

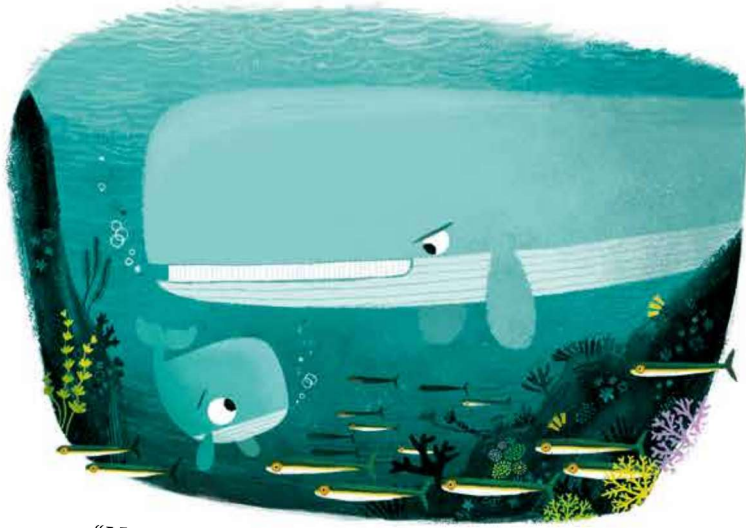

The smallest blue whale in the whole of the pod.

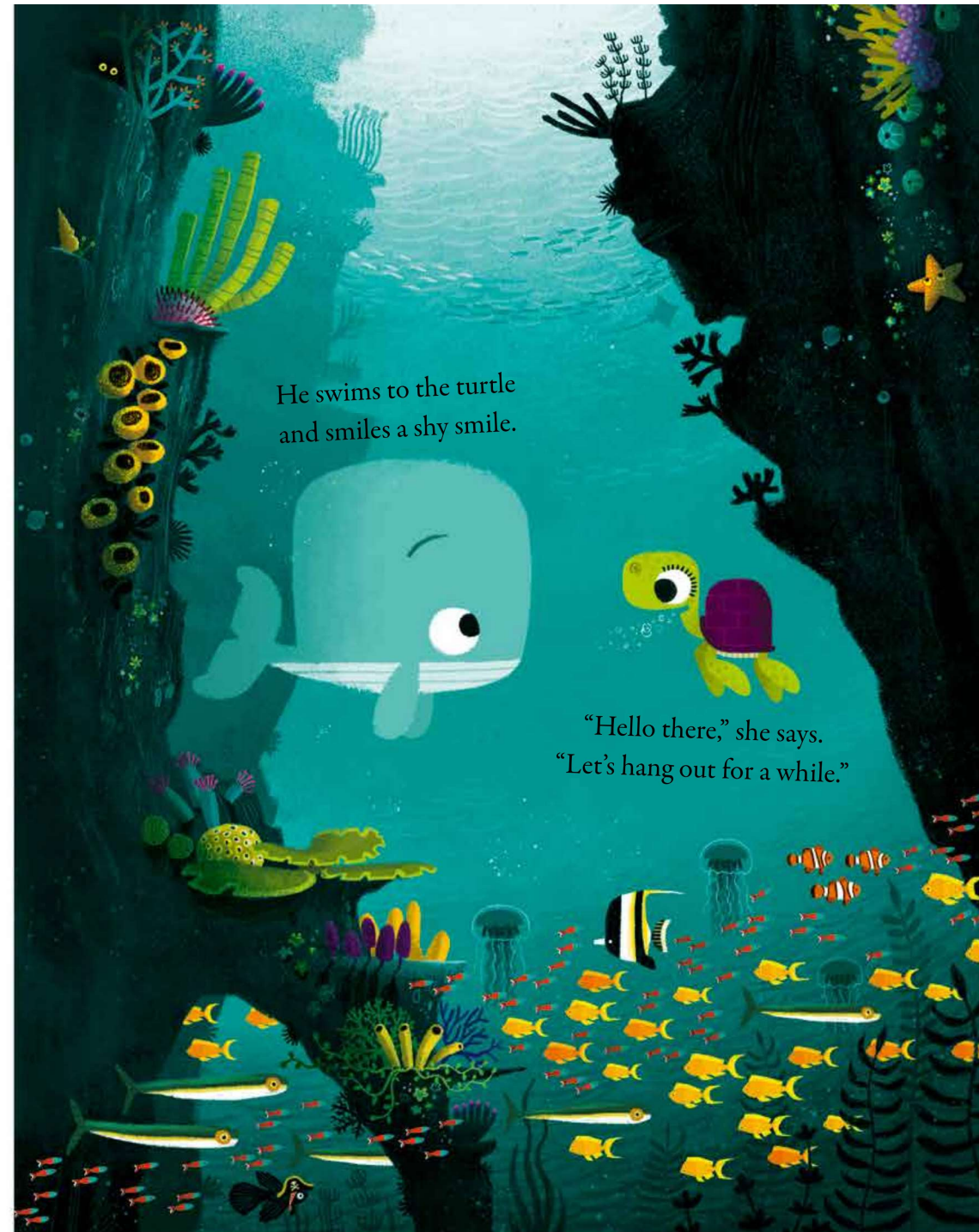
His parents they love him, but hope all the same
