And they weren't QUITE their normal selves either.

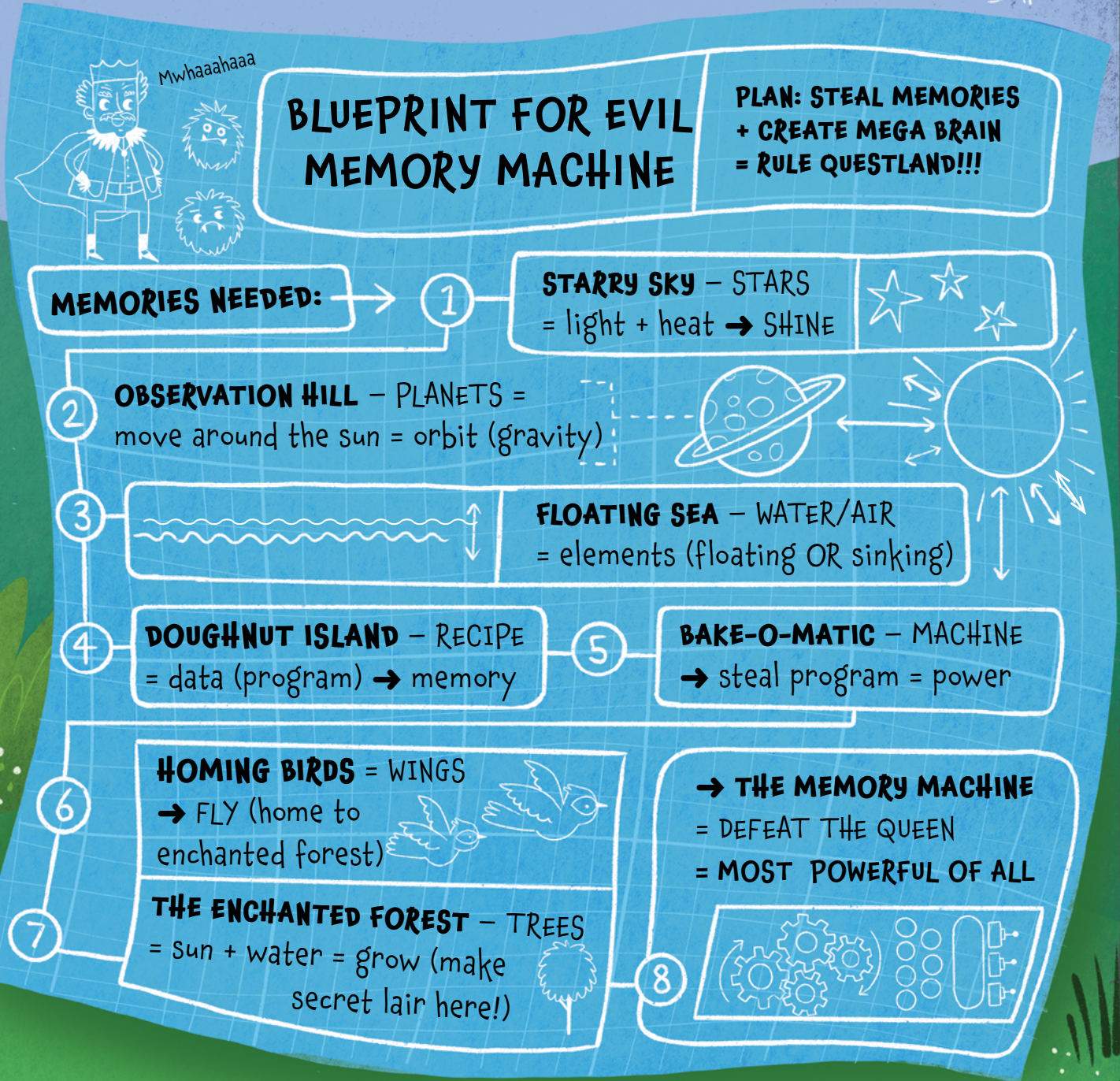

‘Let me look, please, Bea!’ said Leo Zoom, who loved space.

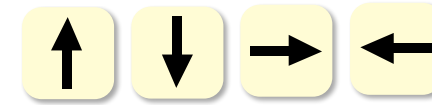

Lillicorn frowned. ‘Do you think they’ve forgotten too?’

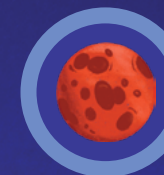
You can do this!
