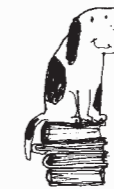

putting on disguises,



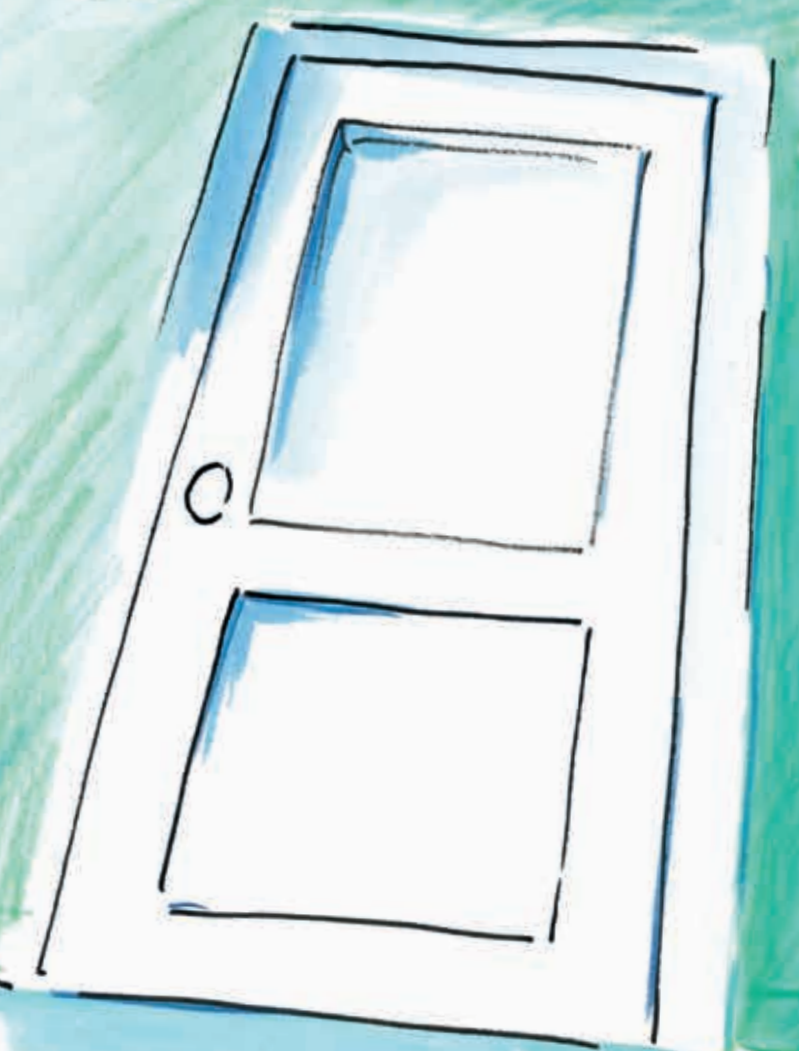
and making
