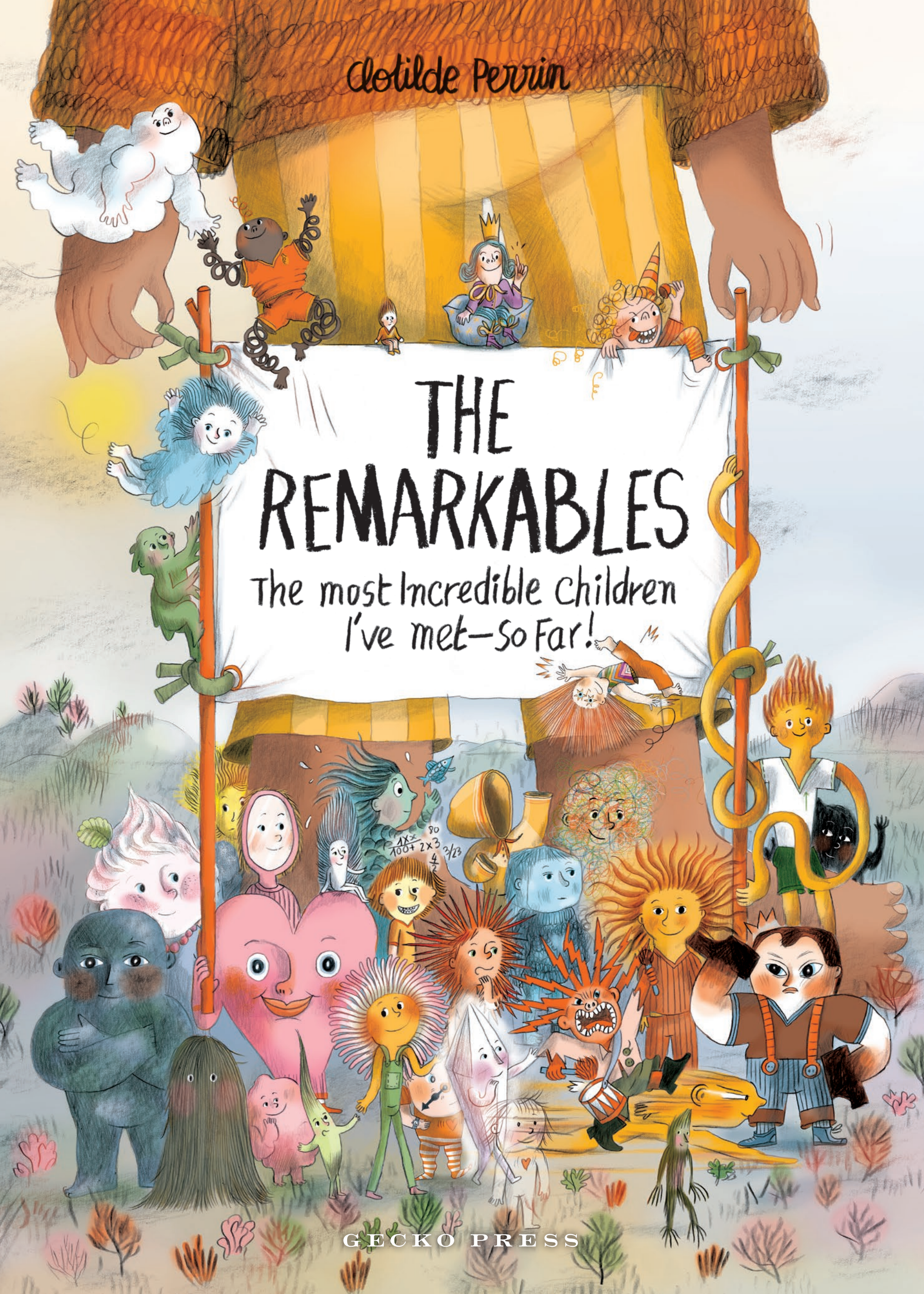

One day, I got a bad scare and my whole body went cold. My heart turned into a block of ice.

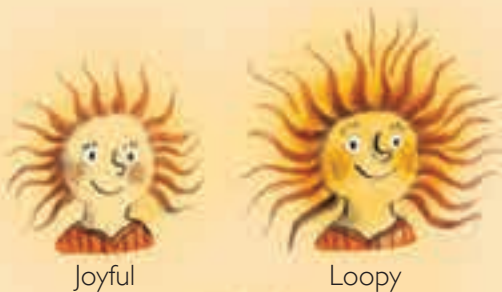

BRIGHT EYES

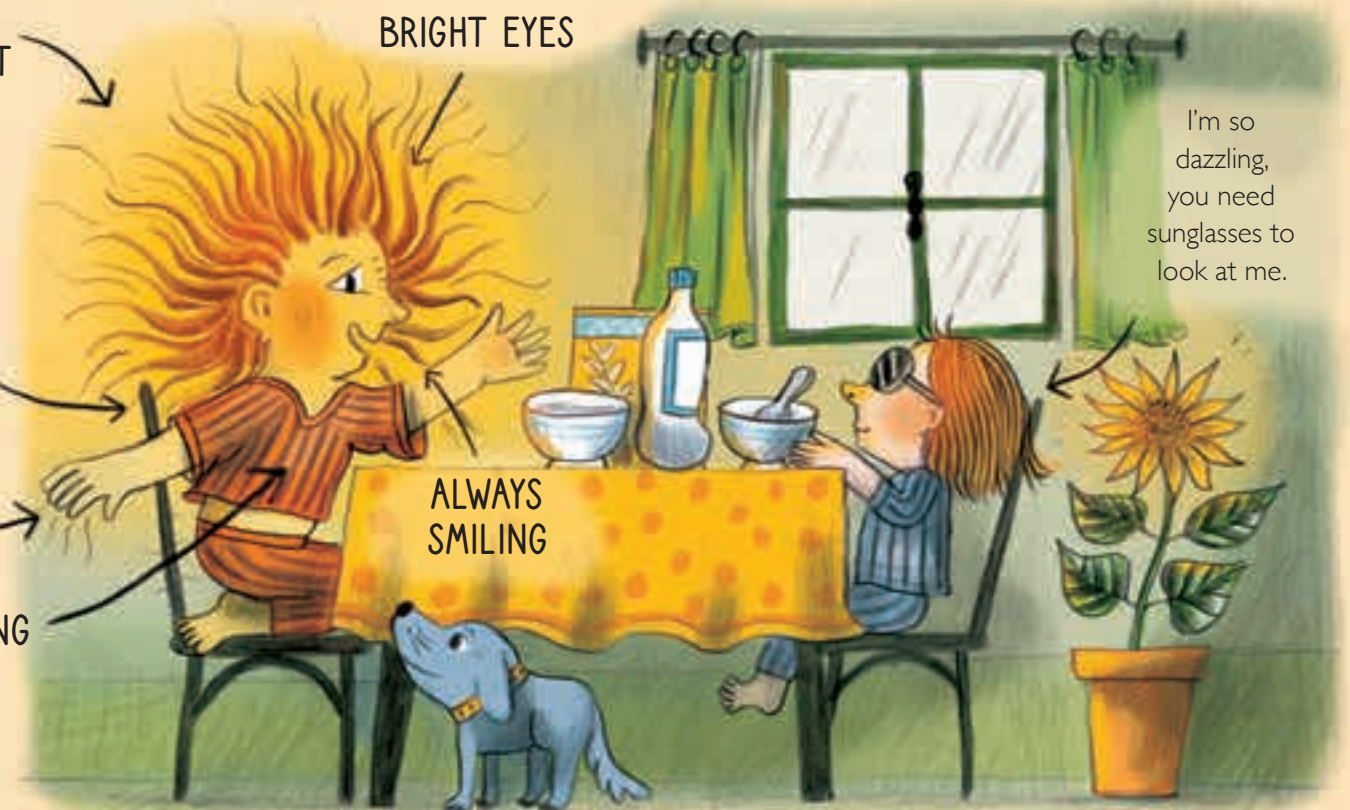
I'm so dazzling, you need sunglasses to look at me.

HEART BURSTING WITH JOY

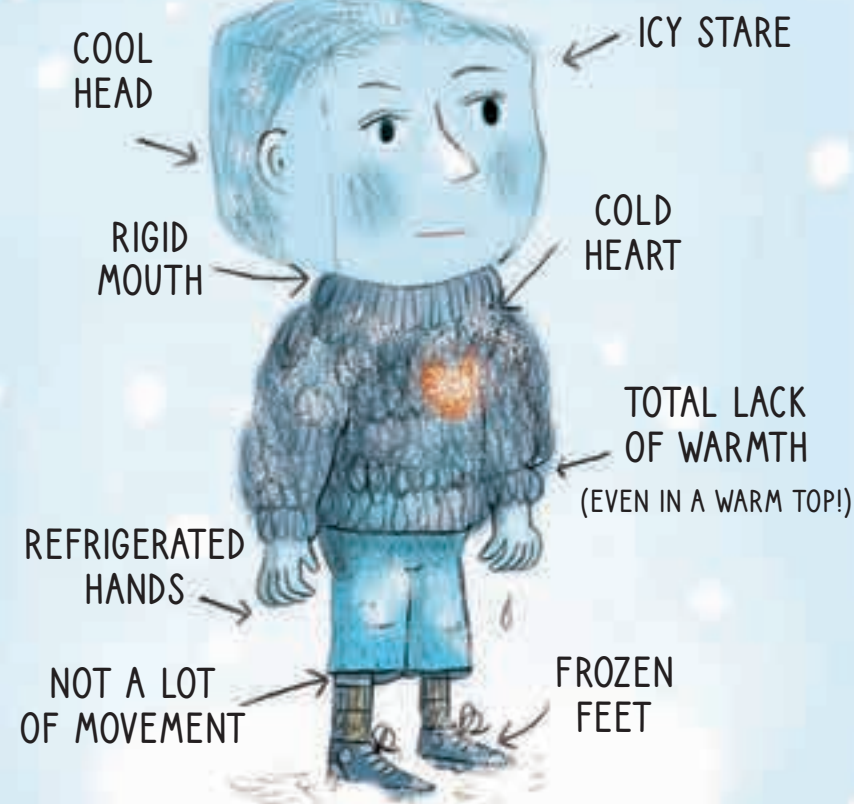


I'll warm you up...

My dream house!

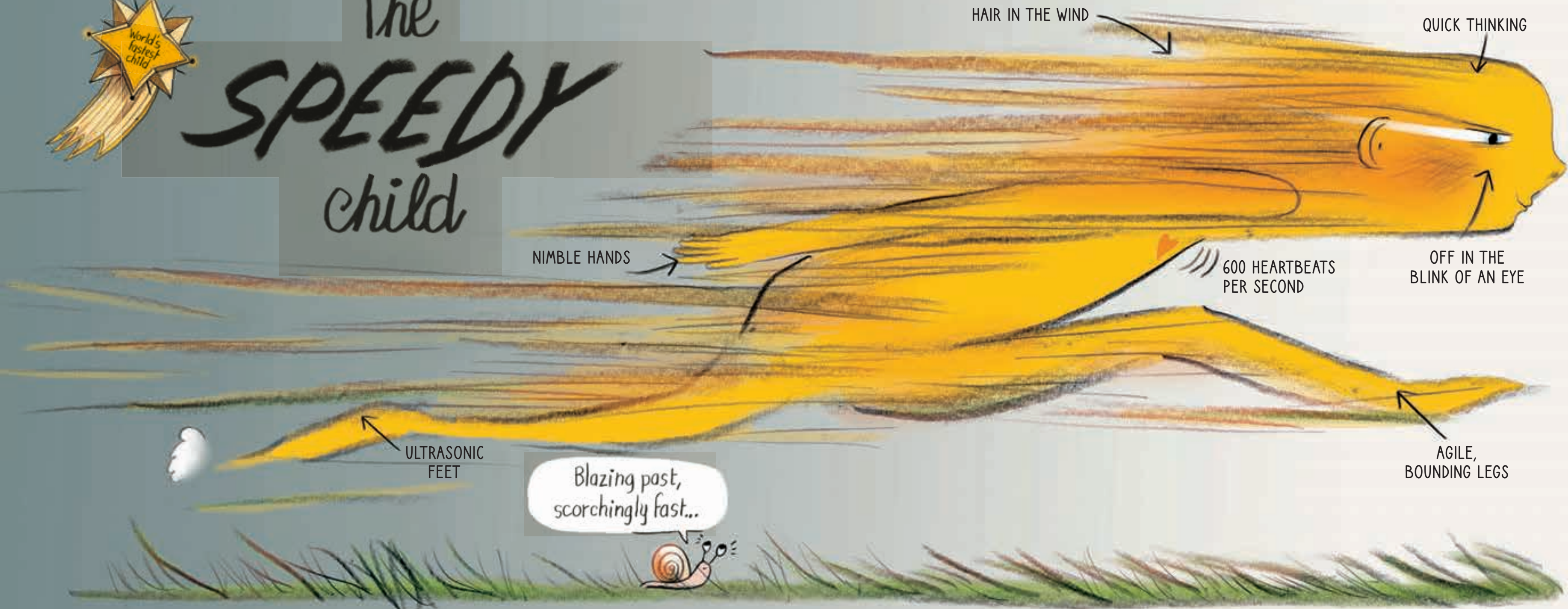


POLAR BEAR

AT MY HOUSE



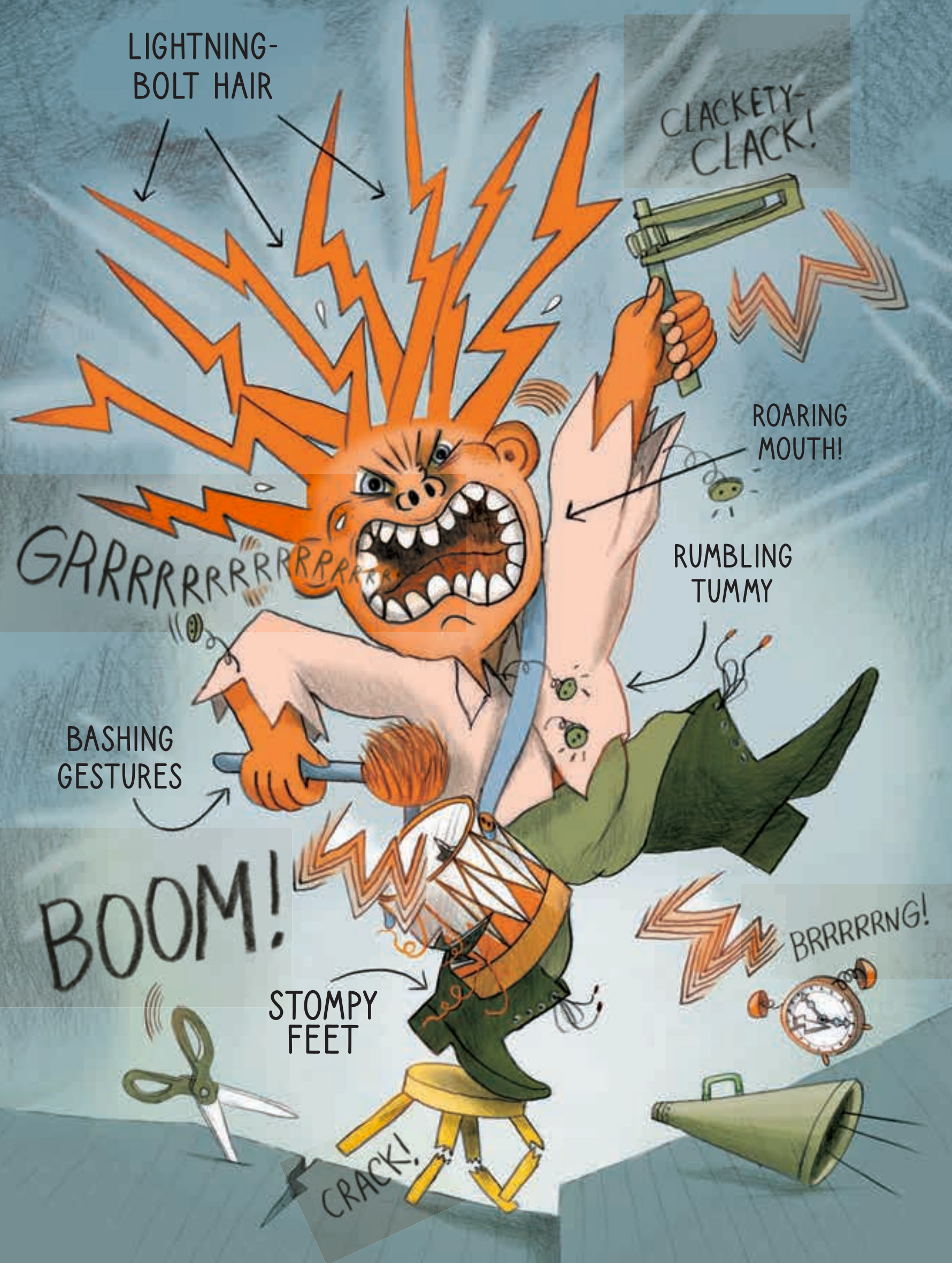
I race through the rooms of our house so fast my parents can hardly see me.

THINGS I LOVE

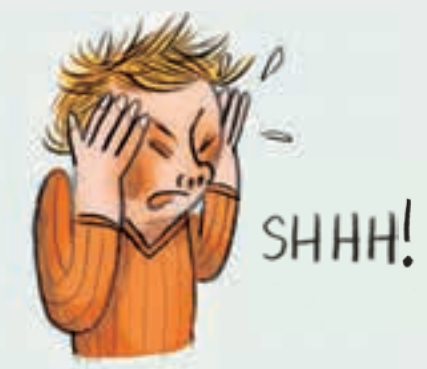
The THUNDER child
