Jack's mum was not like the other mums. "Hi, Jack!" she called.

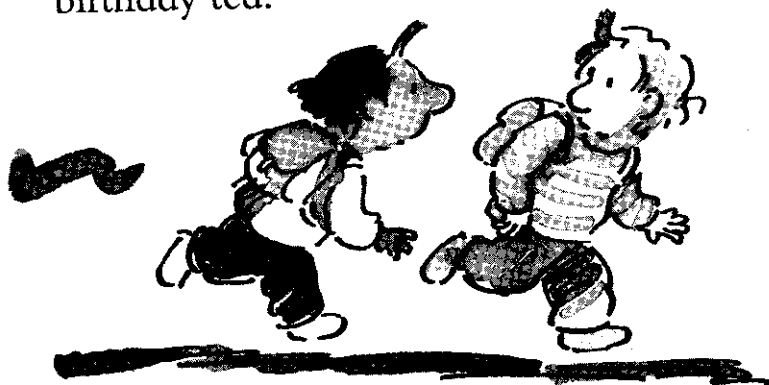
Jack pretended not to hear.
