sorts of adventures to be had.




The same places you might see every day can change

That are strewn across the floor!

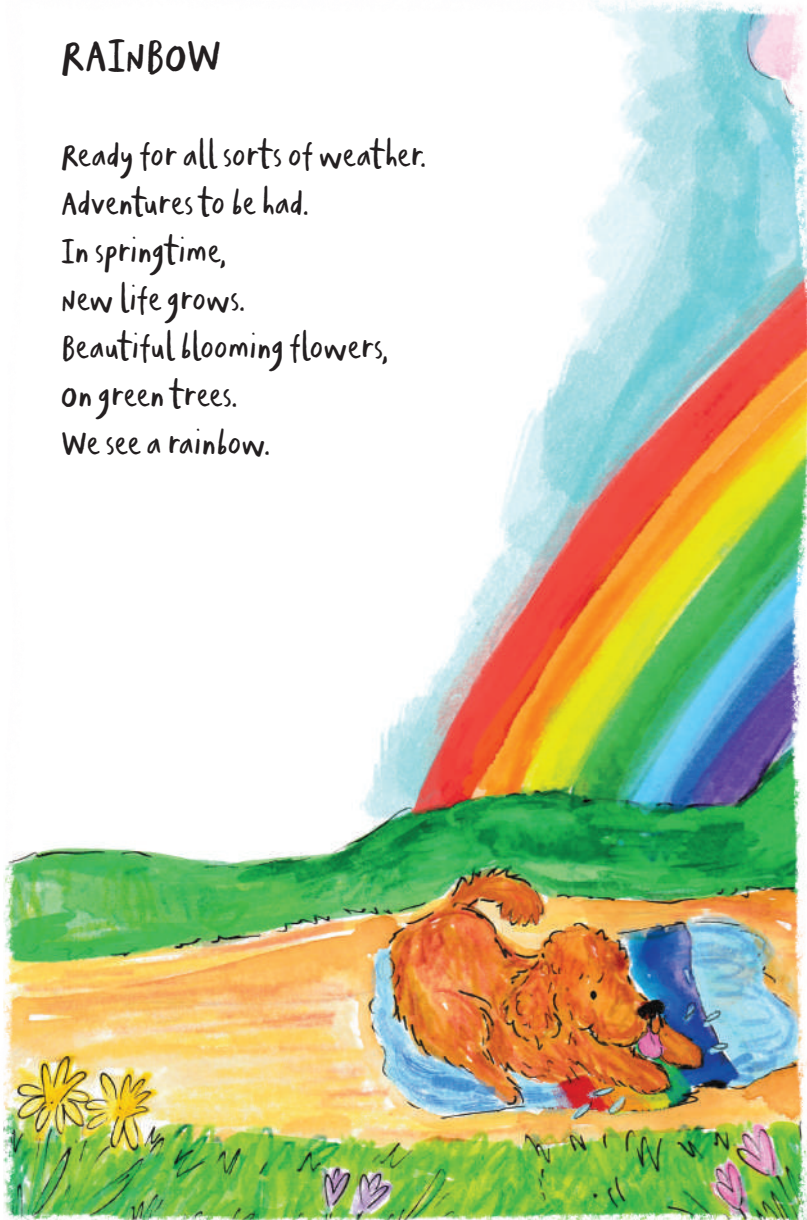
You take a great big leap,

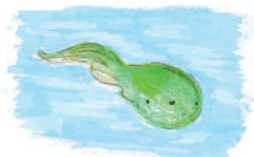

Make a spring nature hunt and get outside.

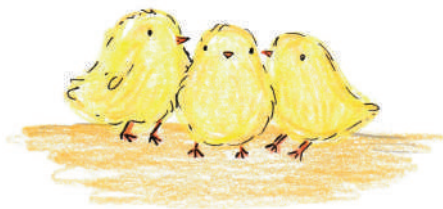


Plant something and watch it grow.
