

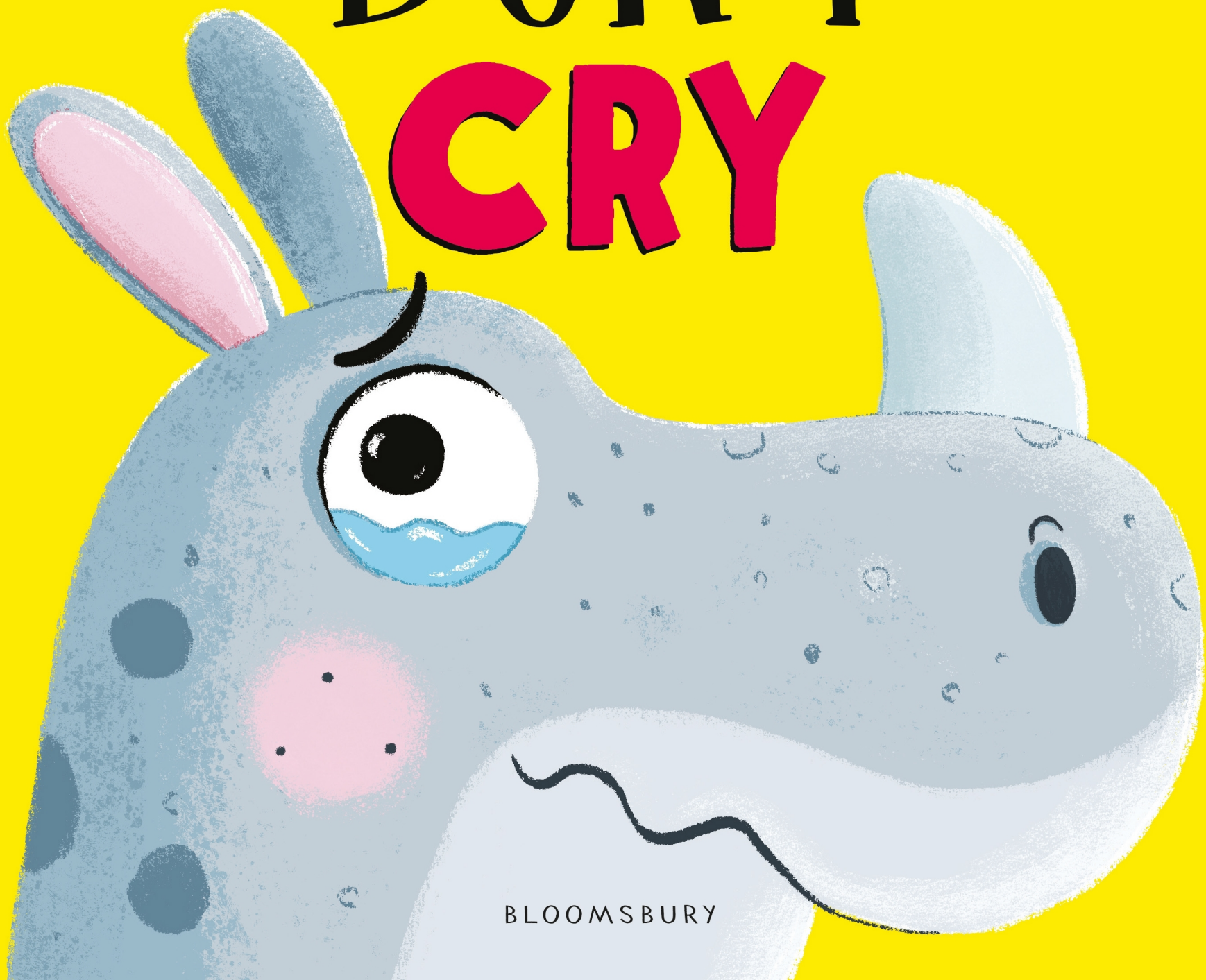

he sings.

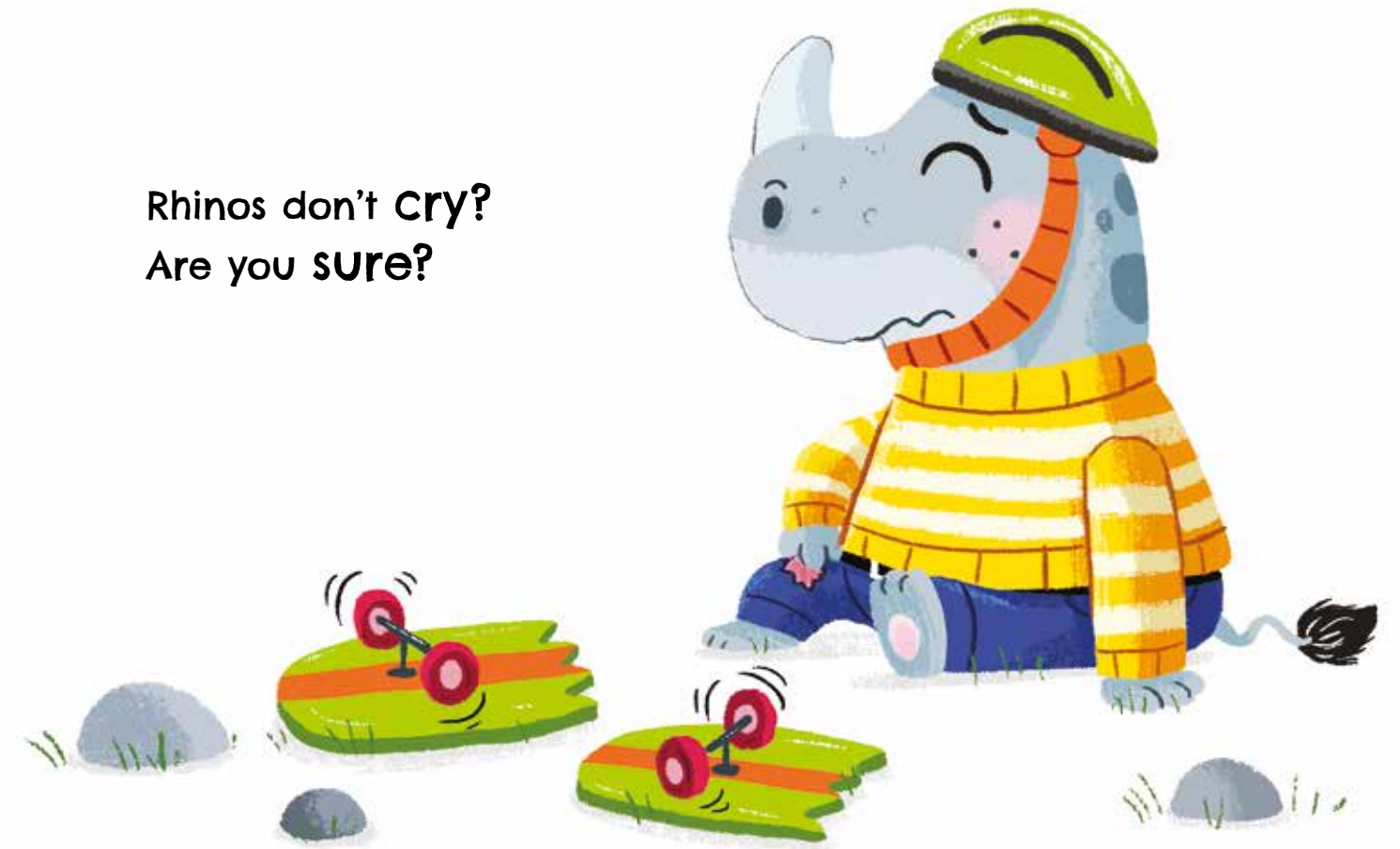


And goodness me, Milo loves being a rhino –

Rhinos DON'T cry.



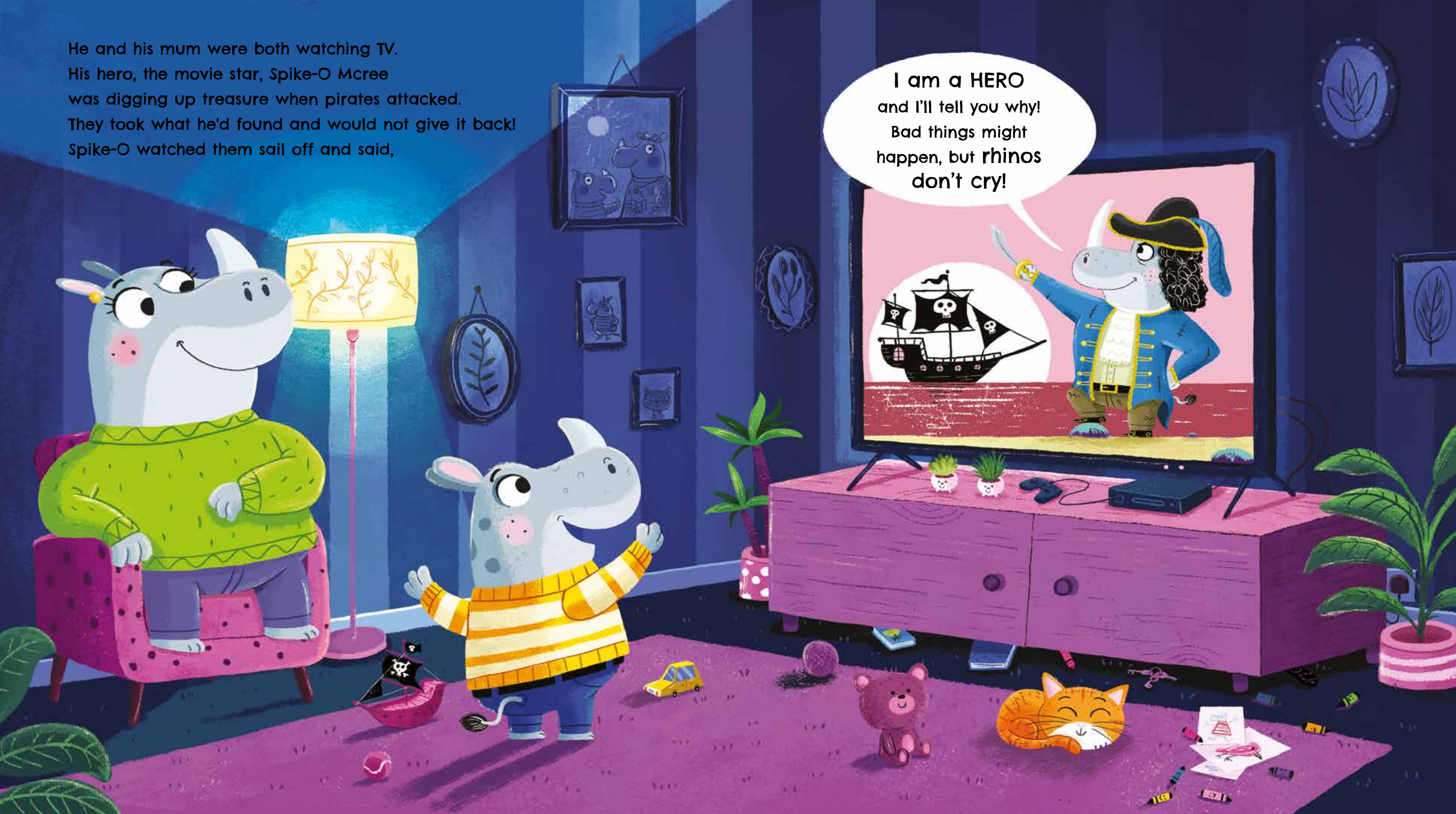
Rhinos don't cry?
