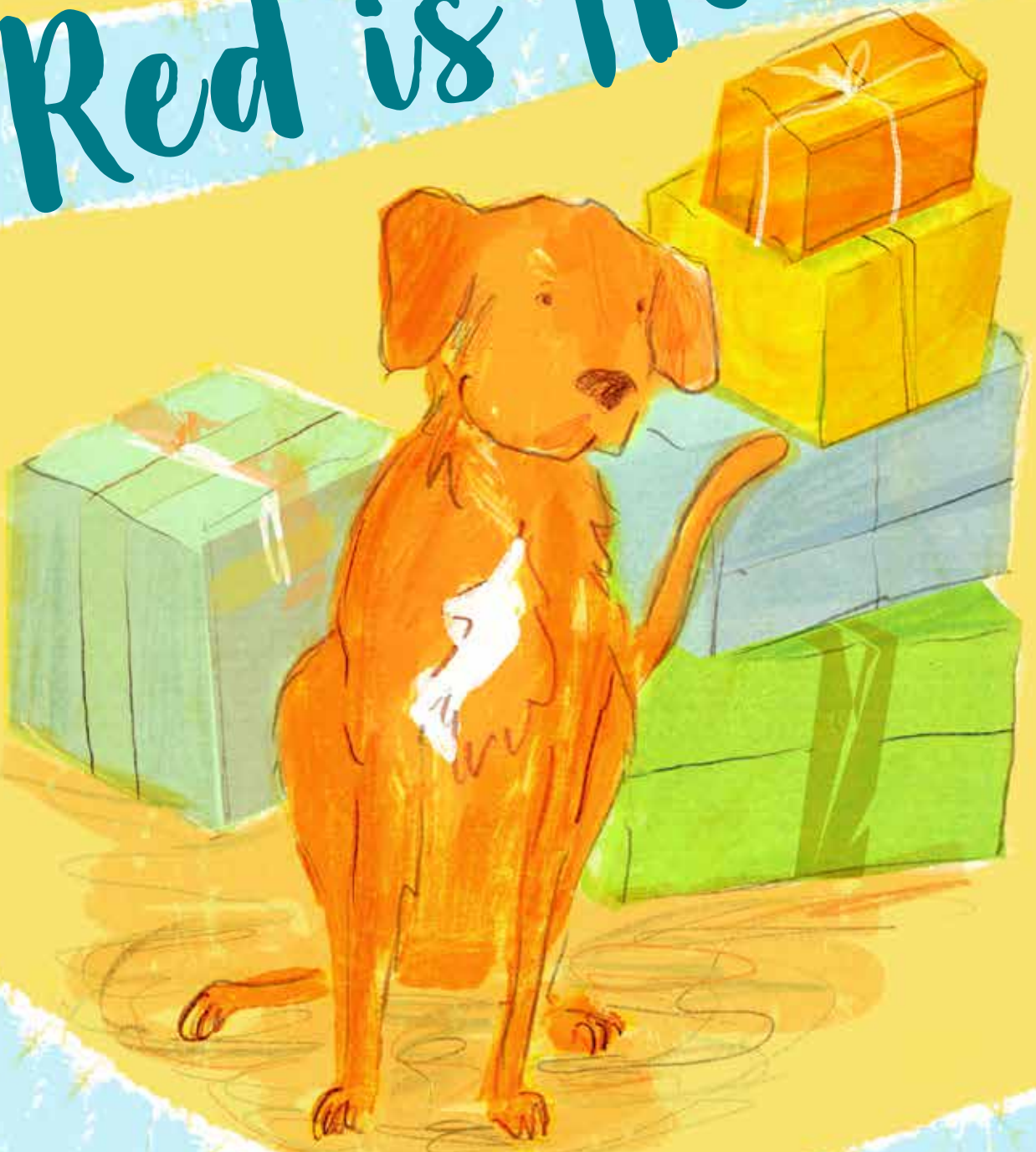

Red lives here, with Chino and Maude.



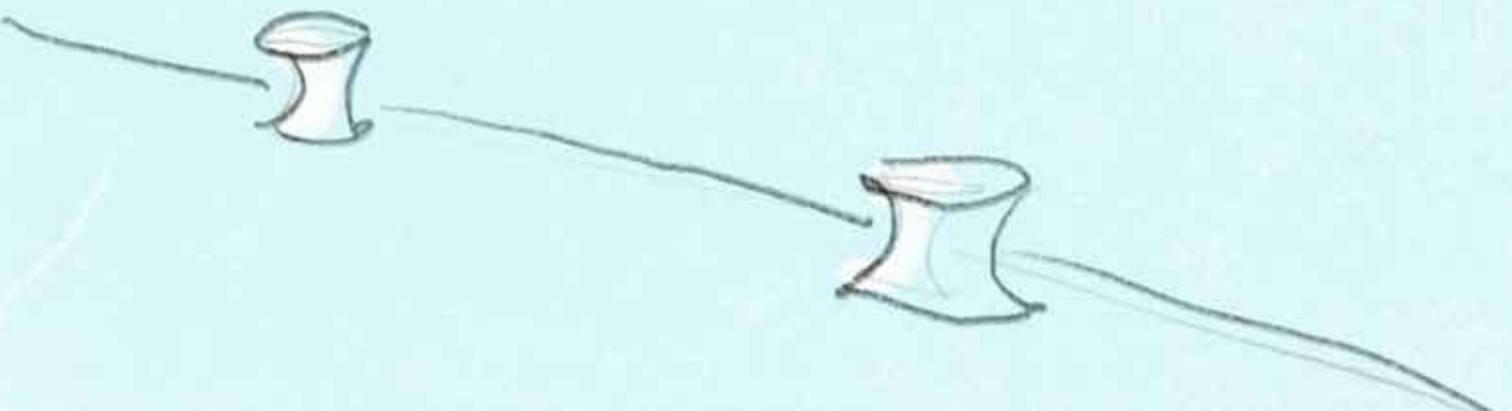
And also there, with Sita and Claude.

and he does that.



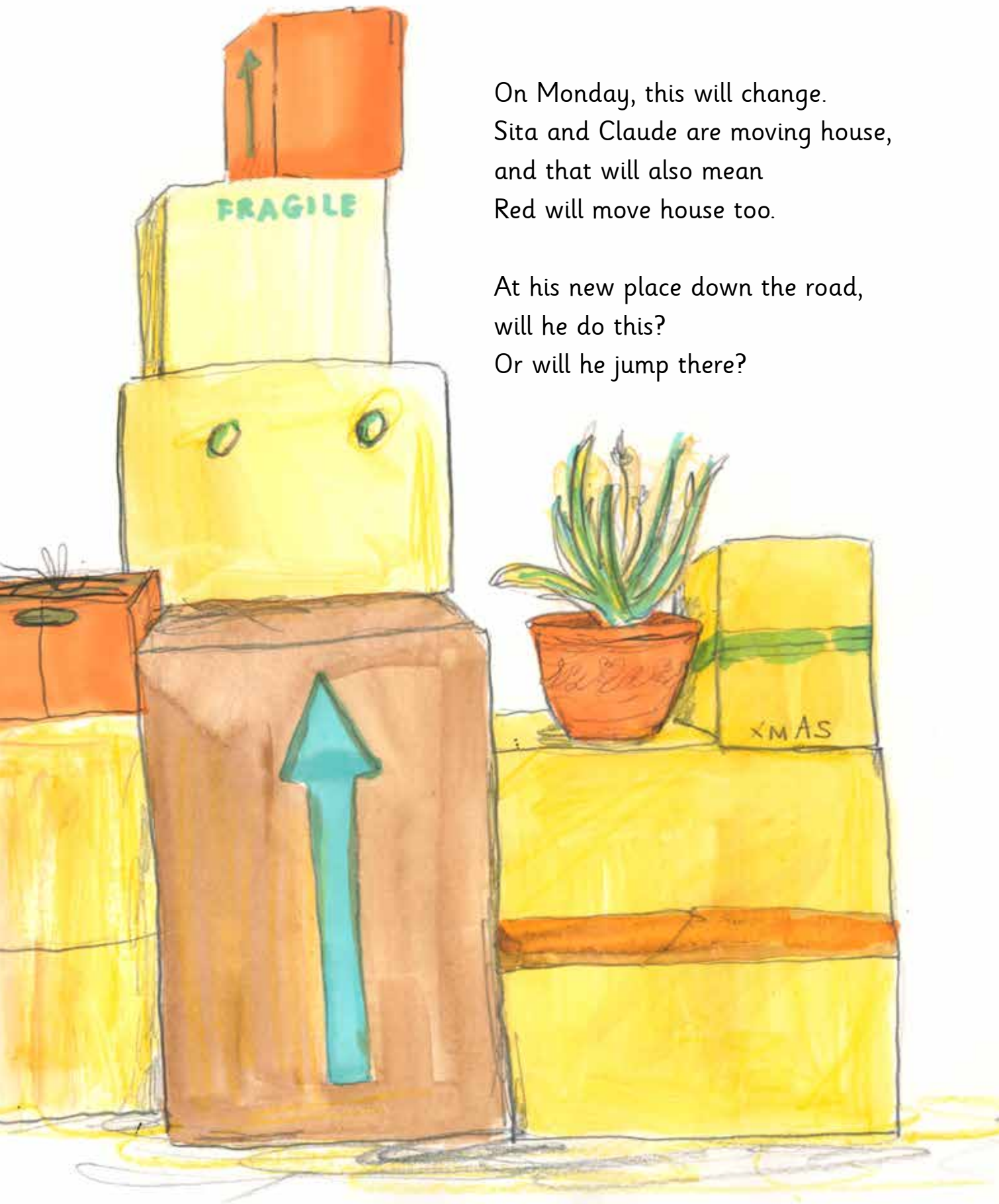
And sometimes, you know,
