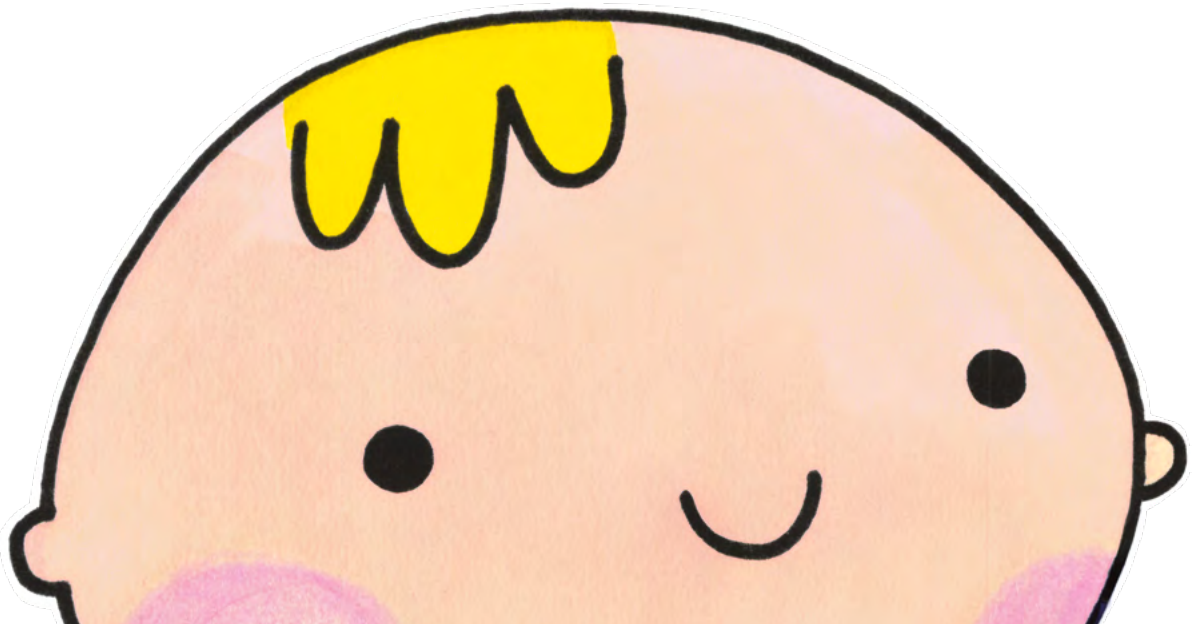

won first prize for her garden.

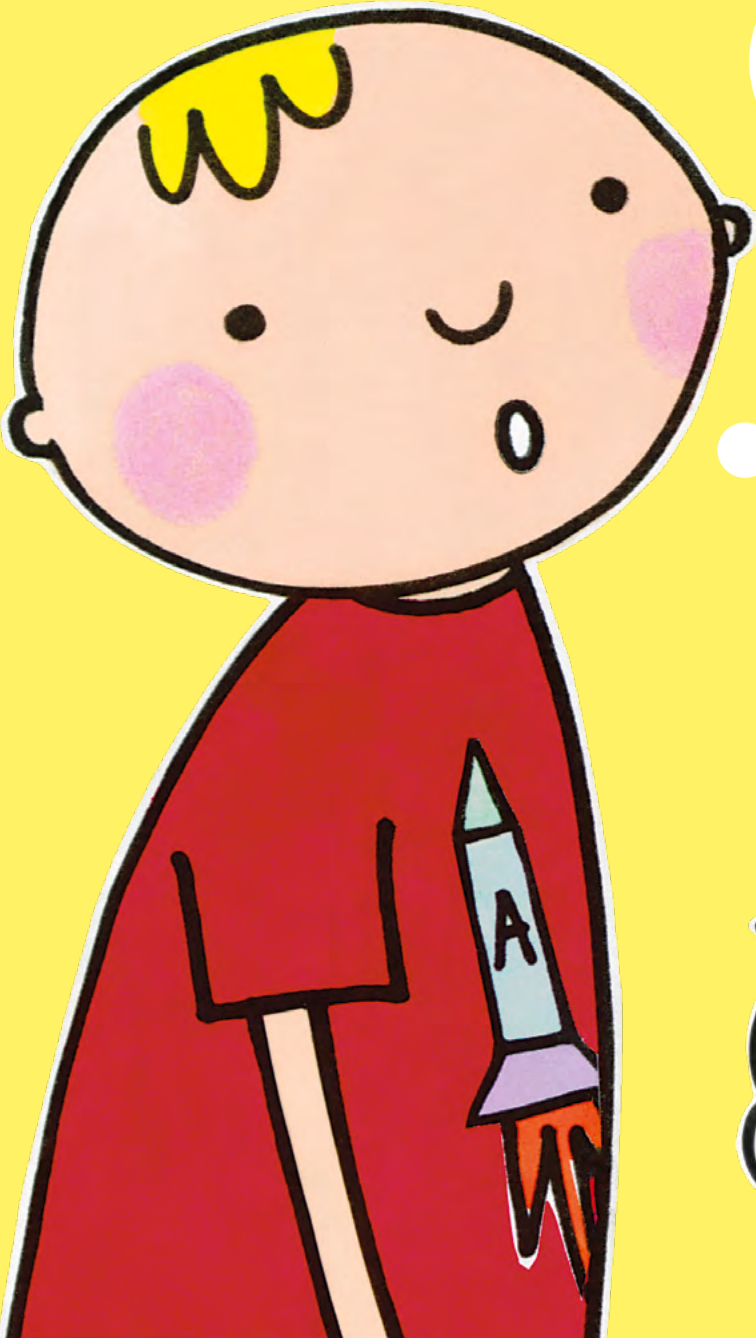
"Just look at

he wondered.



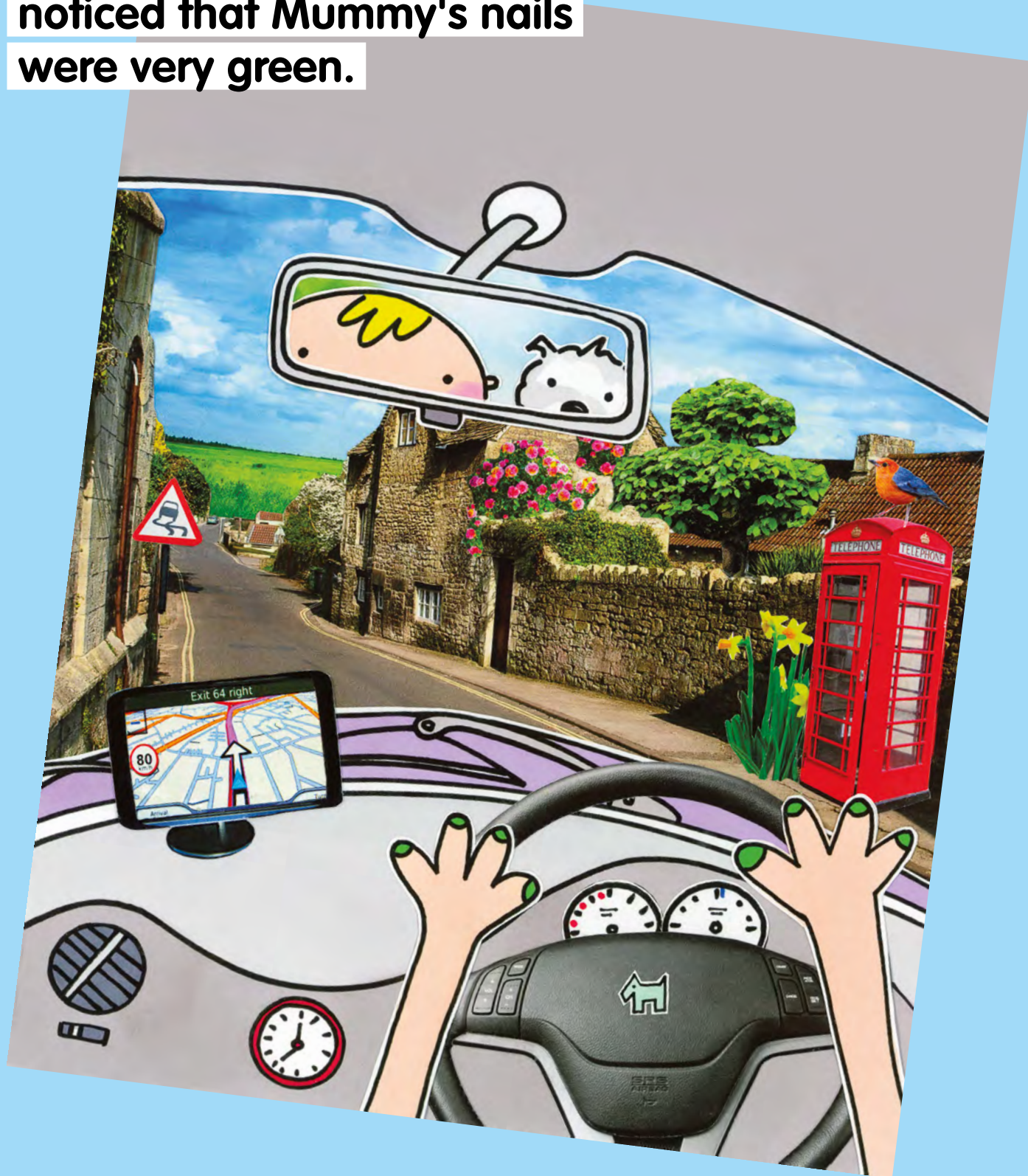
I don't have

a picture.



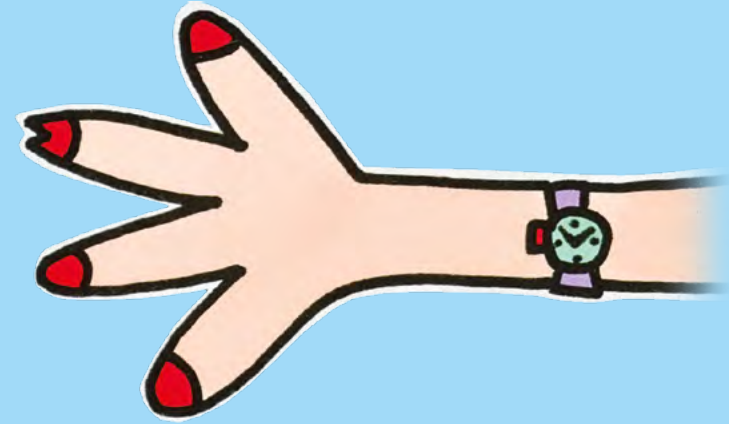
"Or do I?"

As Mummy really did not like chipped nailpolish,

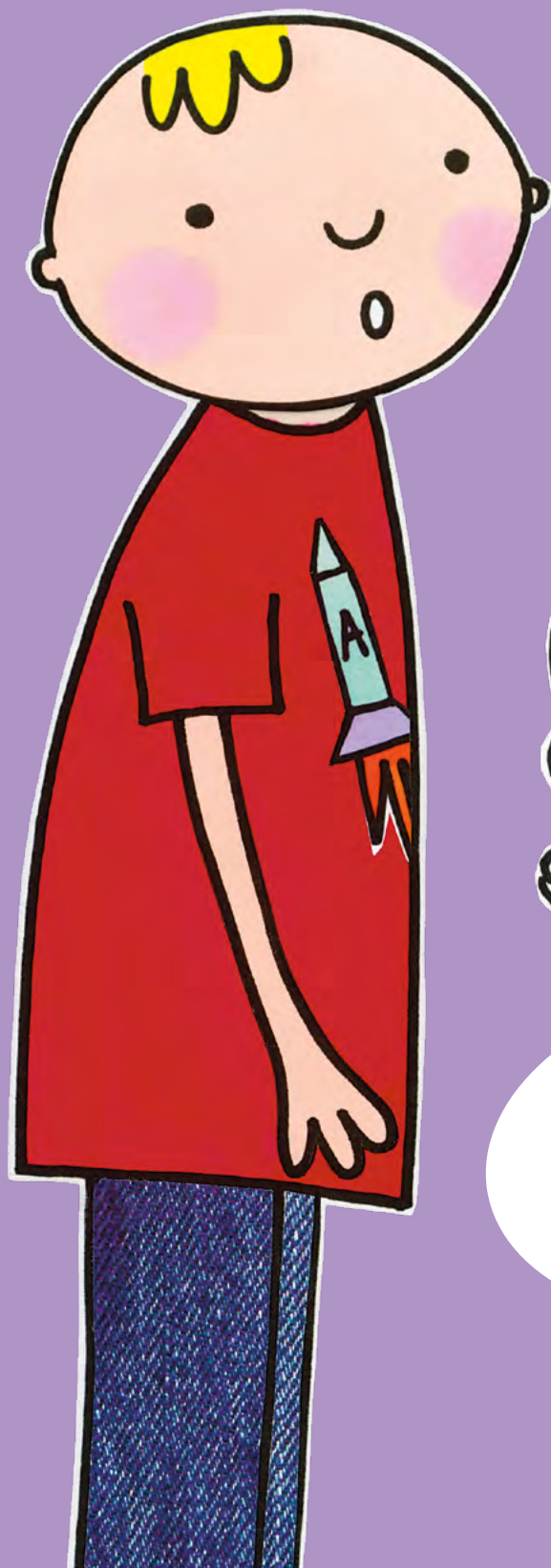


she often painted her nails a different colour.
