

Uncle Henry and Aunt Em ran to hide in the storm shelter.


'Dorothy, quick!' shouted Uncle Henry, as the door blew shut behind him.

Chapter 2


Dorothy shut her eyes and held onto the kitchen table. She was scared of falling out of the house!
