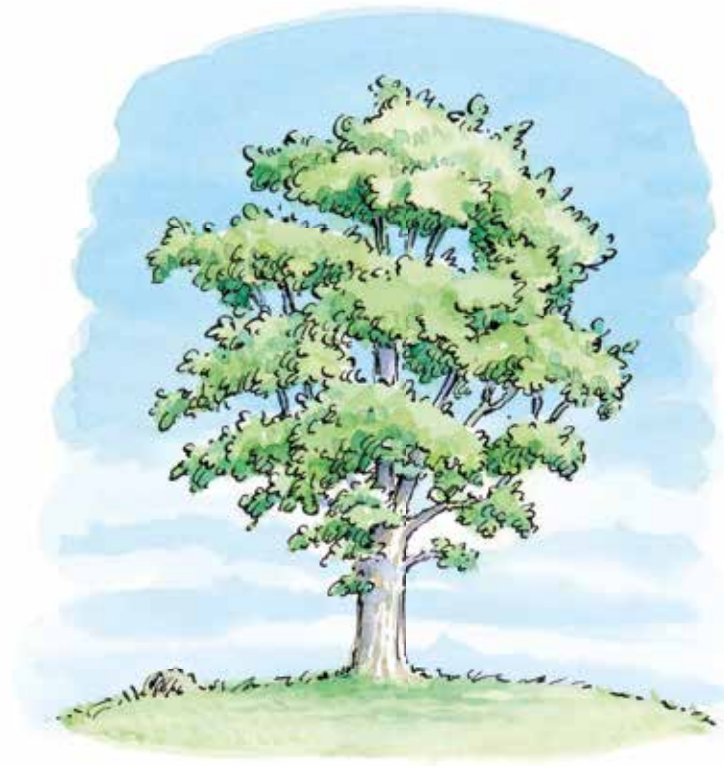
Marry me, Mole?

But Mole said...






“NO!”
