Mummy's so super at doing the shopping.



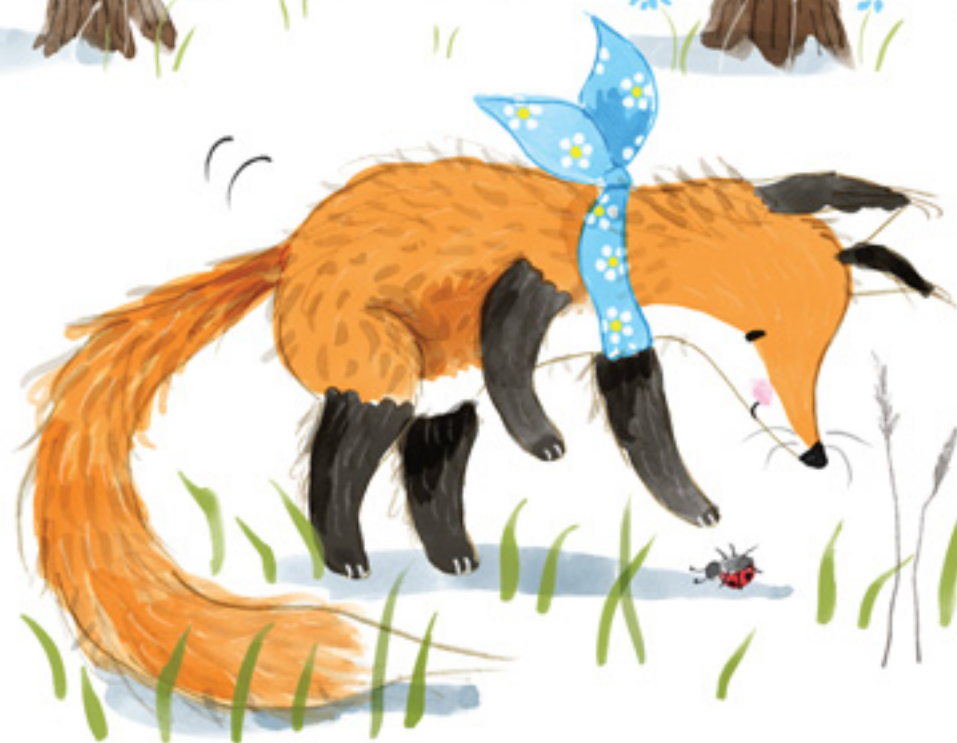
we zoom round the shops without even stopping!
