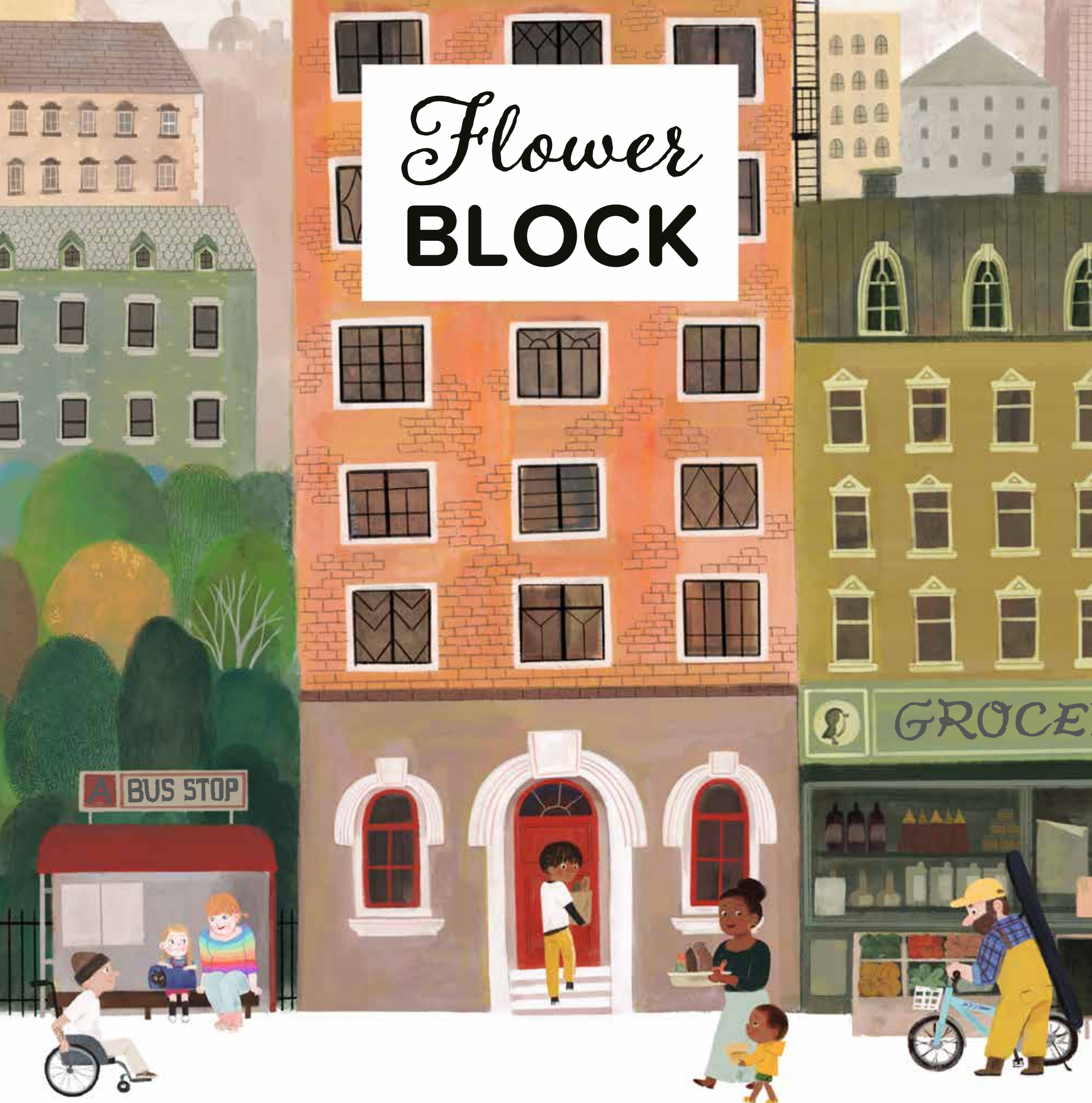

Grow Your Own Sunflower kit.

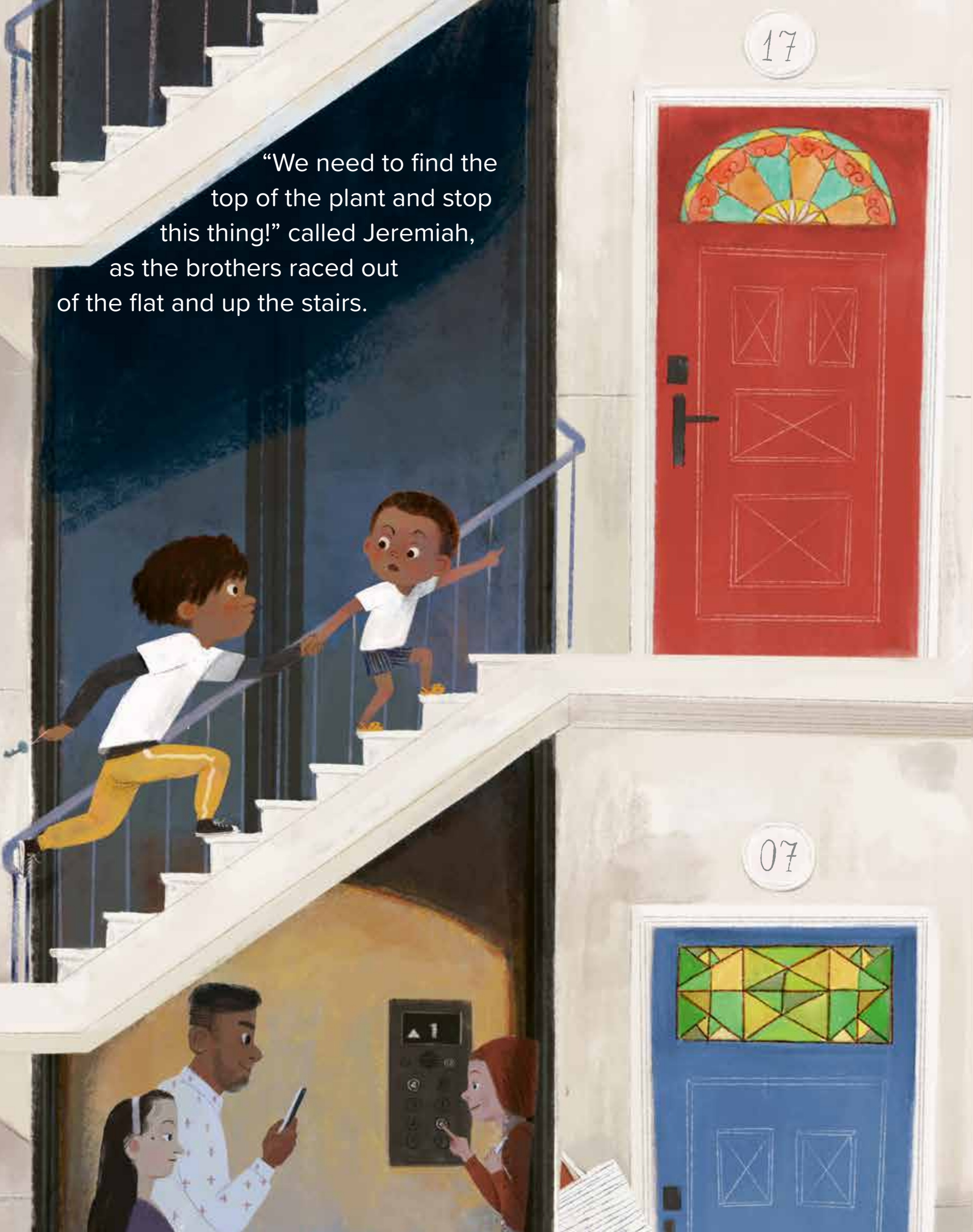
He placed the pot carefully next to the photo of his dad.

“We need to find the top of the plant and stop this thing!” called Jeremiah, as the brothers raced out of the flat and up the stairs.



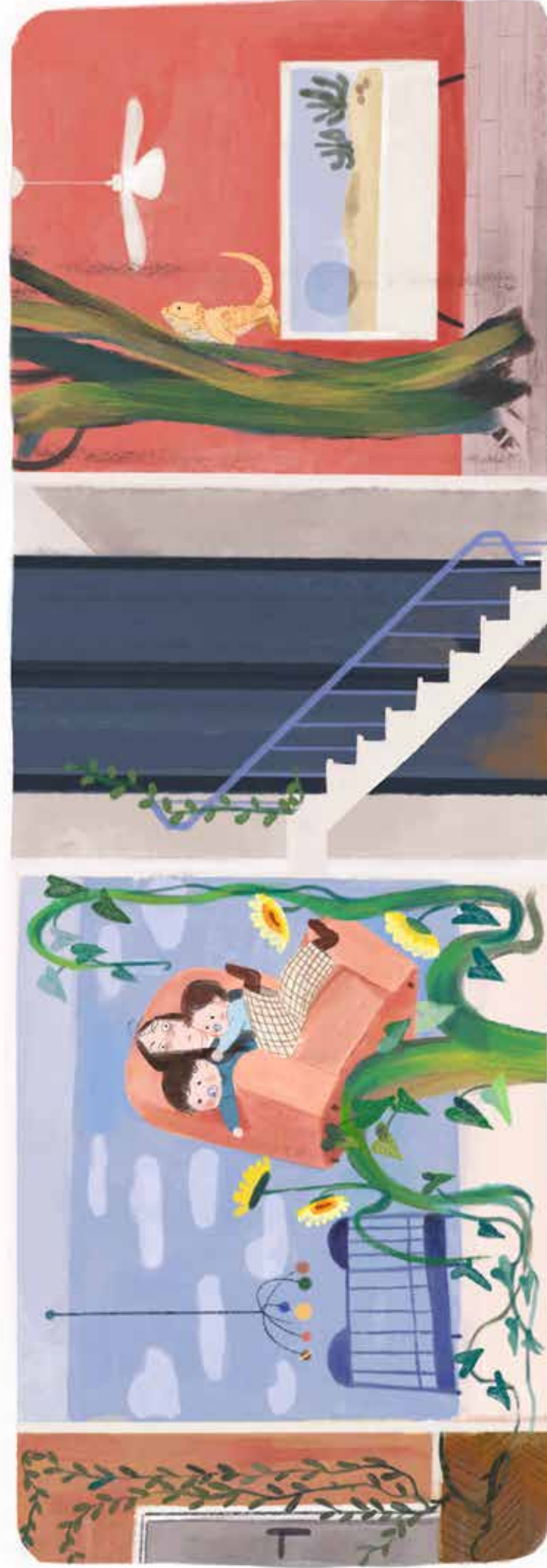
On the next floor, a lady in a rainbow-bright leotard opened the door to Flat 17. Behind her, the boys could see a mass of leaves and petals.
